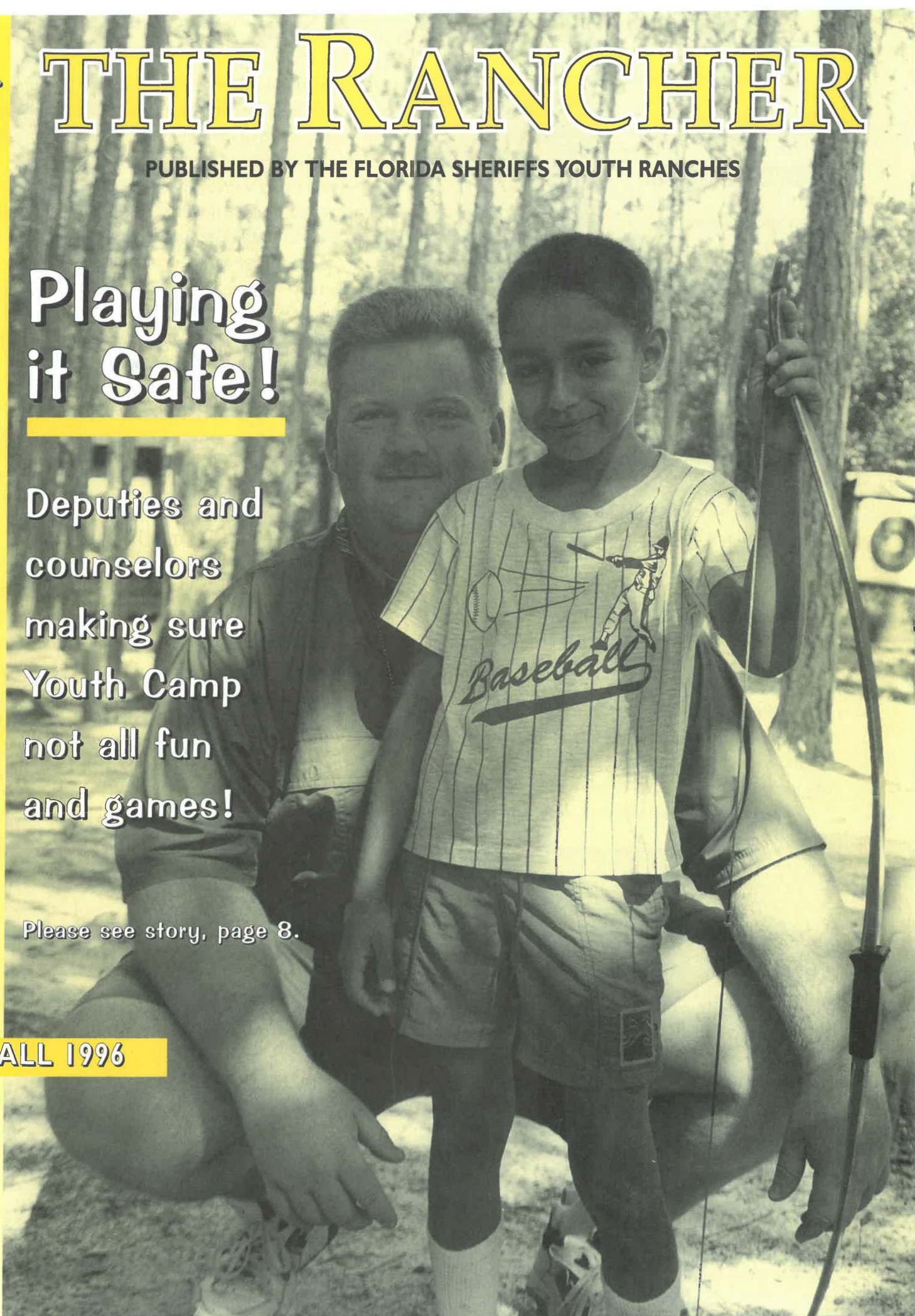

While eating dinner with some of the boys at their cottage recently, one young man shared his story.

Adam is 15-years old and arrived at the Boys Ranch several months ago because he was beyond the control of his parents - associating with kids who were experimenting with drugs, driving dangerously, and getting into trouble.

Adam told me he and his friends were very close. They went everywhere and did everything together - that is, until he came to live at the Ranch. This was his decision, and the opportunity of a lifetime.

Adam was typical of most boys in his cottage. He was polite as he guided me through the living room, kitchen, laundry area, and the rest of his new "home." He did this all with pride and spoke with respect. He has learned so much since coming to the Boys Ranch.

