

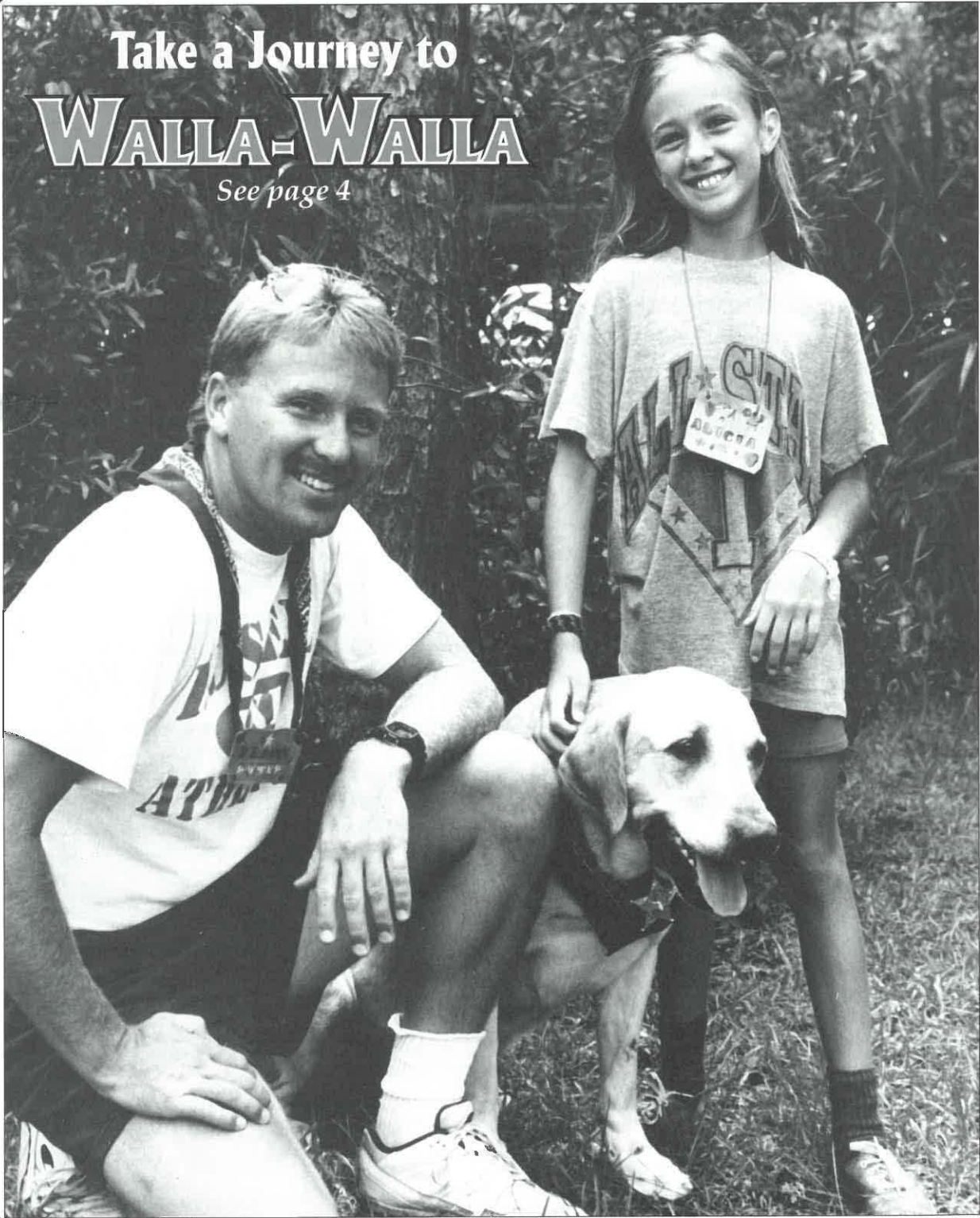

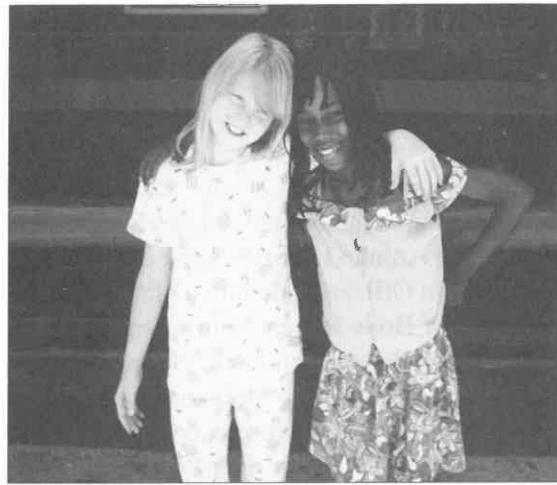

WALLA-WALLA



6:30 a.m. - Rising

The sun is still quietly resting below the horizon, patches of fog layer the dark, morning air. Ten inhabitants of the Walla-Walla campsite rise from their tents to start the day. Busily stretching and straightening, the girls neatly complete their chores and prepare for the activities that lay ahead . . .

7:30 a.m. - Congress

“Congress” is now in session. The sunlight of the new day is peering from wisps of clouds in the blue sky. In this gathering, the entire camp — boys, girls, counselors, and volunteer Deputy Sheriffs — join to begin their day with fresh, inspiring, positive thoughts. Goals are set and discussed, and conflicts are resolved. Only self-

esteem, self-confidence building, positive thoughts are allowed to enter the boys and girls hearts each morning. “I’m going to ride a horse today,” one Walla-Walla girl announces. “I will pass my swim-

ming test,” says another. “I love my counselor, she’s my friend.”

8:00 a.m. - Breakfast

Breakfast! A morning prayer and the Walla-Wallas sit down to plentiful plates of golden eggs, sizzling bacon, jellied biscuits, buttered grits, and hash-browned potatoes — their first meal of the day — here they learn the importance of family, as everyone dines together. Cooperation and manners are expected and play a key factor in their development. “Please, pass the biscuits,” followed by a “Thank You” is echoed around the table without fail.

8:45 a.m. - Canoeing

With satisfied stomachs the boys and girls are ready for their first morning activity — the Walla-Wallas, young ladies between the ages of 10-13, head to the lake and the Canoe Games. Always emphasizing safety, the girls strap on lifejackets and carefully file into canoes.

Three strokes right, three strokes left, three strokes right again. The canoe wanders from its path, as sometimes life does. The girls learn it takes teamwork to get back on track!

