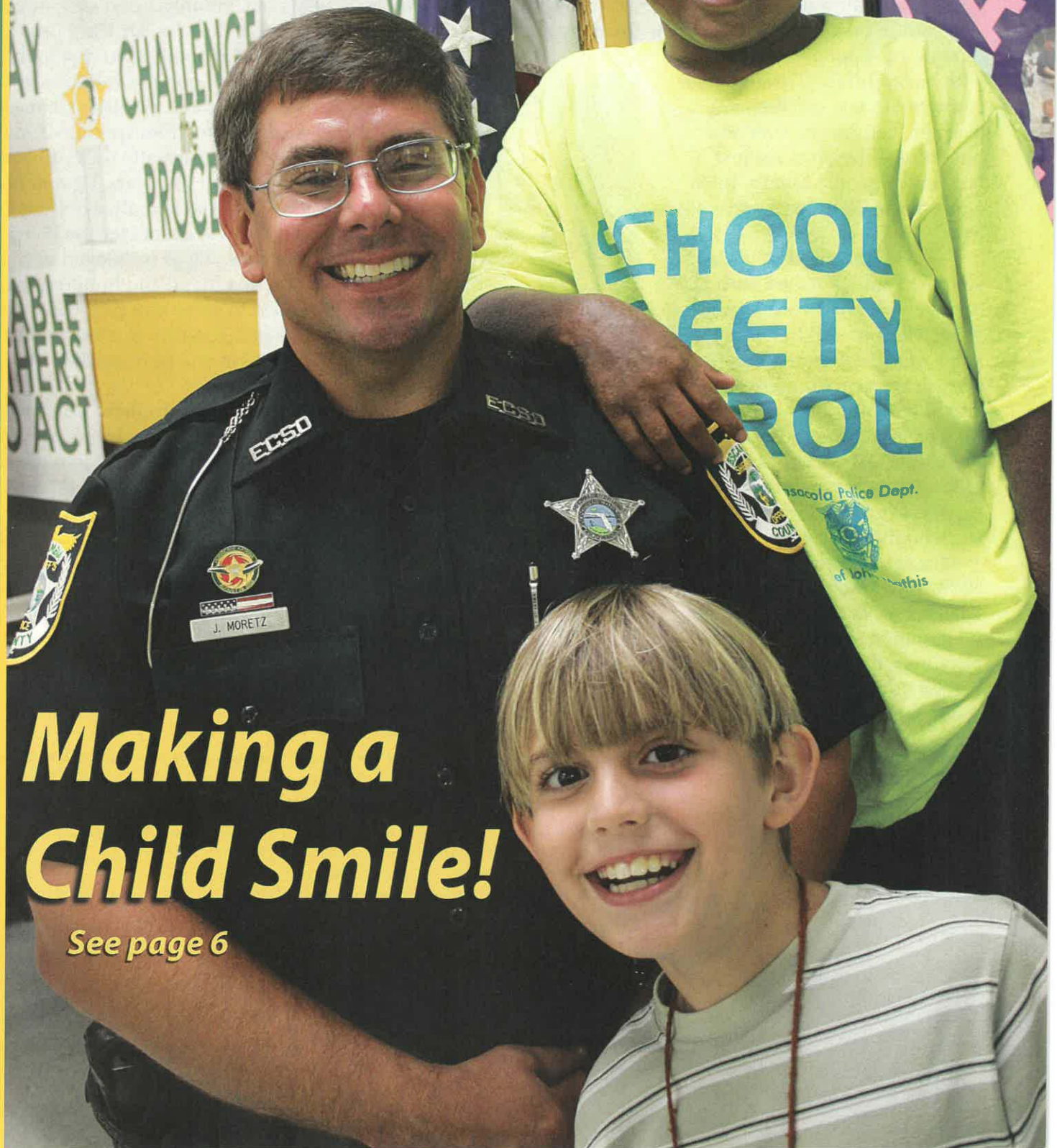

Roger O. Bouchard, Jr.
President of the Florida
Sheriffs Youth Ranches, Inc.