Along the way, we stopped at his room where a

momento reminded him of his past and his old friends. With a careful voice, he told me about a fatal car wreck, one that involved high speed and resulted in untimely death.

In so many words, Adam said, "The Boys Ranch saved my life. I would have been with them that day." Instead, he was at the Ranch, in school, with caring teachers, cottage parents, and other young men working to make a better life.

Adam is so grateful to Florida's Sheriffs, the Youth Ranches, its donors, and all of the others who care for him. So am I. Thank you.

Working to Promote 'Peace'

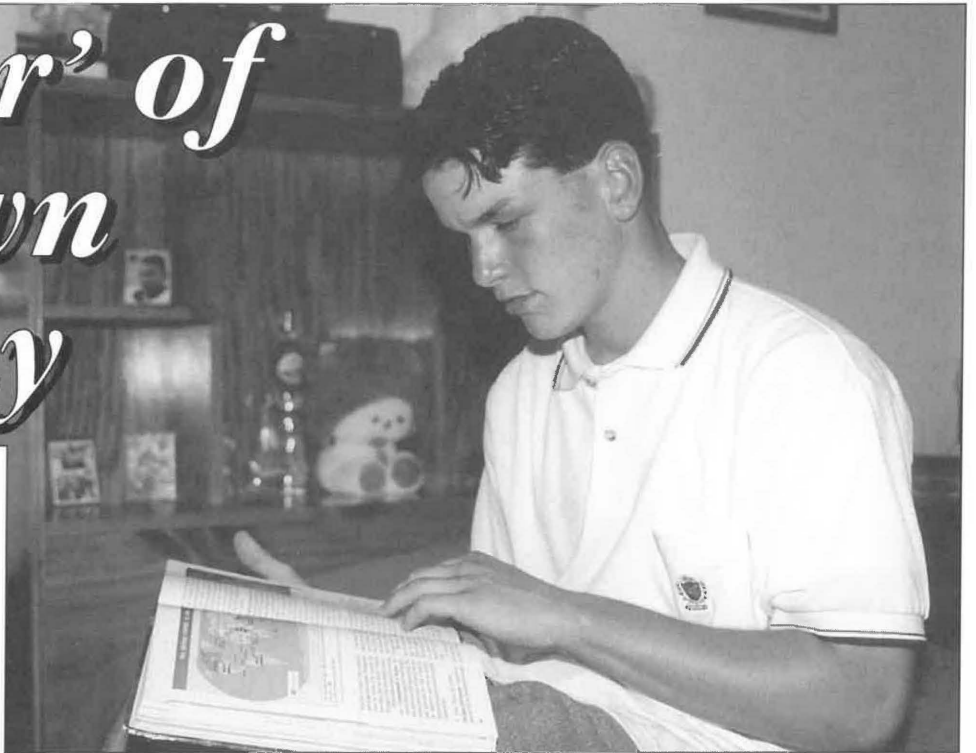

'Master' of His Own Destiny

Ranchers like Anthony are working hard to improve school grades, curb troublesome behavior, expand social skills, and learn proper communication skills. Thanks to careful counseling and thoughtful guidance, troubled youth are reaching for brighter stars along the horizon.



Where in the world would he be without you? Rancher Anthony brushes up on some Geography homework. Once flirting with academic failure, maintaining a poor D-minus grade point average while three full grade levels behind in his coursework, Anthony has turned his life around thanks to careful counseling and newfound friends. Today, Anthony consistently achieves Honor Roll and is looking forward to attending college.

Living A Virtual Reality

After a long-term separation from both biological parents, Anthony had been virtually living the life of an orphan.

"When Anthony came to the Ranch, he displayed many of the same troubles most of our kids are often forced to face," says Youth Ranch/Safety Harbor Director of Education Warren Swiger. "Defiance, poor behavior, and low grades were just some of the obstacles he had to commit to overcome."

Angry at the world and frustrated, Anthony was on the verge of academic collapse. With nearly 60 referrals during one school year and a poor D-minus grade point average, Anthony was spiraling toward despair, in desperate need of positive reinforcement and special guidance. "I was getting in a lot of fights," admits Anthony. "I wasn't very interested in school; I was causing a lot of trouble."

A Lot of Talking, a Lot of Time

Basketball, football, fishing, and newfound friends helped Anthony begin his deliberate and miraculous transformation. Therapy and counseling as well as patience and positive role models all played a part in Anthony's continued development. "Anthony has been making such a tremendous effort," smiles Mr. Swiger. "It's taken a lot of talking, a lot of time, but his progress has been quite remarkable."