Five strokes right, one left. Four strokes right, three strokes on the left. “We’re straight again!”

Good going Walla-Walla!

10:00 a.m. - The Pool

The mid-morning sun is in full sight, the temperature rising. After finishing an early morning canoe trip, the Walla-Walla girls are on to a dip in the pool — a perfect opportunity to escape the heat.

11:15 a.m. - Recreation/Games

Drying in the near-noon sun, the girls of Walla-Walla set off on their next adventure. After a discussion of rules and regulations associated with volleyball —

from a visiting Deputy—the young ladies are ready to serve. “Out,” calls Amanda, “it’s our serve now.”

“No, it’s still our serve,” claims Marie.

“You two remember the rules,” quips Miss Ness.

Marie realizes her error and graciously hands the ball back to Amanda and her teammates — apology accepted.

The significance of cooperation, value of teamwork, and benefits of sharing, are important lessons learned — and all before the bell for lunch . . .

12:30 p.m. - Work Program

After a hearty lunch and energetic singing, our girls are assigned to “work” duty around the camp. While policing the grounds, retrieving any trash accidentally left behind, and collecting firewood for the evening’s activities, the girls of Walla-Walla are taught the importance of caring for their surroundings and the value of the work ethic — wonderful tools the boys and girls take from camp and apply back home in their personal lives.

3:00 p.m. - Horseback Riding

The pasture is green and wide. Horses graze in the field quietly, as the girls approach for a ride along the sandy trail, just on the horizon.

Given specific instructions and lessons on horseback riding techniques, each child is assigned to a particular horse. Safety, trust, and care for animals are

slowly and carefully. The others follow suit and away Walla-Walla rides, into the nearly set sun.

