

## "Get Involved," Said Harry Weaver, and Ex-Ranchers Did

When former Ranchers attended the anniversary celebration of the Boys Ranch last October, Executive Director Harry Weaver urged them to "get involved in our problems, our programs and our plans for future development."

Since then, many of them have become involved in a number of ways.

Leonard Russek, for example, was responsible for setting up an educational program to warn Ranchers about the dangers of drug abuse.

After talking it over with Harry, he brought to the Ranch for a drug abuse seminar Robert E. Patterson and Ron Williams, who are drug problem specialists in the Hillsborough County School System.

The two specialists met with Ranchers in groups, held rap sessions, answered questions and established a firm foundation of basic knowledge about drugs.

"It was very helpful," Harry said later. "We don't have, and have never had a serious drug problem, but we want to do everything possible to prevent one

from developing."

Leonard was one of the first two boys enrolled at the Ranch when it opened for business in 1959. Now he has a family of his own, and is making a career in accounting. He has been living in Leesburg, but is planning to move to Tampa.

Harry said other alumni have become involved in various ways. Some have referred needy youngsters to the Ranch. Many have given cash gifts. Some have counseled with boys now living at the Ranch and have helped them to work out problems. Some have returned to the Ranch for short periods to work as temporary cottage parents.

### ALUMNI MEETING

The Boys Ranch Alumni Association will hold its next meeting at the Ranch May 5-7, with President Wally Edwards presiding. Over 30 alumni attended the last reunion on October 2, 1971.

On the second go 'round there was music from Lohengrin; a script almost as old as sin; and a lovely bride by his side.

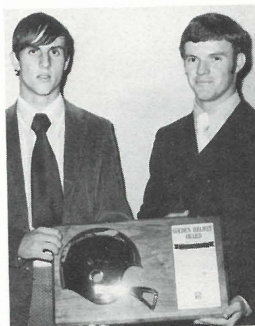
The date was January 27; and

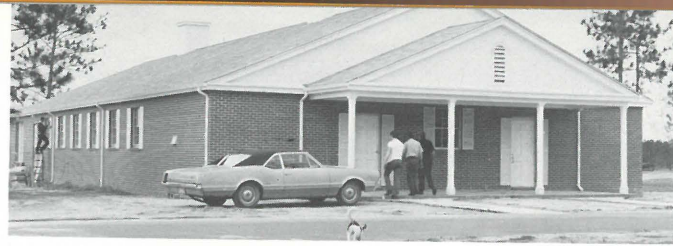
David, who is the son of Mrs. Helen Shaw, of Tampa, was given moral support by Former Rancher David Thigpen, who served as best man.

of them, Bernie McCray, is shown with David in the award photo. The other, Bobby Ploucher, was not present when the picture was taken.



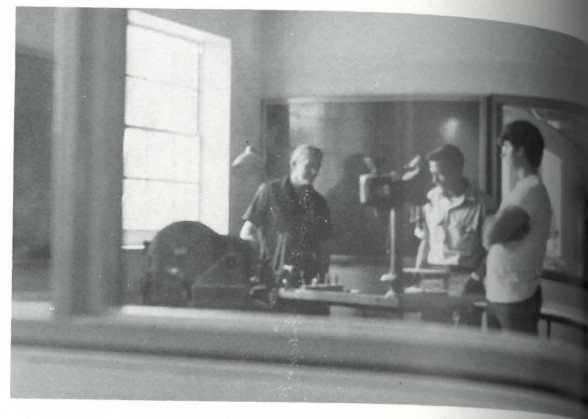

### Thank You Mister Rogers

The Boys Ranch suffered a great loss on January 31. Mr. Jay Rogers, Cottage Father, died unexpectedly. He will be sorely missed by the Ranchers at Saunders Cottage, by the Ranchers generally, by the staff, and by the entire Ranch. He suffered a heart seizure shortly upon his return from Church with a group of boys.

Mr. Rogers loved the Ranch; he was a complete part of it as well as the Ranch being a part of him. He believed in the Ranch and was proud of it and his work. He was extremely proud of all the Ranchers, and especially those Ranchers with whom he worked so closely.

He possessed the unique combination of talents that is necessary in working with teenagers. He was firm, fair, consistent, and above all deeply concerned about each boy, and he really cared about them. He was ALWAYS available. He was a good listener, and each Rancher knew that he could be heard completely, regardless of his problems.

