When the name Carl Stauffer comes to mind, I think of a man who helped prepare the way for the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches. He was there in 1957 when the Boys Ranch was founded, recruited Harry Weaver in 1961, and wrote *The Rancher* magazine that recorded our history and promoted the success of our boys and girls.

HONOR AND DUTY

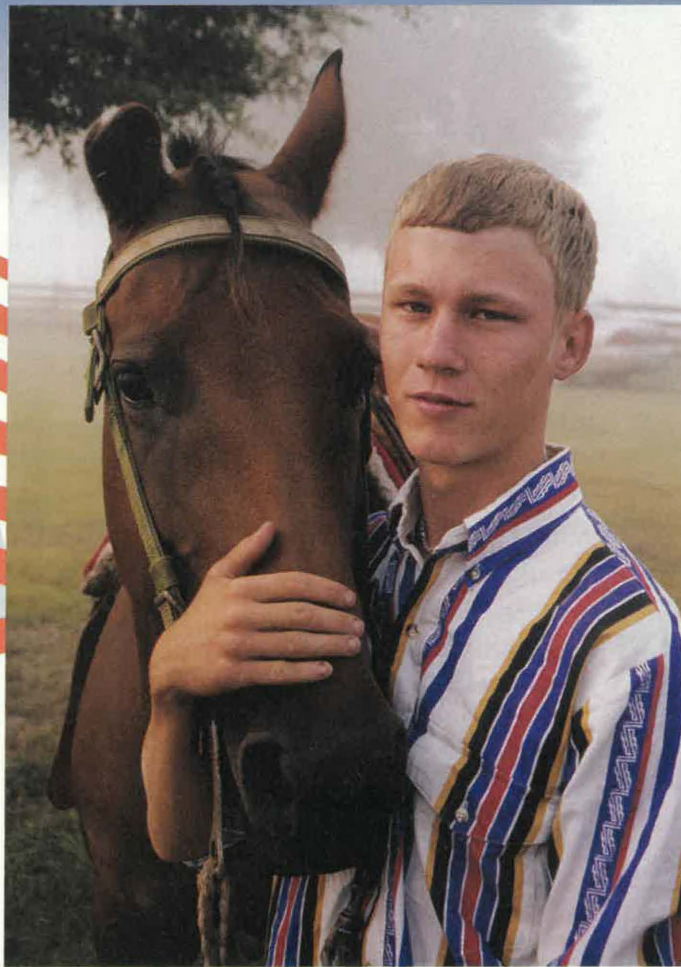
As he stood with honor before the Sheriffs of Florida in his crisp, immaculate uniform, Airman Charles "Chuck" Register drew a deep breath and smiled slightly. He knew why he was here...his duty was clear – it was time to say "thank you" and tell these men about the difference they made in his life!

With a strong, confident voice, he began to describe his past. Chuck explained that his mother and father were not around much during his teenage years. He moved around from place to place and typically wore out his welcome pretty fast. In fact, Chuck was literally living with neighbors when a school counselor suggested he consider moving to the Florida Sheriffs Boys Ranch.

At first, the idea did not appeal to him – moving into a home with nine other boys. But, after an initial visit and a good look at the farm, Chuck figured it wouldn't be that bad. He liked horses, the large cottages were beautiful and he really didn't have anywhere else to go.

Chuck was a hard worker and immediately got a job at the Ranch. He passed the tractor test and took great pride in caring for the animals. School was ok, but there were many days he tried to get out early by convincing the teacher of some great need for his help at the farm. All that time driving the tractor would come in handy in the military.

Halfway through his senior year, Chuck returned to his hometown and obtained his high school diploma. He enlisted in the Air Force and headed off to basic training. Currently assigned to McGuire Air

He had the flag folded, framed and certified, then carefully carried it all the way home for presentation to Youth Ranches President Roger Bouchard.

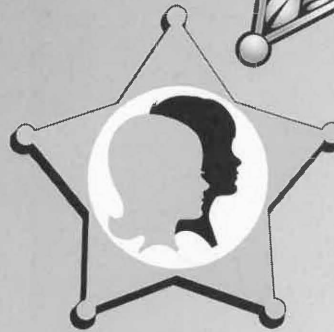

Since 1957, the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches has been "fighting the good fight" to prevent juvenile delinquency.