Beating 56-to-1 Odds

Since last summer, Anthony has been vastly improving his personal and peer relationships, participating enthusiastically in the Youth Ranch program, and busy earning a

reputation of reliability and honesty.

Through a newly discovered commitment to excellence, Anthony has steadily progressed in his schoolwork, advancing from three grade levels behind, and consistently appearing on the Honor Roll List. Today, overachieving is Anthony's fresh objective. Safety Harbor Middle School "Winning Warrior" and "Turnaround Student of the Year" as well as Youth Ranches awards for volunteer service, leadership, and special achievement have replaced the negative awards of misconduct. "Before, I had 56 dean referrals in one year," admits Anthony, acknowledging maturely his past problems and mistakes. "Last year, I had only **one** . . . just a simple misunderstanding."

Role Reversal

"When you do good rather than bad, people look at you differently," observes Anthony. "When you set goals, change your attitude, things really get easier and you realize everyone is just out to help."

With caring counselors and faithful friends like School Resource Officer Steve Hochenell standing at his side for guidance and support, Anthony has demonstrated phenomenal potential and has developed into a valuable role model for others who may be just beginning their long journeys to positive improvement. "A lot of the kids we have in residence will now approach Anthony for advice and guidance," says Mr. Swiger. "He especially offers support to newer kids just entering the Ranch. He's certainly become a powerful, positive role model."

Like many of the boys and girls in our care around the state, Anthony truly believes he would have eventually landed in prison if the Youth Ranches had not helped and offered a haven for reform.

"The Ranch is like a family," says Anthony. "The boys, the counselors . . . at the Ranch, I have true friends."

Reeling In New Hope, Full of Promise

In August, and with mixed emotions, Anthony graduates from the Youth Ranches residential program having met all of the goals he had set out to accomplish, and returns to live with his grandmother and sister. Filled with new hope and full of promise, he says, "I'll miss the Ranch and all the friends I've made. But, I know it's time to move on. I know my grandmother will take good care of me and my sister; she's always been there for us and given us a home when we've needed it most."

This past summer, Anthony received a special recognition when he was awarded a two-year Florida Association of School Resource Officers Scholarship. It will help him get a head start on his college education four years from now. "I'd like to go to college, Florida State," Anthony

smiles, performing the Seminole "chop" with his right hand and elbow. "I'd like to study communications and advertising, which will help me with my real dream . . . becoming a professional fisherman, a *Bassmaster*."

Having fished since he was three-years old, the largest catch Anthony ever reeled in was a 10-pound, 37-inch carp.

"I think fishing has given Anthony the chance to mature, relax, and strive for reachable goals," says Mom Field, one of Anthony's caring cottage parents. "It's really given him the opportunity to take time-out occasionally and think about his actions; really think about the future."

Education is the cornerstone of a productive and fruitful future. With knowledge and wisdom, children can accomplish their dreams and lead us