Mr. Rogers could see good in everything that a Rancher did. Self-discipline could be seen evolving from the group process that was taking place in Saunders Cottage. You could actually feel it.

No, he was not a perfect man and he was not self-righteous. Boys like this ingredient in any person. A Rancher could feel comfortable in his presence. He was able to laugh at himself and to apologize when necessary. He was able to tell a Rancher that he did not know the answer to a question, but when he didn't know, he would find out. He could be wrong, too, and he could admit it.

Although his great work at the Ranch is ended, he leaves behind his long time companion, Mrs. Marie Rogers, who contributed to and also shared in his success. She served as a substitute mother to each boy and played the role the way a mother should. We hope that her talents can continue to be used at the Ranch.

The Boys Ranch is a better place because Mr. Rogers came our way. He gave many boys "hope" and a "handle" to hold onto.

Thank you, Mr. Rogers; and thank you God for sharing him with us.

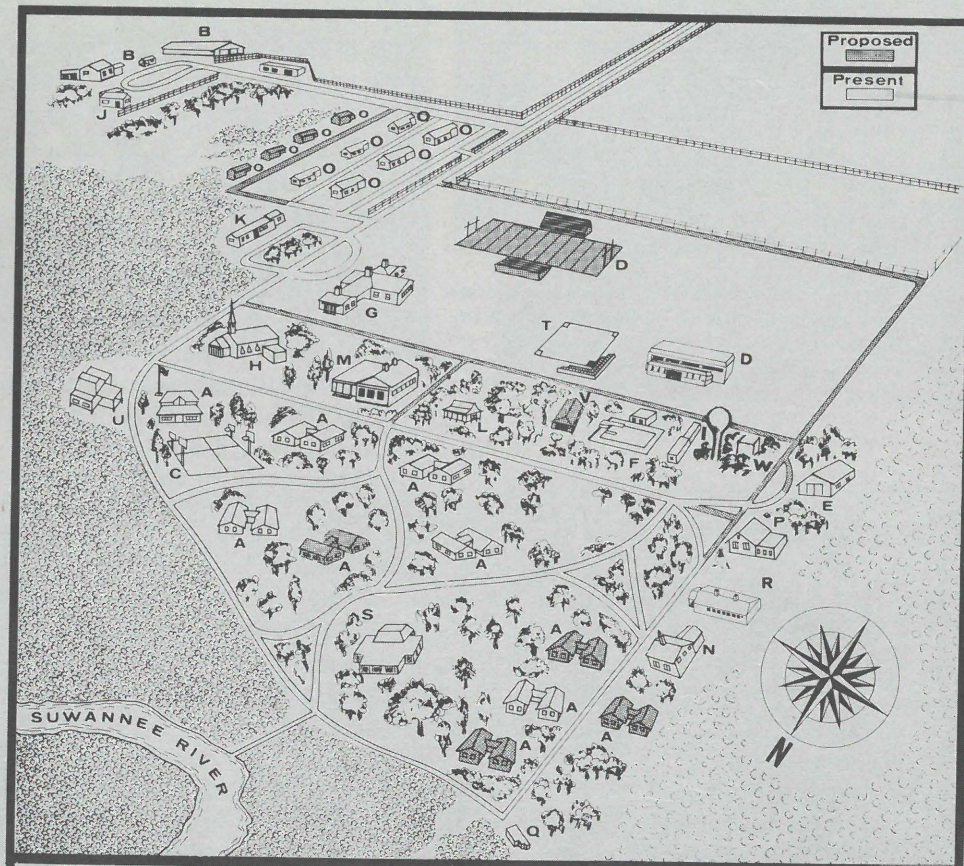

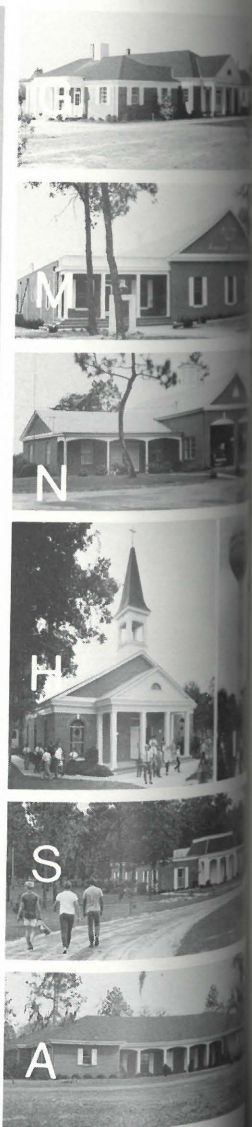

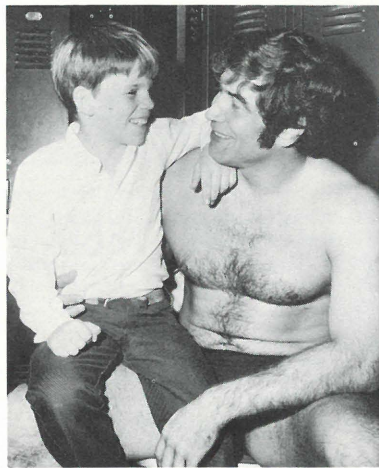

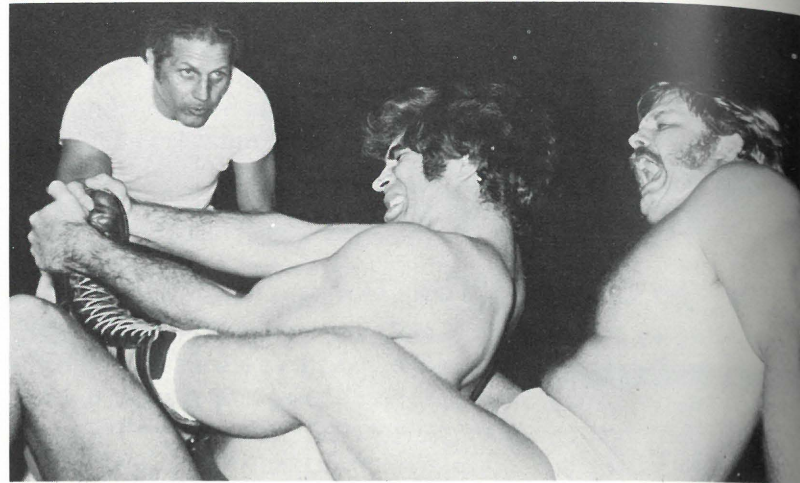
# "RASSLERS" AND RANCHERS

Ranchers know what it's like to wrestle with man-size problems. Many of them have been losers. Some of them have been floored by bad breaks. A few of them have been counted out by adults

And the Ranch is something like an idealized wrestling ring where no boy is ever counted out completely, and every loser has an opportunity to try again.

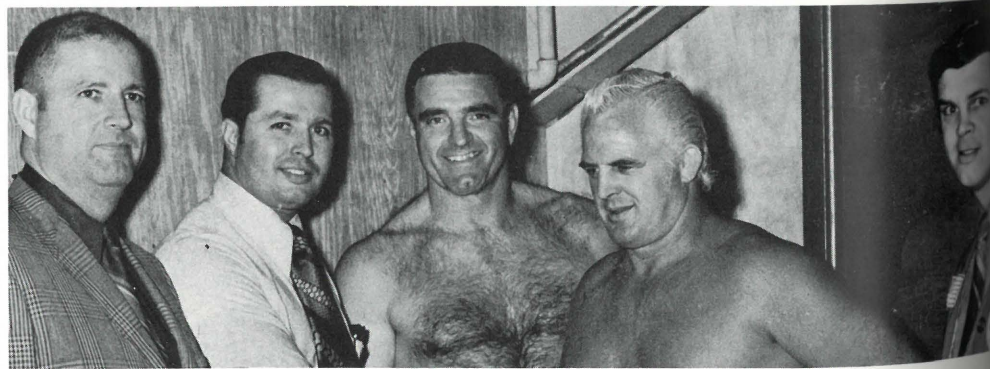
Wrestlers dig this. They believe in the Boys Ranch, and they'll sweat and strain to raise money for it.