With the generous help of many caring donors, the Sheriffs of Florida designed and built Youth Ranches where wayward boys and girls could learn to become productive, law abiding citizens. Today, this statewide network of residential campuses, family counseling and camping services has proven to be a highly effective way to break the cycle of delinquency and abuse.

As we approach our 50th Anniversary, Florida's

Sheriffs have made a collective commitment to invite some of their most faithful friends to leave a legacy to care for the next generation of children. The goal of the Sheriffs Endowment Challenge is to build the Endowment Fund to \$50 million by 2007...but they can't do it alone.

The Youth Ranches is looking for individuals who are willing to make a substantial commitment to help prevent delinquency and protect the future of Florida's children.

Over the years, there have been occasions when there was not enough money to pay for the care of our children. This created stressful scenarios that forced us to temporarily close cottages and lay off staff. These difficult times convinced us a strong Endowment Fund is one way to ensure a stable and consistent source of income for the children we serve.

Each irrevocable gift commitment of \$50,000 or more will receive special recognition by the Sheriffs of Florida and be named as a Golden Anniversary Honorary Endowment Benefactor of the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches. Additional honors are available to those who surpass this level of charitable giving.

With an emphasis on traditional family values and the basics of a good education, we believe many "at-risk" youth will choose to earn their living in productive work rather than rely on a life of crime or depend on public welfare.

As our children grow into healthy young men and women, we want them to accept responsibility for their behavior, build a brighter future for themselves and become successful parents who provide for their families.

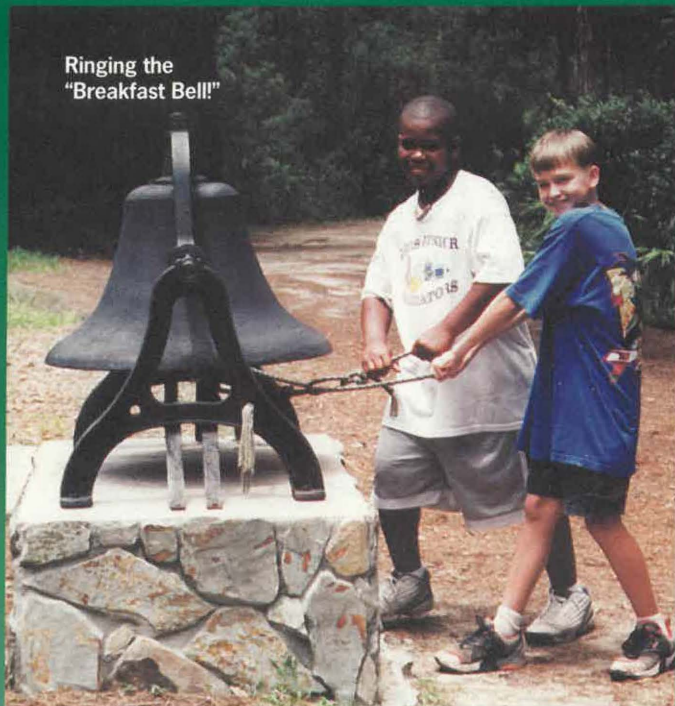

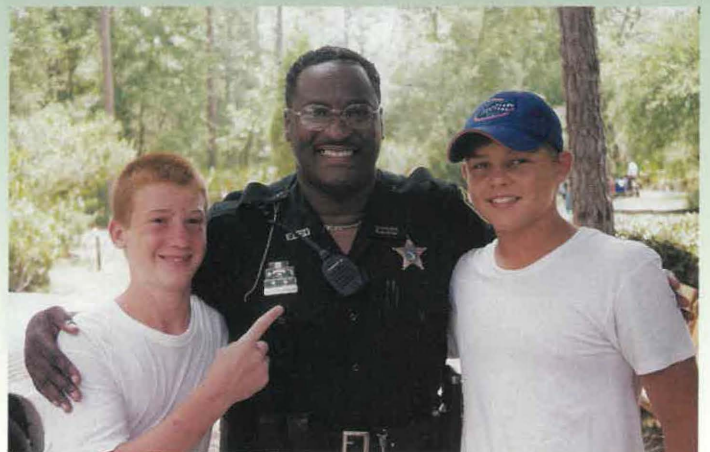


With a jump and a spin or a mask and a fin, these boys really enjoy spending time cooling off in the swimming pool.