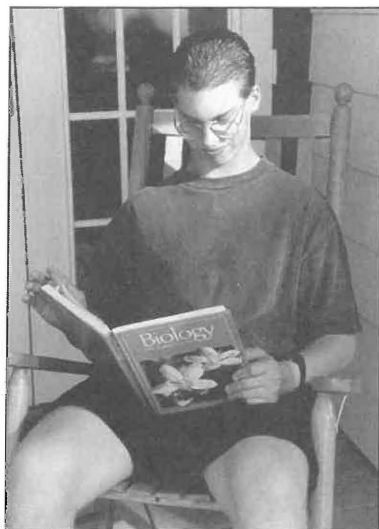

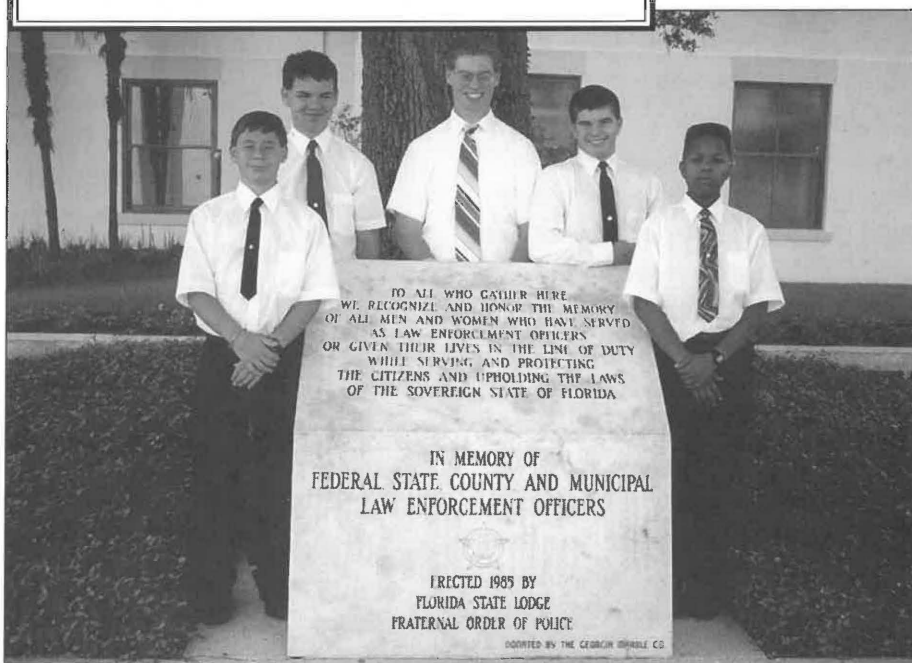

Capitol Travelers! (L-R) Ranchers Robby, Joey, David, Lacious, and Mike prepare for their guided tour of the Capitol Building.

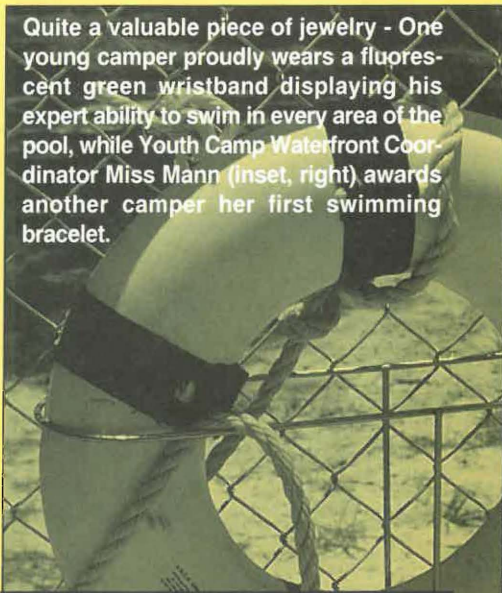

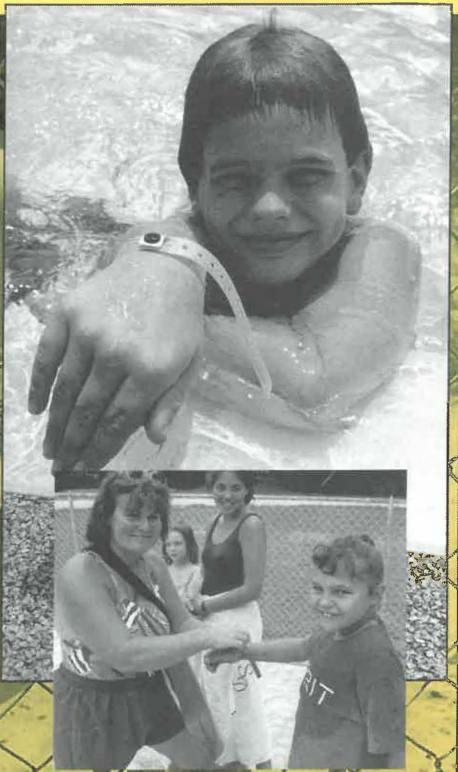
woman plead for life, the boys received a firsthand account of the high cost of doing wrong," says Pop Stump. "Now, more than ever, these young men realize where the road

But, like any daily activity, boys and girls must learn to act responsibly and within the acceptable framework of society, respecting rules and regulations enacted to maintain personal safety. Thanks to carefully trained counselors and dedicated Deputy Sheriffs, youngsters are learning not only how to play, but also how to . . .

... Play it Safe!

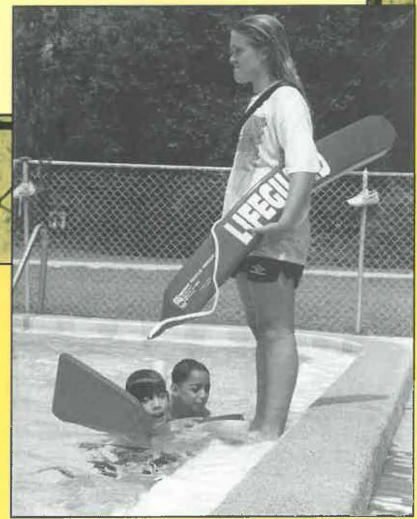
“Most of our pool rules are basic, every day precautions; very common sense stuff,” says Youth Camp Coordinator Phil Shults. “But, you’d be surprised how many of our kids have never even seen or been in or near a pool in their lives. It’s very important for them, and all our youngsters, to know and respect the rules that we have in place to protect them.”