5:30 p.m. - Dinner

Dinnertime! And after the evening prayer, our boys and girls replenish their energy for the day's final events.

6:15 p.m. - Arts & Crafts

Following our campers we travel next to the Arts & Crafts Center. "Look what I painted," says one youngster. "See what I did, isn't my butterfly beautiful?"

Developing artistic talents is such a confidence-promoting time for the boys and girls.

7:30 p.m. - Archery

The sun has begun its descent from the sky, it's cooler now. This evening, the girls are scheduled for a round of archery. Carefully and slowly, well-instructed and trained, Walla-Walla always observes safety while on the range. What an exciting moment it is when a camper hits the target, or better, receives a bullseye for her effort.

"Miss Shelley, Miss Shelley, I got a bullseye!"

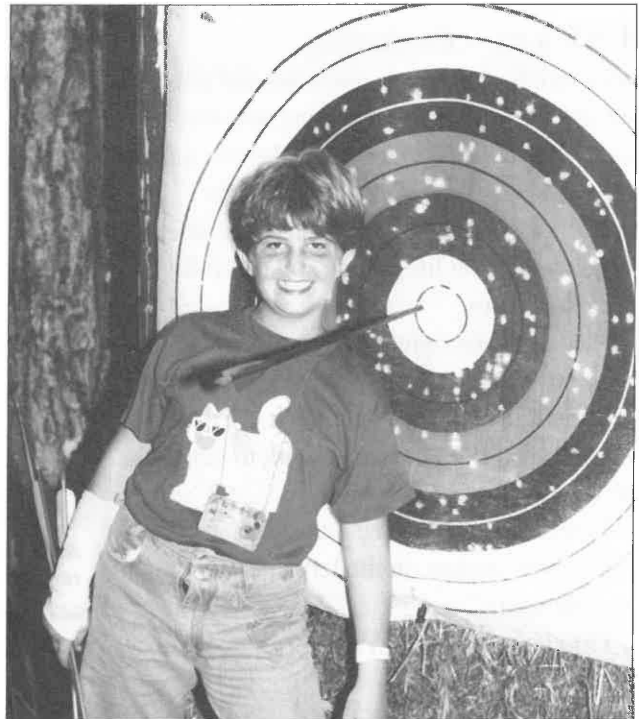
"Great job, Allison."

9:00 p.m. - Pow-Wow

The last activity of the day is finally upon our girls. The sun has fallen in the west, the sky is dark blue and purple. A fire at the campsite glows orange, lighting the night. Youth Ranches Recognizes Boys and Girls at Annual Awards Banquets

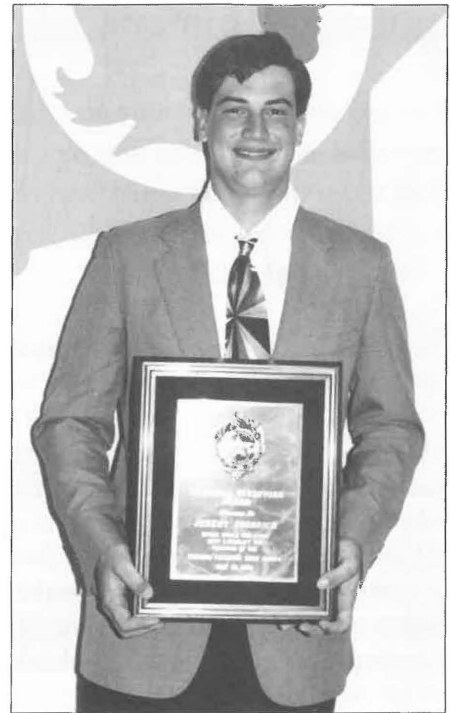
The boys looked handsome, dressed in suit and tie, polished shoes; the girls, with satin, lace, and curls in their hair, were radiant. The children were painted with smiles.

The Youth Ranches is proud to have helped make this birthday one Terrance will never forget.