Clay County Sheriffs Office Helps Turn Metal Into Money!

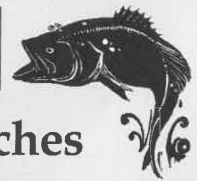

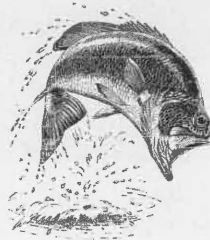
Leon County Sheriff Larry Campbell presented a very large check to the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches represented by Alison Evans and Roger Bouchard.

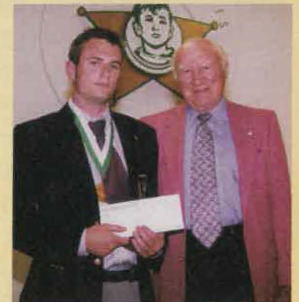

Q: What is the relationship between the Florida Sheriffs Association and the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches?

The mission of the **Florida Sheriffs Association** is to foster and enhance effective law enforcement activities through educational and charitable efforts including the prevention of crime, the apprehension of criminals, and the protection of the life and property of the citizens of Florida. It is located in Tallahassee and works closely with the 67 Sheriffs of Florida. The Florida Sheriffs Association is the founding organization of the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches.

The Florida Sheriffs Association is made up of Honorary, Business, and Law Enforcement Members who pay yearly dues of \$20. The Florida Sheriffs Association actively supports the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches and other law enforcement related programs.



The mission of the **Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches** is to prevent juvenile delinquency and develop lawful, productive citizens through a broad range of family centered services. We have four residential sites, two camps, and three Opportunity Stores located throughout Florida. We provide residential services, camping services, family counseling services and other delinquency prevention programs to meet the changing needs of Florida's children and families.

The Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches accepts donations in any amounts and uses these gifts to support the children in our care. Voluntary gifts are a primary source of funding. Charitable gifts, bequests, wills and trusts can be earmarked to benefit any of the statewide programs.

The Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches is nationally accredited by the Council on Accreditation of Services for Families and Children, Inc. and the American Camping Association. Since 1957, the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches has touched the lives of over 55,000 boys, girls, and their families.

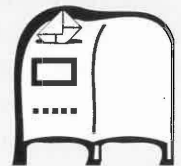

Sponsored by some very generous charitable contributions, sites for these special camps are selected based on the needs of the community and the advice of the local Sheriff.

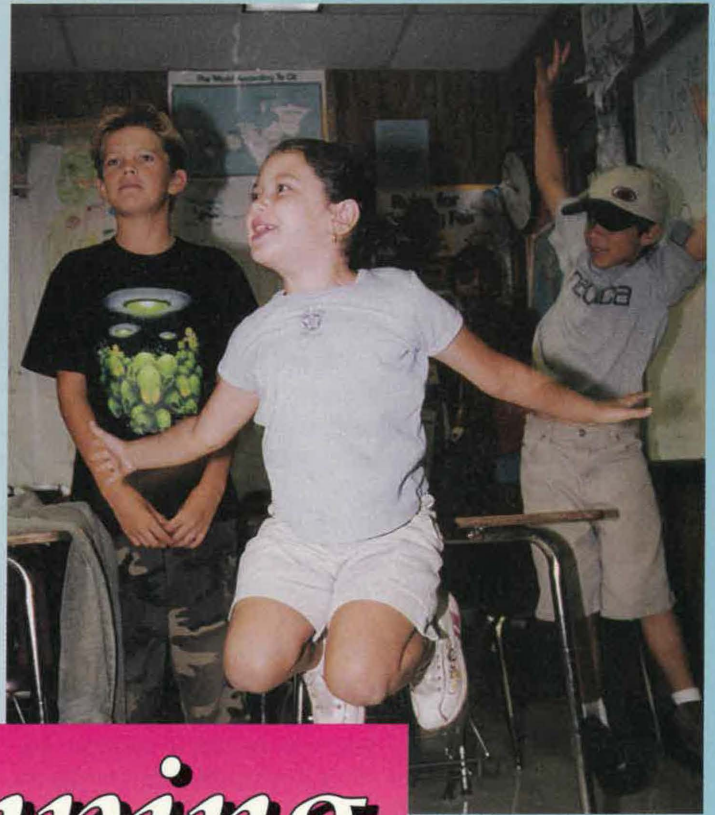
Because it is located so close to their homes, the local children flock to participate in this free summer day camp.