On the initial day of camp, every boy and girl, before they are permitted to swim freely throughout particular areas of the campus pool, are placed through a comprehensive, three-step test to measure their swimming ability. A successful paddle across the shallow-end earns a camper one red wristband. A successful lap across the center of the pool earns a yellow-coded counterpart. And, if a camper can swim clear across the deepest end and tread water for ten complete seconds, he/she will earn their fluorescent green bracelet which allows them access to any area of the pool at any time during their swimming period.

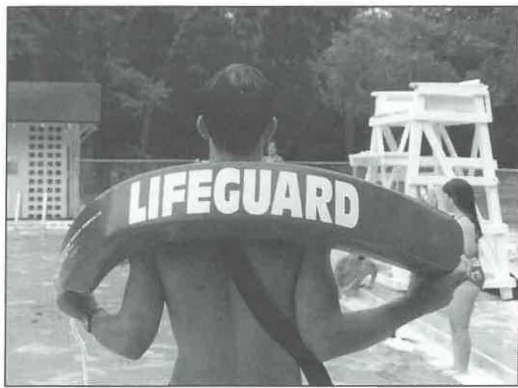
- ### Knowing pool rules can be a real life-saver!
1. Absolutely NO running on the pool deck.
 2. Absolutely NO flipping into the pool.
 3. Absolutely NO fighting.
 4. Always share the pool “toys.”
 5. Always shower before entering the pool.
 6. Always receive eardrops before exiting the pool area.
 7. Always stop swimming when a lifeguard blows his/her whistle.
 8. Always remember - Have a Good Time!



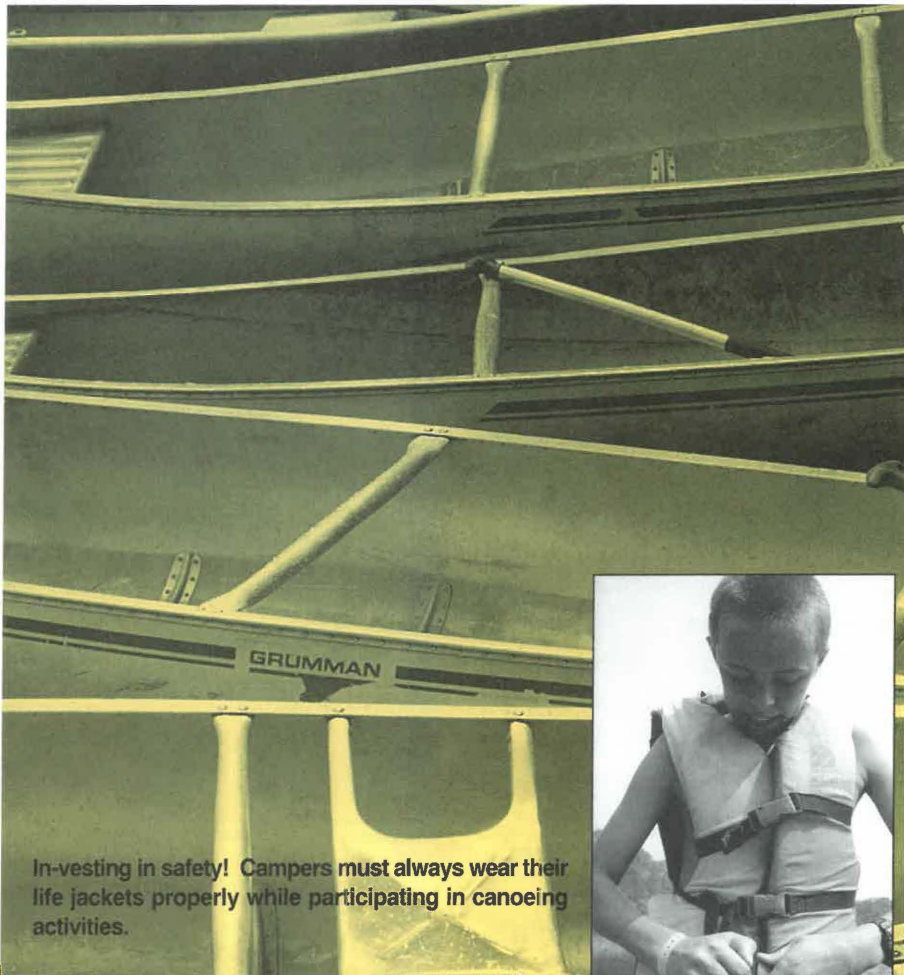
At the Florida Sheriffs Youth Camp, proper health and safety precautions are always practiced, like receiving routine eardrops to fight possible post-pool infections.