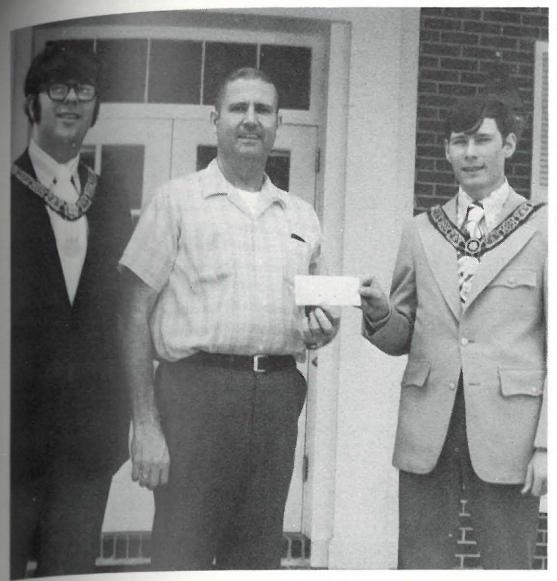

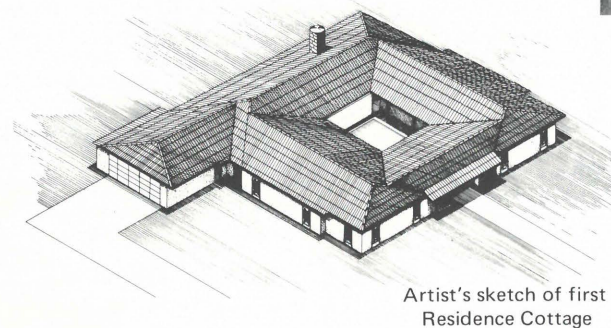

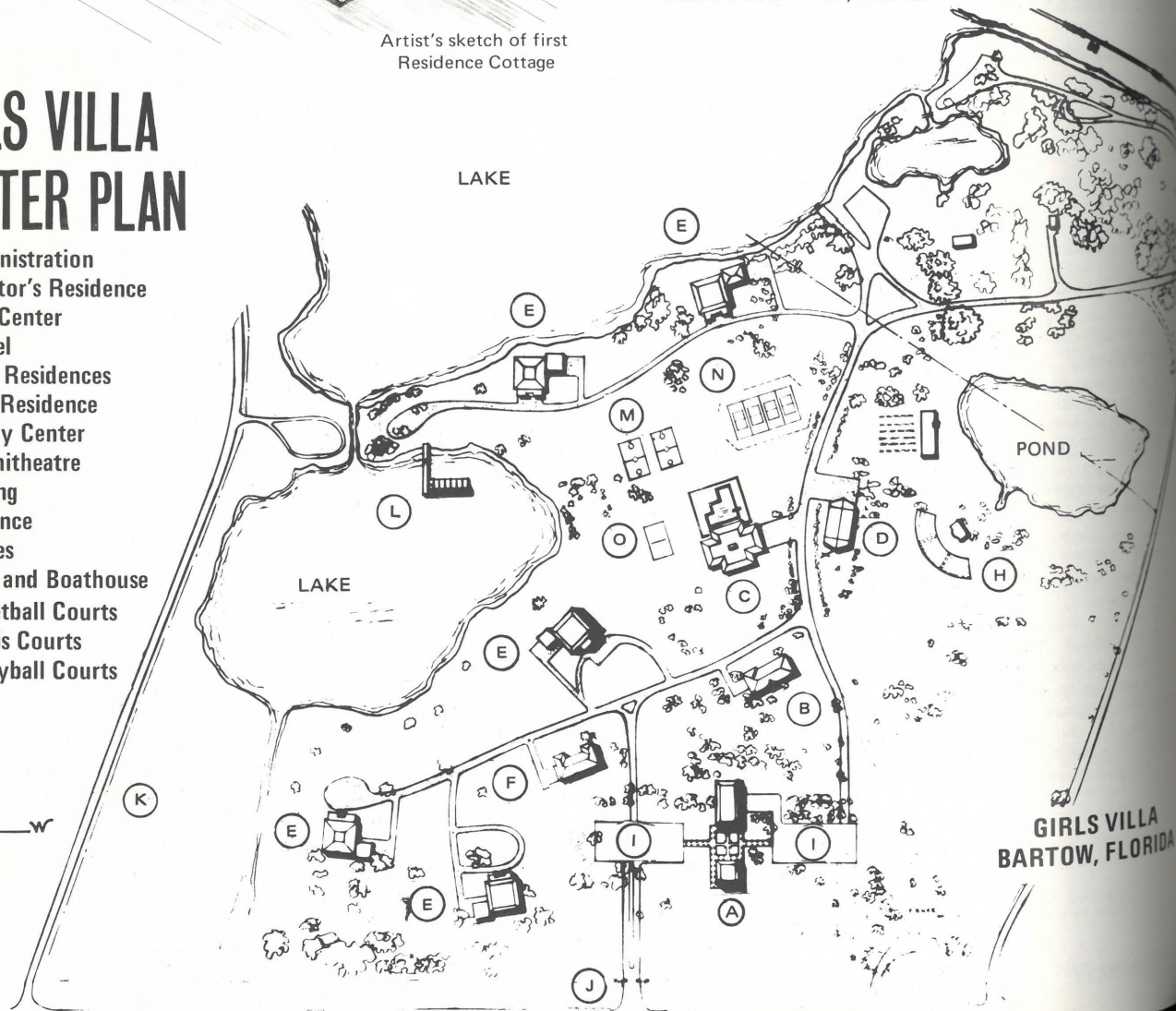
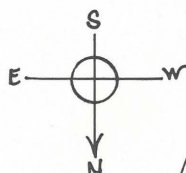