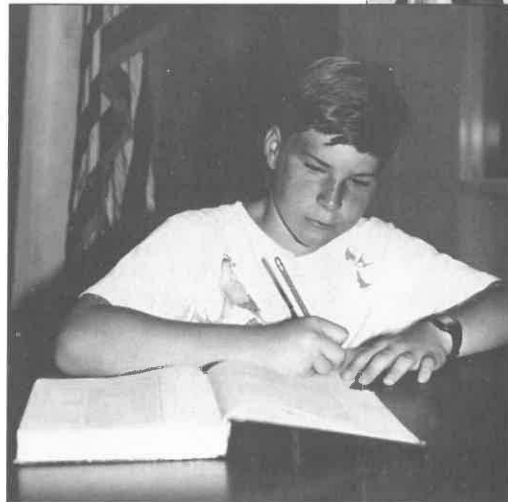

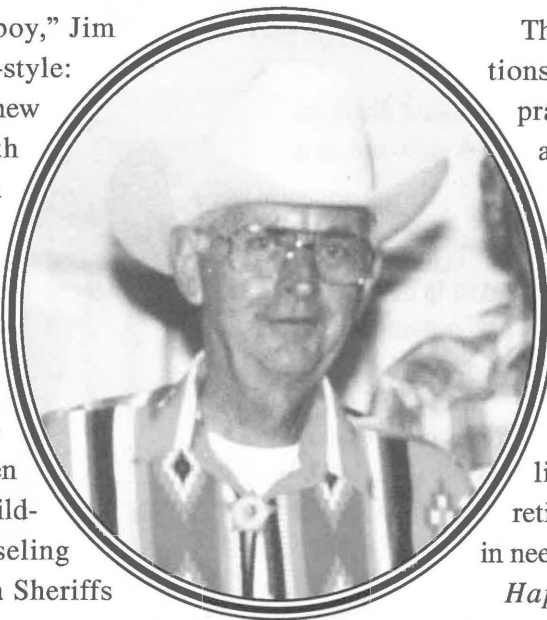

And that, they certainly do!

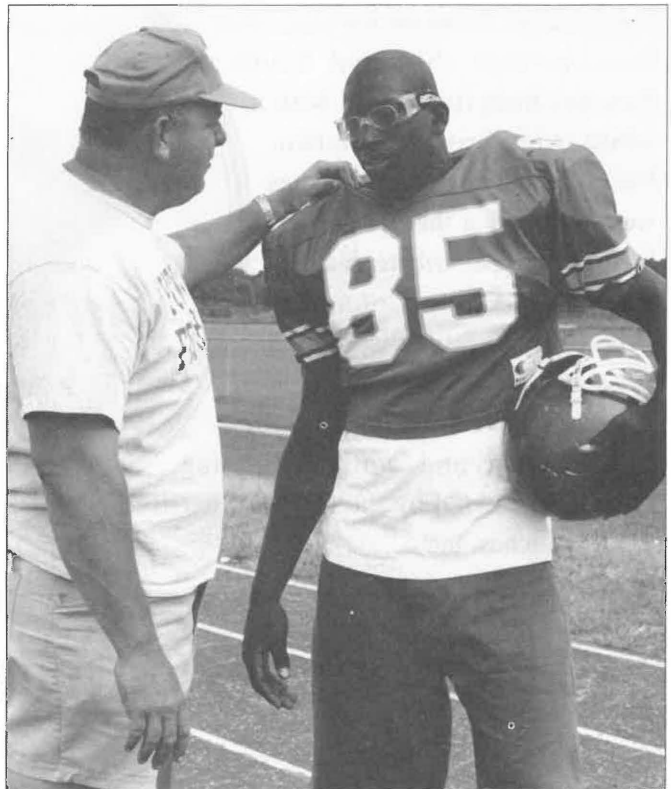

Indeed, the success Thaddeus has experienced on the court has translated into gains and accomplishments of — spending free-time with friends and teammates, devoting time learning to cook household meals for his entire cottage, and caring for roses in the garden. Thaddeus also enjoys working with other children, helping them conquer their own self doubts, form strong ambitions, and motivate them in their future. Perhaps most importantly, he delights in challenging others to change study habits and focus on improving their academic performance.