Youngsters, according to the color of their wristband, must remain in their own designated swimming depths. This maintains a greater level of safety and allows particular swimmers to build self-esteem and self-confidence by practicing to earn more advanced, color-coded bracelets. Of course, throughout the initial swim tests and during the entire summer of pool activities, certified lifeguards are always stationed in strategic posts surrounding the pool deck, enforcing specific rules, and always prepared to handle an emergency, should a rare accident occur.

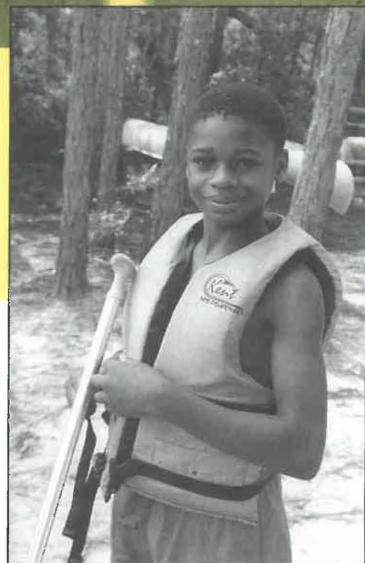
If you don't want to miss this boat - Jacket Is Required!

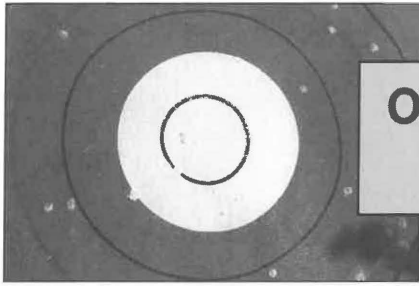
“There are really only two main rules I emphasize out here,” says Youth Camp Waterfront Coordinator Miss Mann. “One, always wear your life jacket in the canoe, and two, never stand up in the boat.”

Like all of the normal precautions observed at the pool location, campers at the lake are given a 20-minute course covering basic canoe instruction and safety information. Before youths are ever permitted to leave shore, they are taught proper paddle usage and technique and embarking and disembarking practices. They are reminded to remain with their canoe in the event it capsizes, and they are also required to practice swimming with their life vests in place. As always, well-trained life-



guards, counselors, and Deputies canoe with campers or are close at hand to maintain a high level of safety and enjoyment at all times.





Observing safety on the archery range is always main target!

Centuries ago, the most accurate and talented archers were held in the highest regard and with the utmost respect by their villagers. Today, the art of archery is practiced for fun and sport, but its ancient traditions can still hold popular lessons, teaching important values like concentration, posturing, and self-respect.

"The beauty of archery," says Youth Camp Archery Instructor Miss Gallant, "is that anybody, of any age, can do it . . . it is truly a mental sport, not physical."

In any sporting activity, rules are employed to ensure fun, fairness, and safety. Those factors are especially true with the bow and arrow.

RULE #1 - Always walk, never run around the range.

RULE #2 - Always stay on "Pow-Wow" logs when not shooting on range.

RULE #3 - Always aim arrows downrange or at the ground.

RULE #4 - Never approach targets until everyone has finished firing.

And what are the consequences if any of these rules are mistakenly broken?

"An archer will sit out a round."

And then?

"An archer will sit out one class."

Although enforcement is seldom necessary, proper regulations are in position to teach responsibility, respect, and safety.



