There's Gold In Them There Acres of Planted Pines

Seedling by seedling the Boys Ranch is approaching its goal of 2,000 acres of planted pine trees. At a rate of 1,000 trees per acre, that means an eventual stand of at least 2,000,000 trees, and (over decades) an income of millions of dollars. A few years ago the Ranch was selling pulpwood for \$8 a cord. Now the price is up to \$26 a cord, and apparently rising. We have 1,500 acres in pines at the present time — a figure attained with the help of over 128,000 donated pine seedlings which our boys planted in November, December and January. The seedlings came from Buckeye Cellulose Co., Perry (54,000); and Gilman Paper Co., Day (74,000). There are still many acres of scrub oak to be cleared before we reach our final 2,000-acre goal. Our normal routine is to clear out the scrub oak, plant watermelons, harvest a cash crop of melons, then plant pines. Eventually, we hope to be able to harvest 100 acres of 20-year-old pine trees each year, and replant the same number of acres.

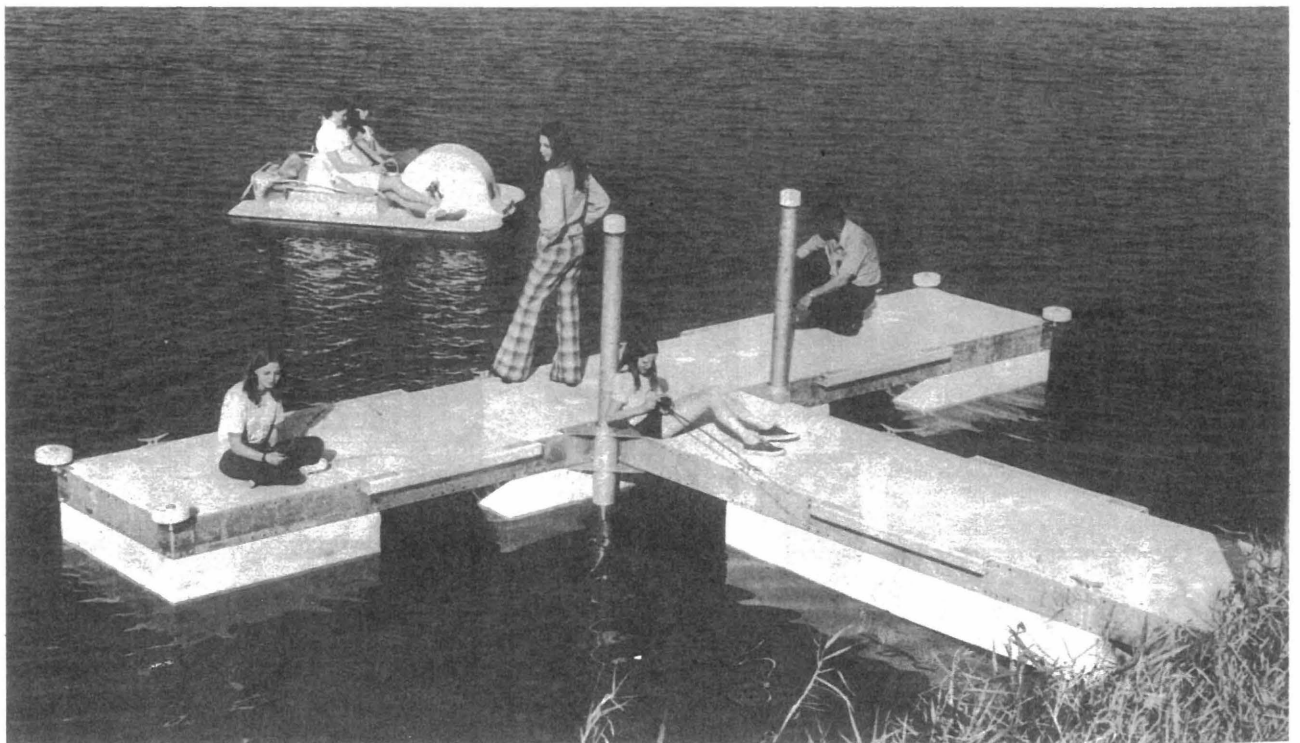


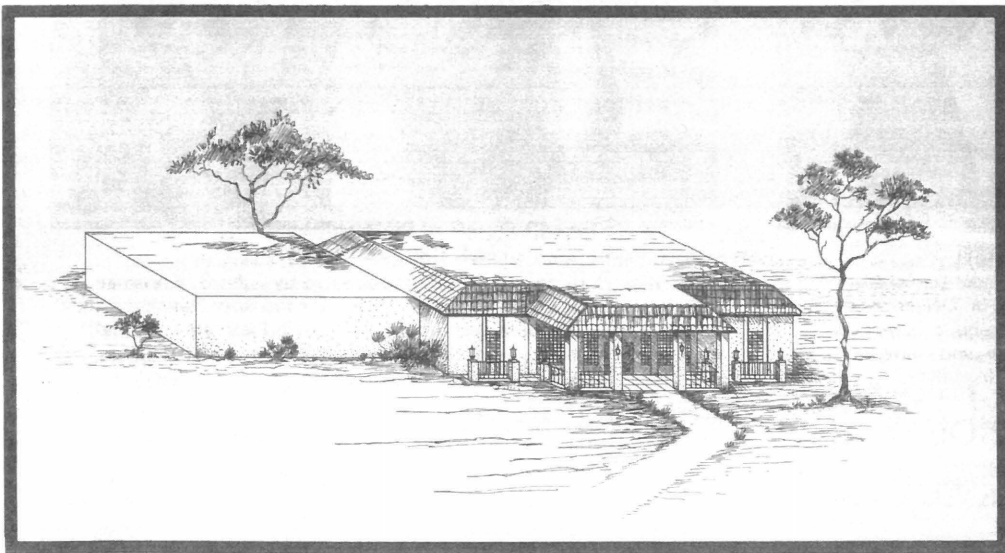


Things are looking **UP** at the Girls Villa

In their spare time the girls are helping workmen tear down part of an abandoned museum to make way for the new administration building shown in the illustration at left.



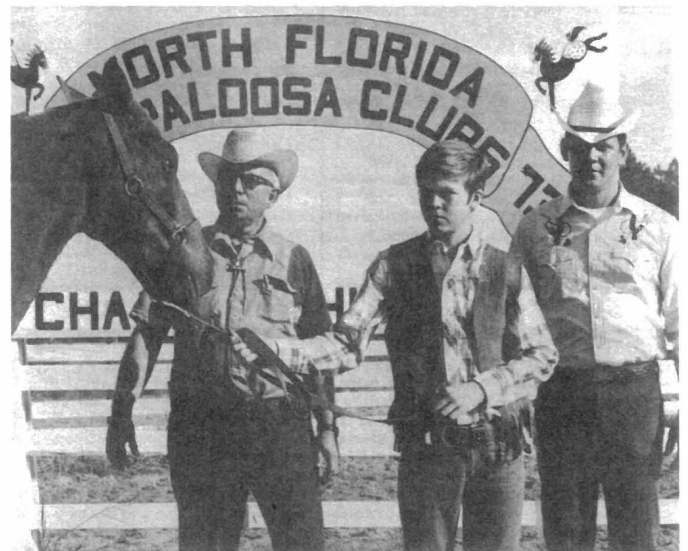
No More High School Classes For Donny and Doug