As I looked through this issue of *The Rancher*, I couldn't help but wonder at the diversity and richness of experiences we share with our children. Through their contact with law enforcement, teachers, volunteers, staff and donors, they begin to see just how much people care for them and want them to have successful lives.

During an awards night at summer camp, I visited with 11 deputies who had volunteered to work with our children that week. Some of these deputies had been serving at camp for many years and have collectively worked a total of 68 summers. For the children, this positive exposure to law enforcement can be a life-changing experience, one which will keep them on the right side of the law.

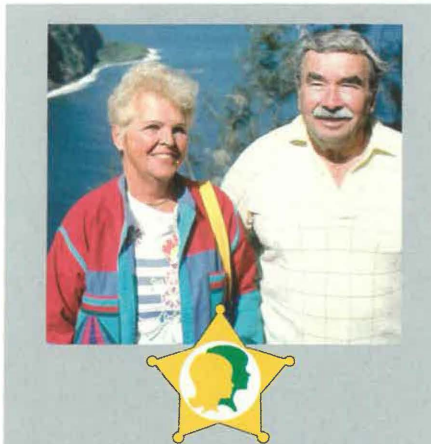
Earlier in the year, we held a 50th Anniversary reception in Tallahassee for legislators and other government officials. The five boys from the Boys Ranch who helped us host this distinguished group were able to mingle and

talk to our elected officials. I was so proud of them as they told the legislators of their experiences before the Youth Ranches and how they had turned their lives around while in our program. As I drove back to Live Oak, I could not help but think what a great memory it was for our youth to meet the men and women who influence and make our laws.

On a sad note, the Youth Ranches lost one of its most fervent supporters and beloved friends recently. Dr. Sherman Pace of Clearwater was a Youth Ranches Board Member, volunteer and supporter since the early days. For decades, Dr. Pace provided medical services at no cost to the children of our Youth Ranch in Safety Harbor. He also arranged medical care from specialists in the community, usually on a pro bono basis. Over the years, I got to know Dr. Pace well and always visited with him at events for the Youth Ranches. I was privileged to count him as a friend and honored to be asked to serve as a pallbearer while we said goodbye to a wonderful man. He will be missed by all who knew him.

Law enforcement officers, legislators, doctors and so many others involved with our children make their lives richer and brighter than they could have been without this experience. I would like to thank all of you who give in so many ways to the Youth Ranches. You are truly saving lives!

My name is Michael...

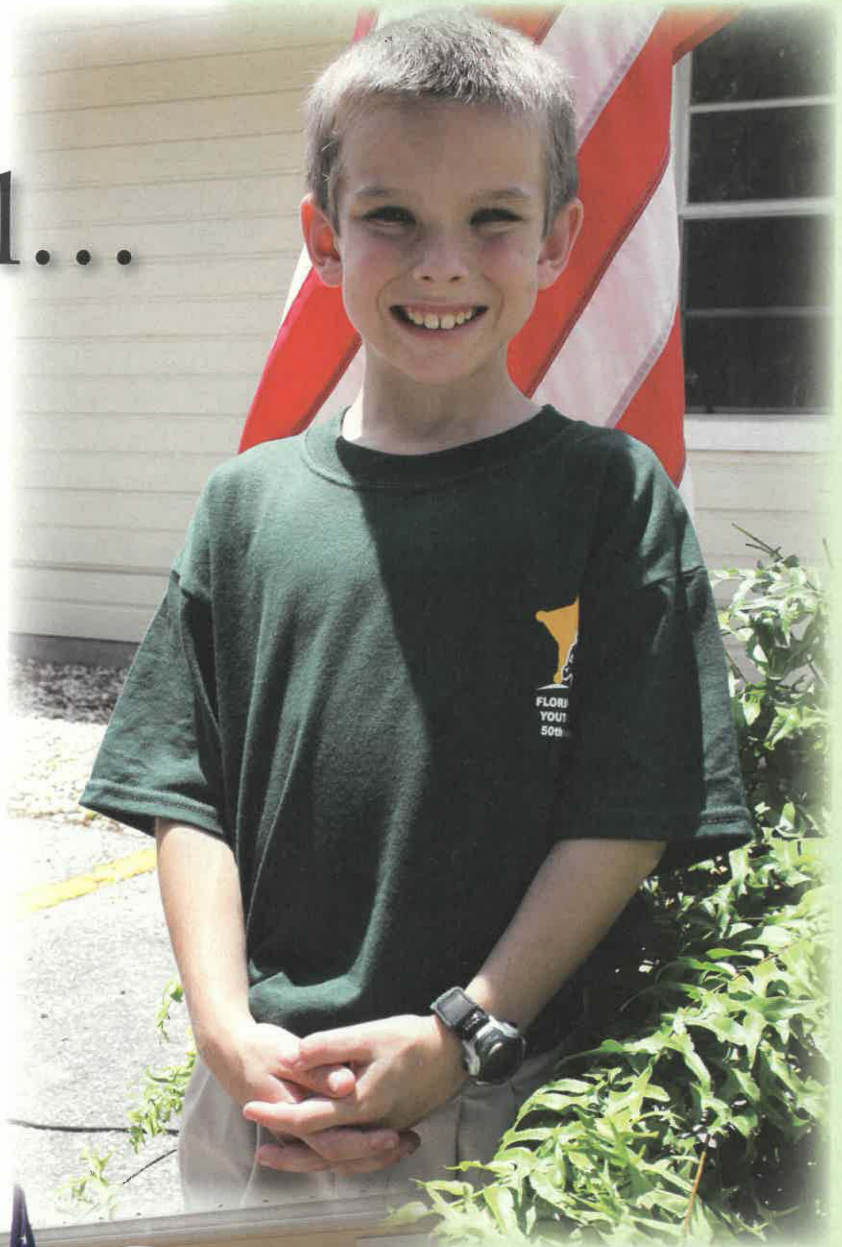
"My name is Michael and I am nine years old. I came to the Youth Ranch just before Christmas. I came to work on my anger management. My anger problem is bigger than I am.