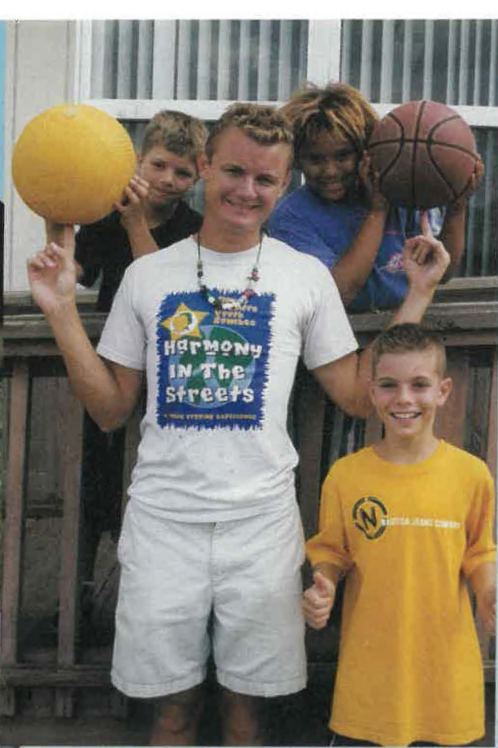
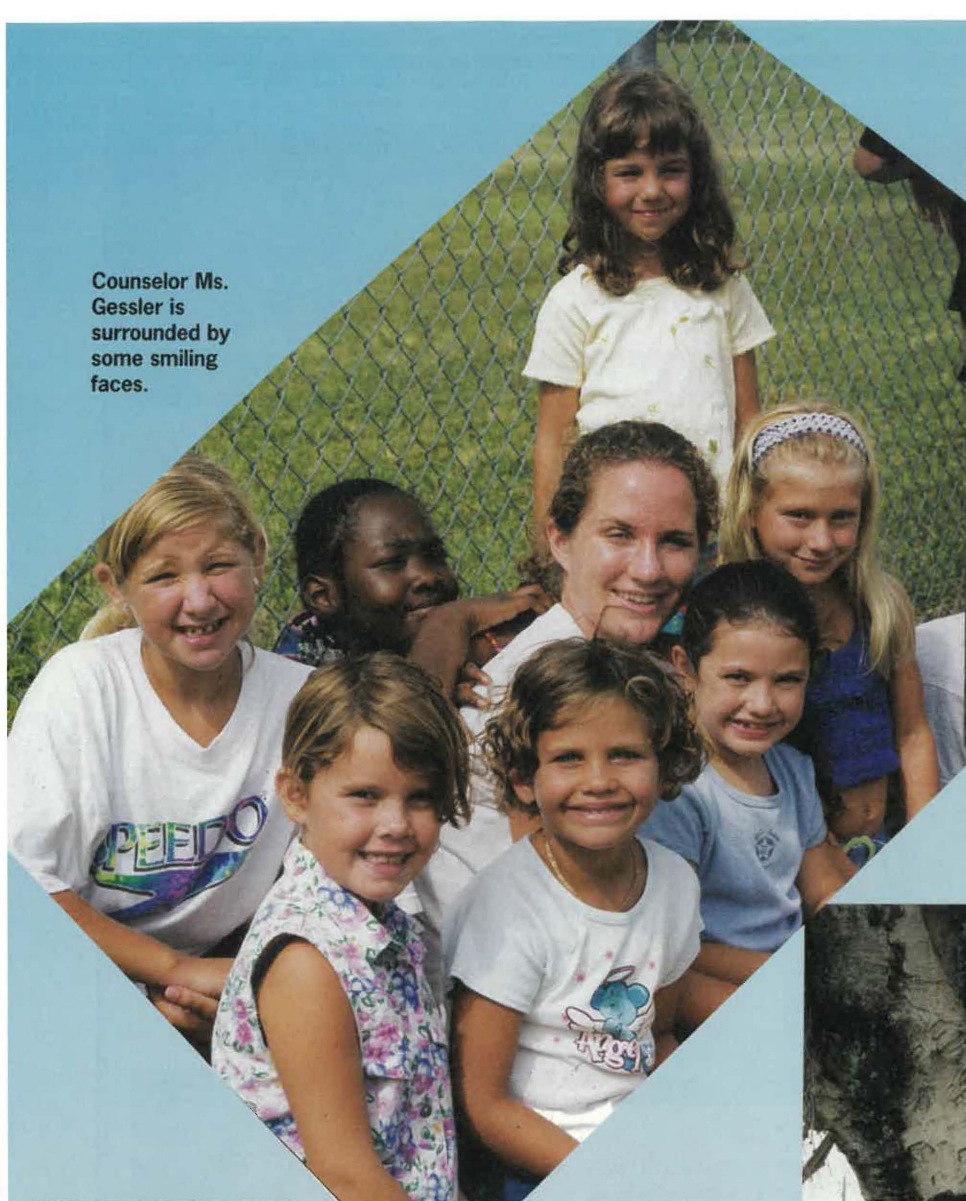
situations if they were not at camp. The financial support you send makes a significant difference in the life of a deserving child.

