As a convenience for our many friends and donors, the Florida Sheriffs Association has established the Florida Sheriffs Youth Fund, Incorporated.

The purposes of the Florida Sheriffs Youth Fund, Inc. are: to generate, receive, and disburse funds for the Girls Villa, Boys Ranch, the adoption and foster home program, and any other program that may be developed for dependent, neglected and homeless boys and girls under the sponsorship of the Florida Sheriffs Association.

Through the establishment of the Fund, four major goals have been accomplished:

- It is easier for an individual to make a gift; only one check is necessary for direct cash gifts.
- 2. Donors do not have to make a decision as to which program will receive the gift, even though they may do so. Monies will be applied in the area of the greatest need.
- 3. Bookkeeping and accounting is more economical and efficient. All record keeping for the Youth Fund, Boys Ranch and Girls Villa is centralized at the Boys Ranch office.
- 4. Future development of child care programs will be easier.

When a gift is made to the Fund and no program preference is made for its use, the governing Board will apply it where it is most needed. This procedure applies to all gifts - cash, insurance, stocks and bonds, real and personal property, and bequests.

When a gift is made to the fund and it is designated for a specific program such as the Ranch or Villa, it will be used exclusively for that program.


The same principle applies to bequests. They can be made to the Youth Fund with or without a program preference. The proper designation of legatee for bequests is:

> Florida Sheriffs Youth Fund, Inc. Boys Ranch, Florida 32060

As in the past, donors can make gifts or bequests directly to the Ranch or the Villa, without utilizing the Youth Fund, but we urge our friends to use it whenever possible because it represents a convenience to them, and an important improvement in our bookkeeping system.

Second Residence Cottage Doubles Capacity at Girls Villa

Dedication of Buena Vista Villa, newest addition at the Florida Sheriffs Girls Villa, will be one of the highlights of Girls Villa Week, which is traditionally observed near Labor Day. Exact dates and plans will be announced later.

Buena Vista is the second of two residence cottages now in operation at the Villa. Pinellas Sunshine Villa was completed in 1972 and dedicated during Girls Villa Week in 1972.

Each residence cottage represents an investment of over \$100,000 and has a capacity of eight girls plus a married couple employed as cottage parents. The unique design is self-contained so that the girls can prepare their own meals and learn to do routine household chores such as laundry and cleaning. There are no plans for a central dining room or central laundry.

Two additional buildings appeared on the Villa landscape recently. One is a metal warehouse which will be used as a supply and maintenance center. The other is a pre-fabricated concrete block building which will be used for staff and administrative purposes.

Present facilities also include a home for the resident director, and a mobile home for use as a staff residence. Resident Director's home.

The motor pool area is sandy and rutted now, but will be paved as soon as construction work is completed.

The new equipment shed will have a shop for small motor repairs (lawnmowers, outboard motors, etc.) at one end.

BOYS RANCH COULDN'T OPERATE WITHOUT "WHEELS"

The motor pool and auto mechanics shop at the Boys Ranch is steadily expanding with the addition of an equipment shed, a small motors repair shop, and an enlarged auto repair shop. When the construction work has been completed, the entire "motor pool" area will be paved.

This is an important part of the Boys Ranch complex for two reasons.

First, the Ranch could not operate without its large fleet of vehicles, including trucks, tractors, automobiles, school buses, fire trucks, trailers, vans and farm machinery.

Second, boys who work at the motor pool and mechanics shop learn important vocational skills which prepare them for jobs in service stations and auto repair shops if their aptitudes point in that direction.

Motor repair work also has its recreational side, giving boys an opportunity to tinker with old jalopies, outboard motors, motorbikes and go-carts.

Lawnmower motors require a lot of attention, but that hardly comes under the heading of recreation.

Bicycle repairs are handled at the arts and crafts building.

The motor pool and auto mechanics shop is located at the rear of the Ranch fire station so that Bob Moss, the full-time fire chief, can also supervise the repair work. Before coming to the Ranch he had over 11 years of experience in auto repair work.

VALPARAISO – Giving is nothing new for Ralph Nordberg, longtime supporter and trustee of the Florida Sheriffs Boys Ranch.

But he does from time to time find new ways of expressing his generosity.

His most recent giveaway was an historic baseball which he donated to the Baseball Hall of Fame in Cooperstown, N. Y. Nordberg acquired the ball in 1933, in Chicago's Comiskey Park, when he caught a foul off the bat of Bill Dickey during the first All-Star game.

At that time in his radio and newspaper advertising career he was sales manager for station WJJD, and was sitting in the stands with Gene Autry when the foul ball came his way.

Autry was a \$35-a-week radio master of ceremonies and had not yet been elevated to stardom. "Frankly," said Nordberg in a recent interview, "I didn't think he had a very good voice."

In contrast, Nordberg waxes enthusiastic any time the Florida Sheriffs Boys Ranch is mentioned. He has been supporting it ever since the early days when it was fighting obscurity; and he has had a hand in its development both through his gifts and through time devoted to his trustee duties.



Although he has been battling serious physical ailments for years, he continues to write cheerful notes to his friends; and occasionally he sends them thoughtful gifts like inspirational booklets or unusual coins.

Nordberg is a compulsive giver, and, if it is more blessed to give than to receive, he has a lot of blessings still coming to him.

We Get Check-Ups Without Writing A Check

The Florida Sheriffs Girls Villa has its share of aches and pains, but no headaches caused by doctors' and dentists' bills.

Fact is, our girls get the best possible medical and dental care, and it's practically all free.

Ten dentists and 21 doctors in surrounding Polk County have volunteered their services. The dental services are coordinated by Dr. Stuart Roux, of Lakeland; and the medical services are coordinated by Dr. Paul E. Coury, of Bartow. They try to allocate the work so that the burden is equalized among the various volunteers, and also so that specialists are utilized when needed.

The mean age at the Villa is between 13 and 14, just the time in life when expensive orthodontic work is usually needed. Dentists' bills – if we had to pay them – would total around \$3,000 or \$4,000 a year.

The annual price tag on medical care would run even higher, but the bills are

marked "paid" before we even see them. One ear surgery case would have cost us \$1,200 if we had been required to pay the bill.

Eye care is paid for by the Lions Club; and outpatient mental health facilities provide psychiatric evaluations and psychological testing free of charge when needed.

Free speech therapy is also available and was so effective in one case that the patient ended up enrolling in a "speed reading" course.

Dr. Doris Carson, Villa Trustee and wife of Jacksonville Sheriff Dale Carson, has added an important contribution to the medical program by helping to develop the medical record forms and procedures.

Many generous people are involved, and it all adds up to this: Our girls can get a check-up any time they need it, and we don't have to worry about writing a check.




The Flavor of Life at the Villa Is Something Other Than Vanilla