“Thaddeus knows the importance of grades,” says Mom Davis.

The charitable gift annuity allows you to give to our troubled boys and girls and also provides you and/or someone you designate with a guaranteed periodic payment for life.

A sizeable portion of your gift (cash, stocks, bonds or mutual funds) is immediately tax deductible and a portion of the periodic annuity payment is tax-free during normal life expectancy. The agreement is irrevocable and is guaranteed by the full assets of the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches, Inc.

The amount of the annuity payment is based on the amount of the gift and the age of the annuitant. Typically,

the older you are, the greater the payment.

Organizations that are permitted to issue gift annuity agreements are required by state and federal law to meet stringent financial standards. The Youth Ranches was the first organization in the state of Florida to receive a permit number, which is DAAP-74-1.

The American Council on Gift Annuities meets every three years to establish the uniform gift annuity rates. The Youth Ranches is a sponsoring organization of this group.

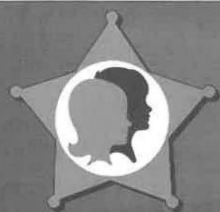

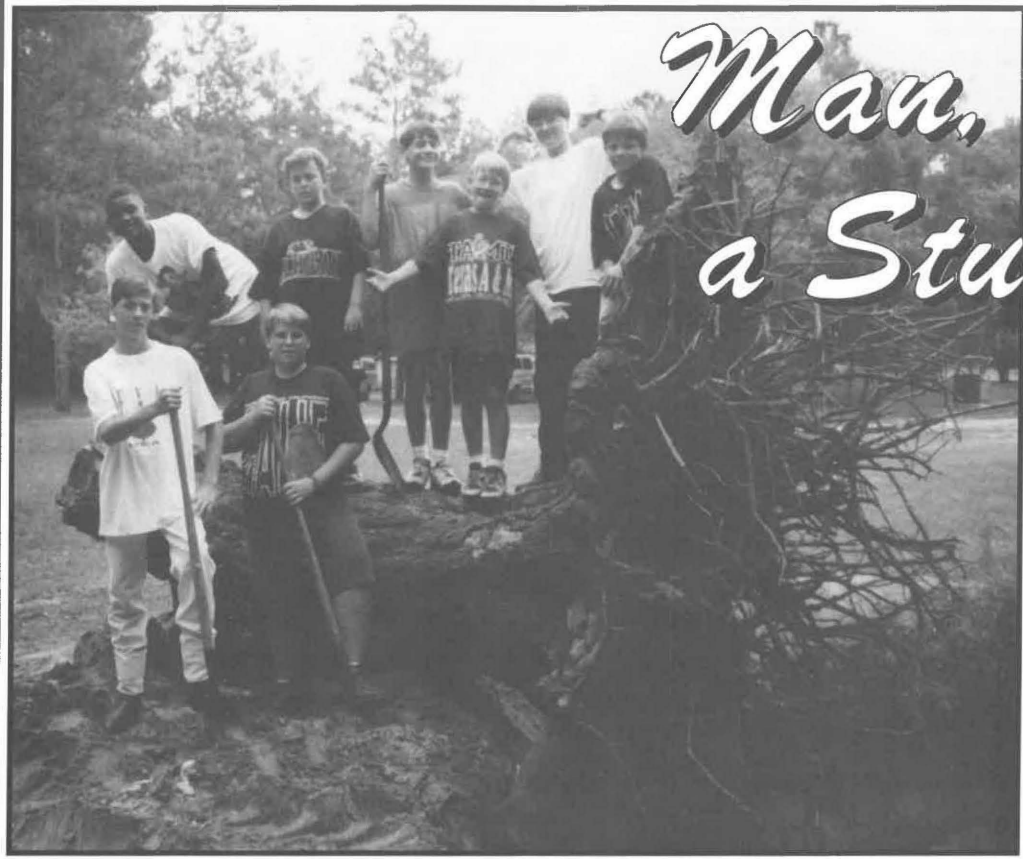

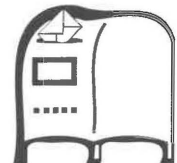