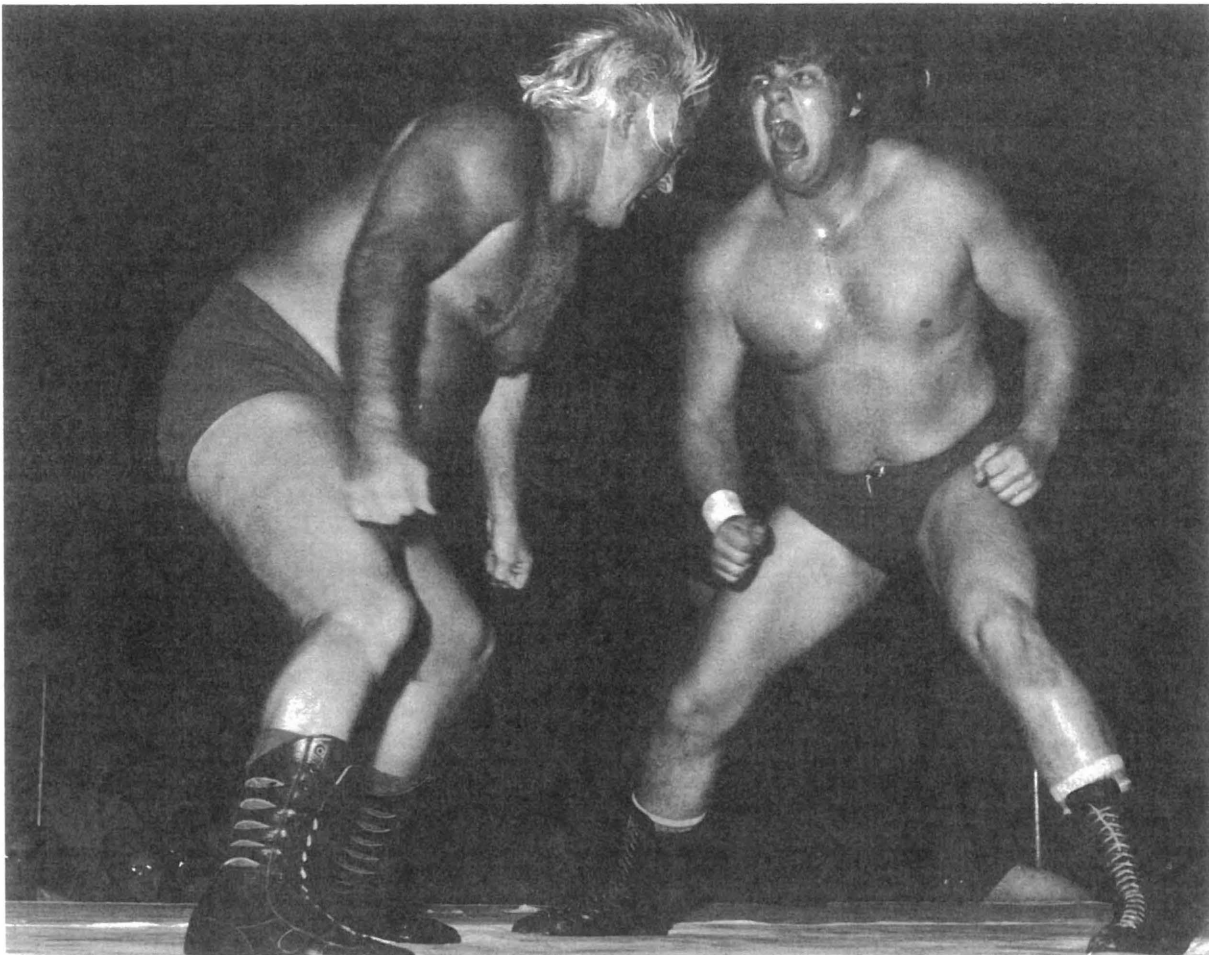

Everytime these merchants of muscular mayhem enter the ring in sports arenas around Florida, it means more dollars in the Boys Ranch bank account . . . and that's music to any Sheriff's ear.

A recent tally showed that professional wrestling proceeds have produced almost \$70,000 in donations to the Ranch.

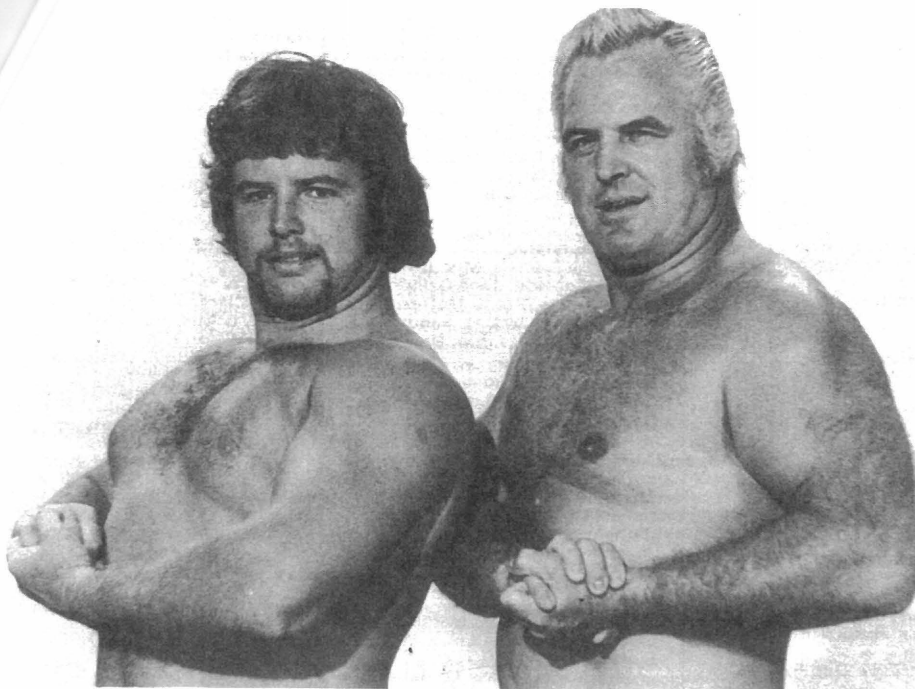
In addition, wrestlers and promoters have taken a personal interest in the boys ever since the Ranch opened its doors for business in 1959. C. P. "Cowboy" Luttrall, Tampa promoter who is now retired, was one of the first loyal supporters from the wrestling fraternity. Others who followed his lead are Eddie Graham of Tampa; Pat O'Hara of Arcadia; Don Curtis of Jacksonville; and Milo Steinborn of Orlando.