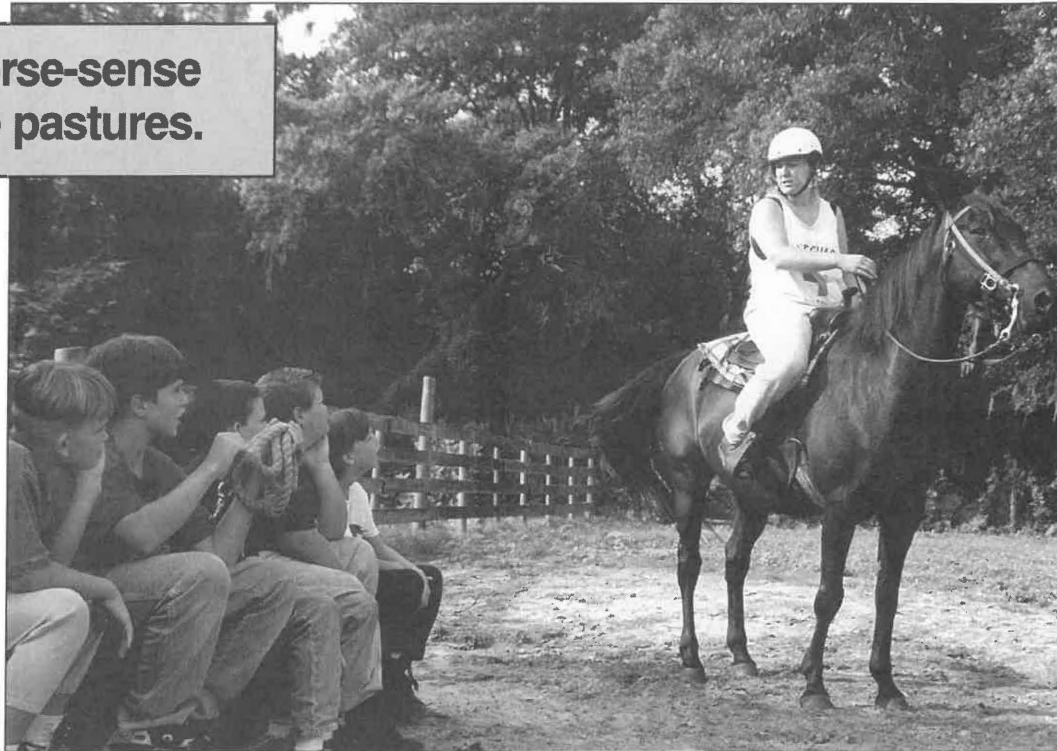
Better use real horse-sense when riding in the pastures.



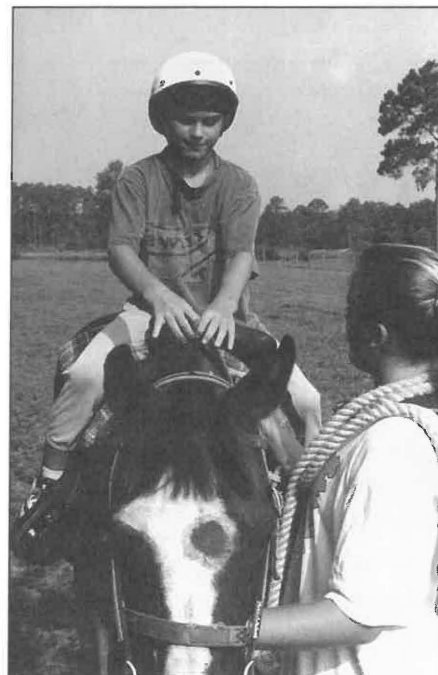
Horseback-riding is one of the few camp activities in which campers must rely on something else, rather than someone else, for their safety and enjoyment.

"All of our horses are so well-trained and very well-behaved," says Youth Camp Riding Coordinator Miss Billick. "I always tell the kids, just because something is bigger than you or a little scary, it doesn't mean you can't overcome your fear and/or learn to control it."

Before campers are allowed to even groom a horse, they must know how to approach it: Always approach a horse from the left, always on the left, and get up on the left! Extensive classes in horsemanship teach boys and girls the proper way to saddle a horse and mount; that they must always remain calm and docile around horses because they will do what you do . . . if you jump, they will jump; that you always push a horse away from yourself, it's safer; that horses respond to sweet "kissy" sounds; and, that riders must always wear their helmets! Prior to a camp-ending trail ride, youth are required to simply walk with their animals in order to practice these safety precau-

tions. All of our youngsters learn patience and self-control through the performance and practice of horsemanship skills.

A Second "Vantastic" Gift!