## CONSTRUCTION UNDER WAY AT GIRLS VILLA

BARTOW — Construction of the first buildings is now under way at the Florida Sheriffs Girls Villa, a home for needy and worthy girls patterned after the famous Florida Sheriffs Boys Ranch.

The first buildings will be a home for the resident director and his family; and a residence cottage with facilities for eight girls and a married couple employed as cottage parents.

The executive committee of the Villa trustees met here in December, 1971, opened bids, and awarded a contract to L. J. Rice and Son, of Lakeland.

Cost of constructing the two buildings will be \$189,784. Villa officials hope to have them completed in time to admit the first girls, by mid-1972.

Other facets of the Villa project are also moving toward this target. Resident Manager Bob Haag and his family are already living on the site. He has established an office in the old Phosphate Valley Museum building adjacent to the Villa property, and has hired a secretary-bookkeeper. One set of cottage parents (an experienced couple who formerly worked at the Boys Ranch) has been hired; and applications are being processed for the first candidates for admission. The Villa was created by The

Sunshine State Women's Chamber of Commerce, a Madeira Beach organization; and was adopted by the Florida Sheriffs Association in 1969.

A charter was filed January 7, 1970; trustees were appointed; and a building site was selected at Peace River Park, near Bartow. This site, with 75 landscaped acres and three lakes, was acquired through a 99-year lease on April 19, 1971.

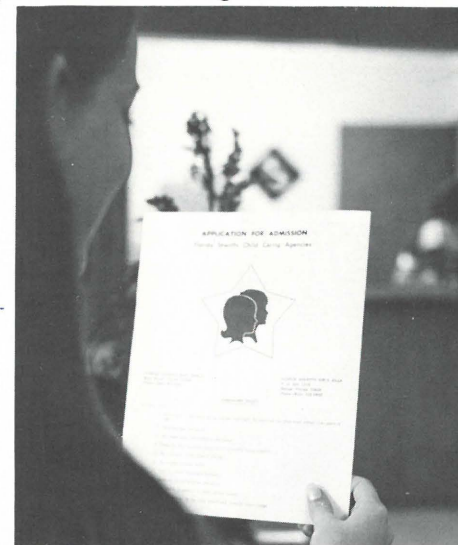
A few months later, Bartow Architect Les Pickett was hired to design the first facilities.

Ground breaking ceremonies were held on August 27, 1971, and shortly afterward Resident Director Haag established his residence at the site in a mobile home.

Record keeping and other administrative functions are currently being handled at the Boys Ranch, but they will gradually be transferred to the Villa. For the present, all gifts and inquiries should be mailed to the Boys Ranch, Boys Ranch, Florida 32060.

Long range planning for program and facilities is well under way. However, The Villa, like the Boys Ranch, is supported entirely by voluntary contributions; and the pace of its future development will be determined by the success of fund raising efforts.

Applications are now being processed and Villa officials will soon be selecting the first girls. Pictured here is one of the new 8-page application forms designed for use by the Boys Ranch and the Girls Villa. It includes a complete medical report and a psychological evaluation.