Wrestlers, because they operate in a world of hard knocks, have a special affinity for youngsters who have been kicked around by life. They frequently visit the ranch; they have staged benefit bouts in nearby Live Oak which have raised over \$12,000 in recent years; and they never fail to put in a plug for the Ranch when they appear on television.

Through Eddie Graham, who is a trustee of the Boys Ranch as well as the Girls Villa, they also have a voice in the operation policies and future plans of both institutions.

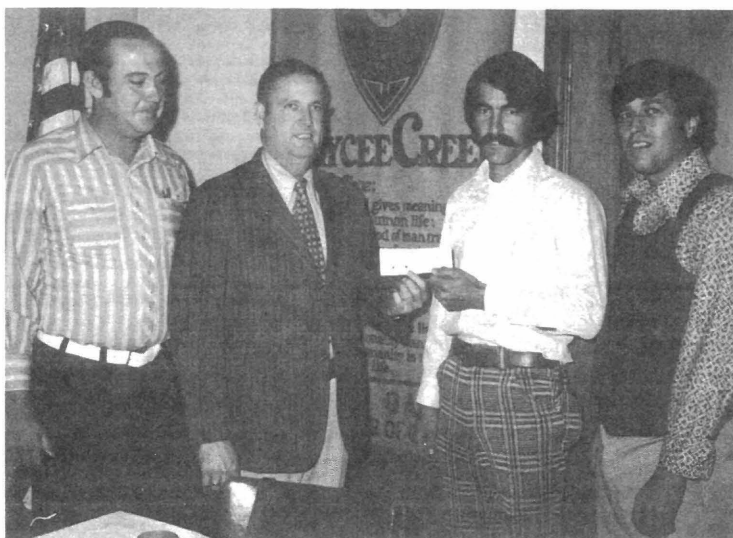
When the Boys Ranch was in its infancy, getting the active support of Florida wrestlers and promoters was no chore. Many of them were already helping Cal Farley's Boys Ranch, an institution founded by a former professional wrestler near Amarillo, Texas, and they quickly stretched their generosity to include the Florida counterpart. Cal Farley also came to the Sheriffs Boys Ranch to assist in getting it started.

The ties are strong; the sentiment runs deep; and wrestlers have become an inseparable part of the Boys Ranch success story.

Beware of the Phony on the Phone

Beware of the fund raiser who calls you on the phone or knocks on your door asking for a donation to the Florida Sheriffs Boys Ranch or Girls Villa.

The Ranch and Villa do not endorse any door-to-door or telephone solicitation of funds. Our only organized state-wide fund raising is done by mail, but unscrupulous fund raisers representing other institutions with similar names have been misleading donors into believing they are employed by the Sheriffs Boys Ranch.

We do not employ any fund raisers.

We do not raise funds by telephone.

We do not organize door-to-door fund raising campaigns.

Occasionally local groups or individuals hold benefits of various kinds and give a portion of the proceeds to the Ranch or Villa. If this should happen in your area, you may receive a phone call from someone selling tickets. If you do, check the authenticity of the call with your local Sheriff's Office before responding.

All fund raising benefits for the Ranch and Villa must have the local Sheriff's approval to be legitimate. We welcome and

appreciate these projects, but the Ranch and Villa do not endorse any of them. Each Sheriff serves as a fund raising chairman in his own county, and it is his responsibility to screen all fund raising projects.

Here Comes That Big Birthday Party

Birthday celebrations last only one day for famous men like George Washington, Abraham Lincoln and Archie Bunker.

