

ust over one year ago, Jessica came to live at the Youth Ranch in Safety Harbor. Initially, she had been offered the opportunity to live in a cottage on campus geared toward independent living. She had obtained her GED and yearned for the freedom of adulthood.

However, with that freedom, also came responsibility. Jessica quickly realized she would be much more successful in a more structured environment. She transferred to a different cottage with a bit more supervision and guidance.

Jessica thrived in this new setting. She enrolled in St. Petersburg College and began to take a few basic courses. She soon expressed an interest in caring for animals and obtained a job at the local Humane Society.

"I really enjoy working with the cats and dogs. Some of them have been abused and abandoned; others are brought here because their owners just can't care for them any longer," said Jessica. "I want to become a 'Vet Tech' and I think this experience will help me reach that goal."

Jessica has received praise for her dedication from both her supervisor and her Cottage Parents. Working full time and going to school part time, she has demonstrated great

I know I do not have my license, but please don't disqualify me for that. I have just about enough <money> saved for insurance and I am researching driving schools. I am trying to schedule time to take the drug and alcohol (required) classes. I cannot depend on any family member to help me get started with a car or insurance...I have

## What to Bring

### \*Modest Attire Required

# Summer Camp: An Adventurous Journey for Three Brothers

Hiking, canoeing, camp fires, and high ropes are just a few ingredients for Summer Camp at the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches. For brothers Eric, Kyle, and Ridge, camp means an adventure away from home and doing things they love to do. "We get to do neat stuff, the horseback riding, archery, and canoeing are awesome," said Ridge (9). "I enjoy being outdoors and learning about nature," Kyle (10) added.

Summer Camp is designed for boys and girls who normally do not have the opportunity to attend other summer programs. Kids from across the state come to participate in this weeklong program that emphasizes team building, peer relations, communication, and self-confidence. The summer camp program this year served hundreds of children just like Eric, Kyle, and Ridge.

Camp also gives kids the chance to build positive relationships with law enforcement officers. Deputies volunteer their time to work alongside camp staff as they lead, teach, and mentor the children. Deputy Carol Arbitelle of the Indian River County Sheriff's Office has worked with the camping program for seven years in a row. "It's great to be with the kids and see the joy and happiness on their faces as they participate in the activities throughout the week," stated Arbitelle.

At the end of each day, campers gather with their group and counselors around the camp fire for an evening "pow wow." They talk about what they learned throughout the day and how they can apply those lessons to their daily lives. The oldest brother Eric (13) proclaimed camp helped him grow as a person. "I am proud of what I have accomplished and it makes me feel good when I achieve new things." He realized swimming was a talent he never knew he had, until earning the title "fastest swimmer" of his group.

Kyle added, "Camp is fun, it is a great place to meet new friends and learn how to get along with others. The deputies are pretty cool, too."




At the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches Summer Camp, we understand that some kids need more than just "time to play," they also need attentive adults to teach them "how to play."

# 100 Years of Good Living!

Charles Klotz celebrated his 100th birthday in a very special way. Surrounded by friends, Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches President Roger Bouchard and Orange County Undersheriff Malone Stewart presented Mr. Klotz with the Golden Star award at a surprise party held for him at the Orlando Elks Lodge.

Born in 1904 in New York City, Charles grew up amid erratic economic times

including the Roaring 20's and the Great Depression. Leaving school after the 8<sup>th</sup> grade to help support his family, Charles learned the value of hard work. He also understood the meaning of heartache when his mother passed away. He was only 14 years old.

As he grew up, Charles began making miniature replicas of World War II airplanes. He devoted over 1800 hours to the project, often using intricate

tools and two bristle paint brushes. He later donated this incredible collection to the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches.

Charles' interest in the military continued and he joined the Navy in 1942, serving as a Second Class Petty Officer hydraulics specialist. After completing his tour of duty, Charles began a successful career in real estate and soon sought out a charity he could trust.

Being familiar with the ways of a teenager struggling to survive during tough times, Charles wanted to extend a helping hand to deserving boys and girls. He decided to support the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches in 1975 because we guide troubled teens with the assurance and love they need to become productive, lawful adults.

With over a century of wisdom and experience, Charles "Charlie" Klotz has fought the tough