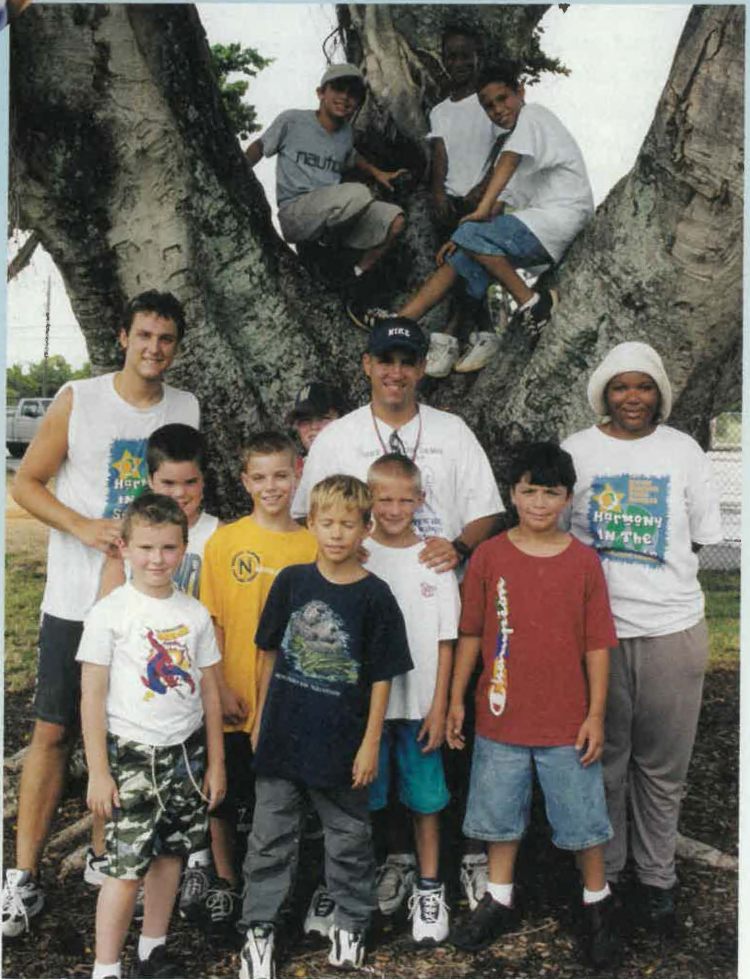

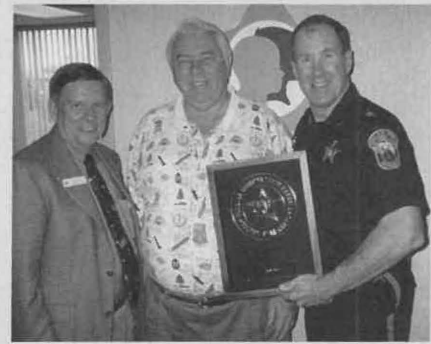