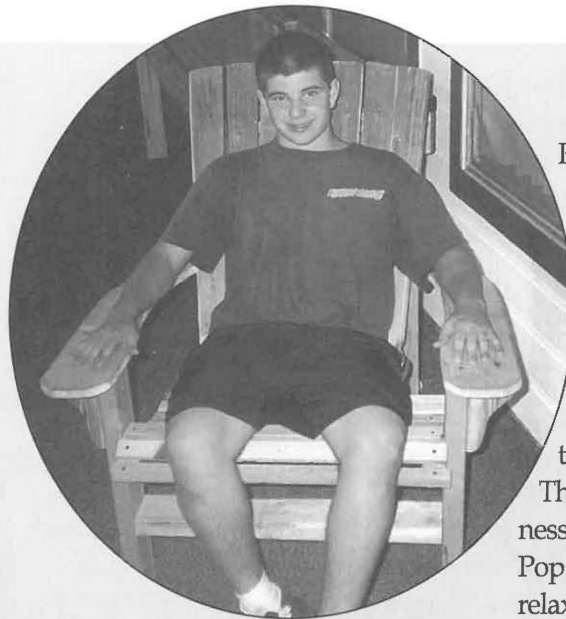

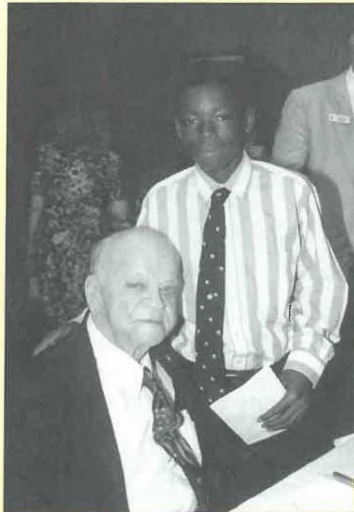


Frances Blackburn rooted firmly in our Hearts and Memories

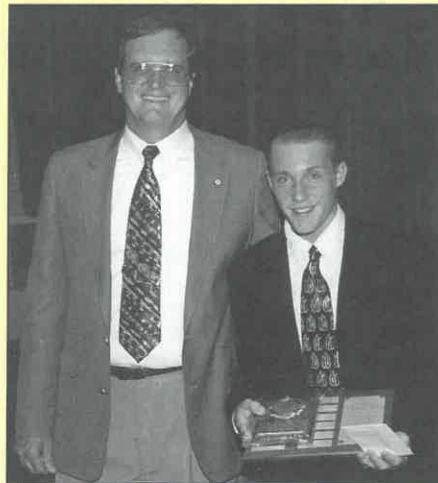

Charitable Gift Annuity



The charitable gift annuity allows you to give to our troubled boys and girls and also provides you and/or someone you designate with a reliable income for life.

A sizeable portion of your gift (cash, stocks, bonds, or mutual funds) is immediately tax deductible and a portion of the annuity income is tax-free during normal life expectancy. The agreement is irrevocable and is supported by the assets of the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches, Inc.

The amount of the annuity income is based on the

amount of the gift and the age of the annuitant. Typically, the older you are, the greater the amount you receive.

Organizations permitted to issue gift annuity agreements are required by state law to meet stringent financial standards. The Youth Ranches was the first organization in the state of Florida to receive a permit number, which is DAAP-74-1.

The American Council on Gift Annuities meets every three years to establish the uniform gift annuity rates. The Youth Ranches is a sponsoring organization of this group.

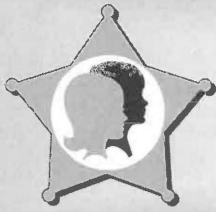

We want our donors to know that we have never permitted other organizations to use our lists of supporters, and we will continue to do everything possible to preserve their privacy.

This Honor Roll gives special recognition to generous supporters of the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches and its six child-care programs: the Florida Sheriffs Boys Ranch,

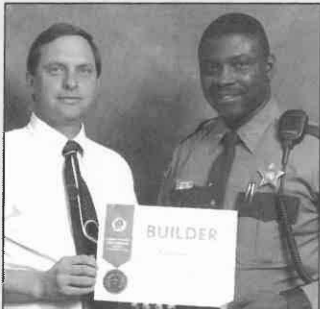

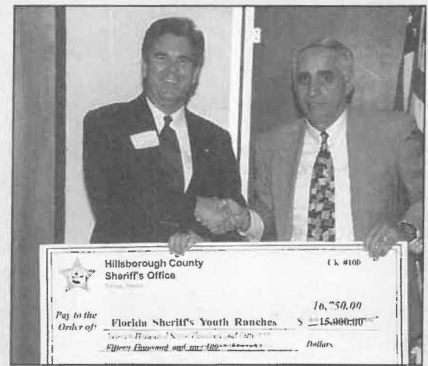