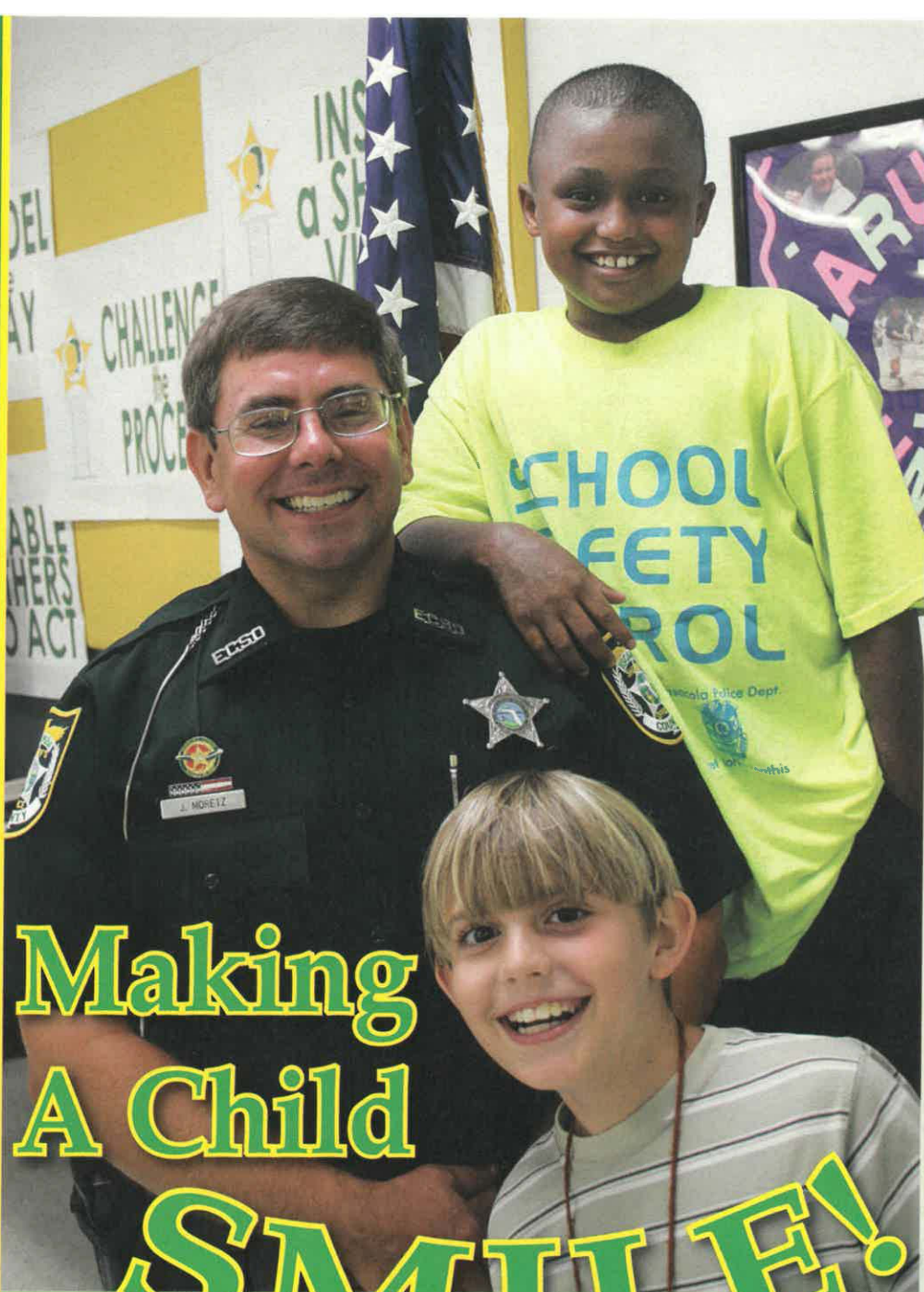
Before I came to the Ranch, I had real problems with swearing and being disrespectful. I still have a little problem now and then but I am doing better.