But, when the Girls Villa checks off another year, the folks in nearby Bartow whoop it up for a whole week.

They call it "Girls Villa Week", and it's one of those something for everyone affairs featuring golf tournaments, tennis tournaments, a fish fry, a fancy ball with a name band, and a Villa "open house".

It gets into gear late in August each year, and winds up on Labor Day, which this year falls on September 2. In three successful years it has raised over \$30,000 for the Villa; and the rash of publicity it generates has produced many additional thousands of dollars in gifts from individuals.

Planning for Girls Villa Week is a year 'round task, and arrangements are nearing completion for the 1974 edition. It promises to be the best yet and we are sincerely grateful to all the generous volunteers and sponsors who are involved in this worthwhile venture.

Sheriff Has "Special Kind of Feeling" For Ranch and Villa

BUSHNELL — Radio disc jockeys are playing a country-western tune written and recorded by a singing, song-writing Sheriff; and every time the record spins it produces dollars for the Boys Ranch and Girls Villa.

Sheriff Don Page said he recorded and distributed the record over a wide area at his own expense, and asked the disc jockeys to announce that anyone sending in a donation to the Ranch and Villa would receive a copy of the record free.

Funds raised in the first three weeks totaled almost \$200, and the Sheriff expects the pace of donations to accelerate.

The song, titled "A Special Kind of Feeling", is on Sheriff Page's own "Lawman" label, and he's hoping some big record company will buy it. If this happens and it becomes a hit, he has pledged he will split 10 per cent of the royalties between the Ranch and Villa.

Although he's written the words to 30 or 40 country-western songs over many years, he "just threw them away", and this is the first one he's recorded. "I can't read music," Don explained, "so I just write down the words and keep humming around until I get a tune to go with them."

That was how "Special Kind of Feeling" was put together in the Leesburg recording studio. Don hummed around, and the tune was picked up by his accompanists Arky Gray (steel guitar), Jim Rupp (bass guitar) and a studio drummer. Rupp works for Sheriff Page as a deputy.

Don's next composition on the Lawman label will be "Sad Little World", a ditty inspired by the ecological crisis. He plans to speak the words against a musical background of voices and instruments.

And somehow, in spite of the 24-hour-a-day responsibilities



of being a Sheriff, he also plans to put together a country-western jamboree as a benefit for the Ranch and Villa.

Writing and singing songs is a preoccupation Don isn't likely to get over. Those words and tunes that go running around in his head he apparently inherited from his 85-year-old mother, Mrs. Mabel Page, who recently received wide publicity for having played the piano in the same church for 80 years.

Don may not be able to equal that record, but he has a start. He's been singing at churches and funerals ever since he was eight.

Neighborly Ties 'Twixt Villa and Village Didn't Just Happen

Bartow is a good neighbor.

And that's what you would expect from this friendly, attractive community next door to the Girls Villa.

But the neighborly ties that link the Villa and the village, didn't just happen. They were woven with much care and concern by a diversified group of people known as the Girls Villa Board of Associates. These Kissinger-like ambassadors of good will are "friend raisers" not "fund raisers"; and their pri-

mary purpose is to bring about close relationships and better understanding between The Villa and the people of Bartow.

There's no butcher, no baker, and no candlestick maker among them, but they represent a broad cross-section, and their influence extends to all segments of the community. The Chairman, Dr. Paul E. Coury, not only heads up the Board of Associates but also coordinates medical services for the girls at the Villa. On the board with him are preachers, teachers, a dentist, a banker, a law enforcement man, business executives, a senator, a pharmacist, a printer, a news reporter, an auto dealer, an insurance agent, a housewife and public officials.

It's their responsibility to keep informed about the needs the goals, the policies and the progress of the Villa through periodic reports. This enables them to keep the community informed; and although they are not fund raisers, generous financial support from the community naturally follows.

Board members provide a communications channel between the Villa and the village. They give advice and guidance to the Villa staff; and they help to shape the future development of the Villa.

Soon after earth was turned at the Girls Villa ground breaking in 1971, plans were formulated for the Board of Associates. It was organized in 1972, and the first chairman was William Stringfellow, a peat moss producer, a former President of the Bartow Chamber of Commerce, and a prime mover in bringing the Villa to Bartow.

Dr. Coury succeeded Stringfellow in 1973, and Jack O. Johnson became the vice chairman.
