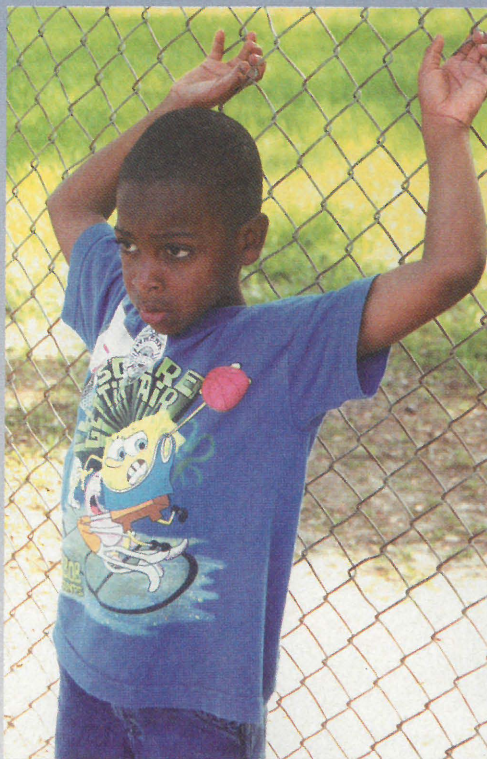
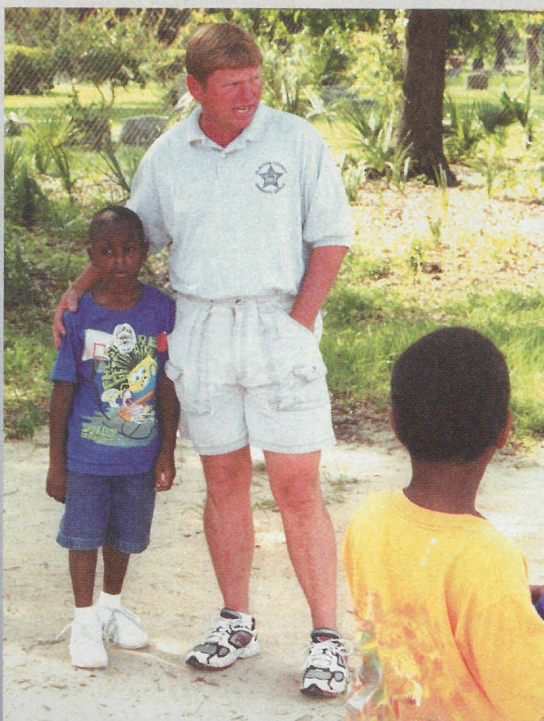
Fighting Delinquency Begins at Home!

Every county in Florida received a very special gift this year - one week of free day camp for the children in a local school or community.

Thanks to a large distribution from a class action lawsuit, facilitated by the Office of the Attorney General and the Florida Sheriffs Association, a special day camp called Harmony In the Streets ~ Wellness In Nutrition was brought right into many of the most needy places in Florida. Some Sheriffs provided additional resources and their county received more than one week of this dynamic delinquency prevention service.

Reaching out to these children takes time and

building a child's self worth.

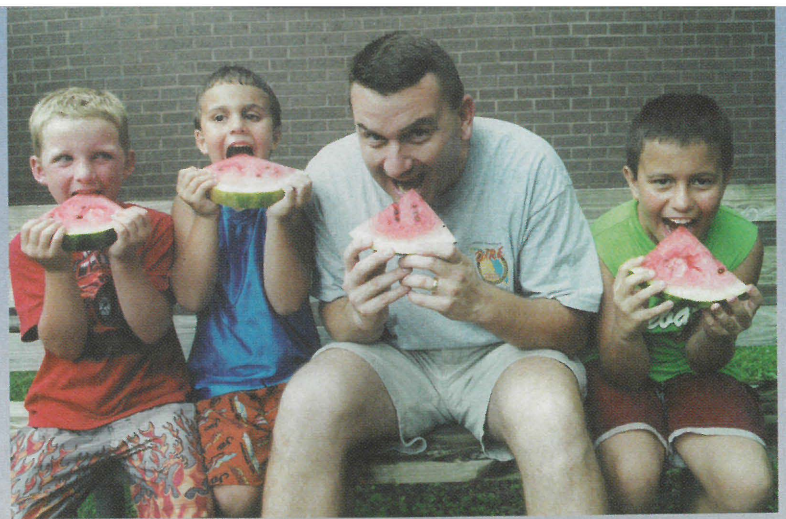

Preventing Juvenile Delinquency has been our mission since 1957. We strive to do more each year and serve as many children as funds permit. Thank you so much for your support and trust!

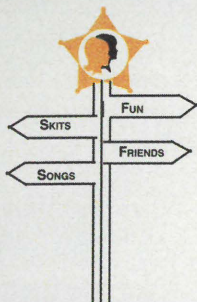

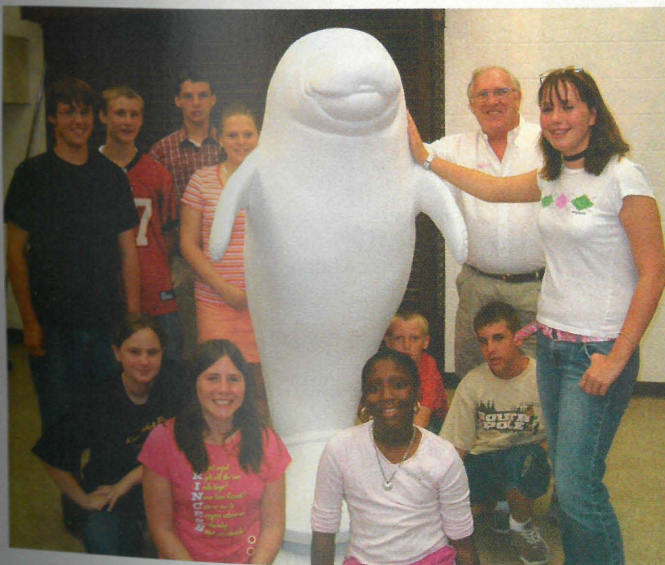
Giving Generously

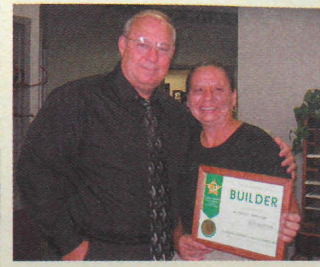

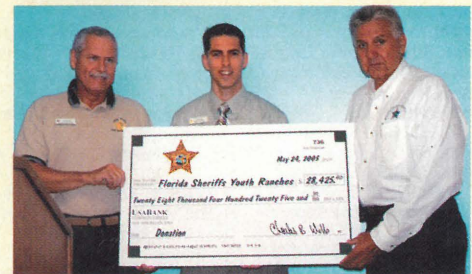