It is hard enough to sit still in school when you are nine years old, and for Michael that challenge is doubly tough. He battles a skin disease that covers his arms and legs leaving him itchy and restless all day long.

Still, Michael smiles! He loves school and those around him are drawn to help this delightful little boy.

His father doesn't really play an active role in his life. A boy without a dad really appreciates the time and attention he receives from the Deputies at summer camp. Still, Michael wishes...

Fighting the feelings of rejection, Michael has a very strong and loving relationship with his mother. Sadly, she knows she is raising a boy who has to become a man way too soon.

Michael took the news of her medical condition with deep, brave breaths that lifted his shoulders up while big, silent tears slid down his face. Even at the age of nine, he knew what terminal meant and promised to help take care of his mother. Still, Michael hurts...

His mother did not want this to be a summer of sorrow. She wanted her son to live, laugh and learn! The School Social Worker and the School Resource Officer talked about the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches Summer Camp. His mother loved the idea but quickly ruled it out because she didn't have the money for such a luxury.

"That's the best part of the plan," explained the Social Worker. "It's free! The Youth Ranches has so many generous donors who send in gifts to sponsor kids just like Michael!"

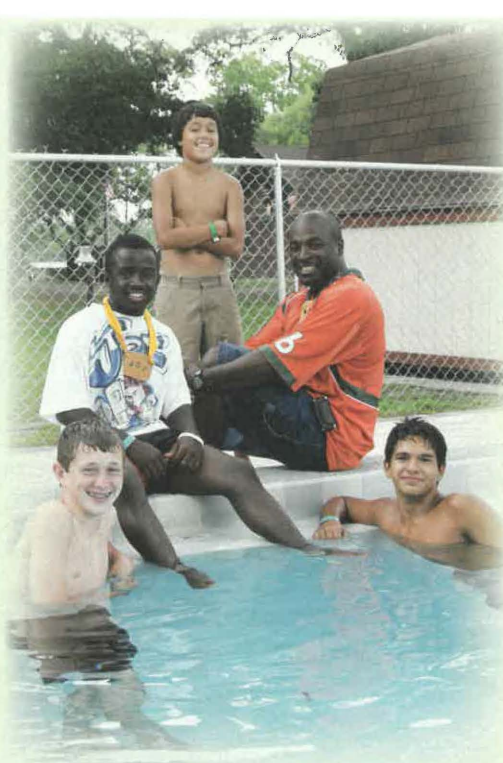

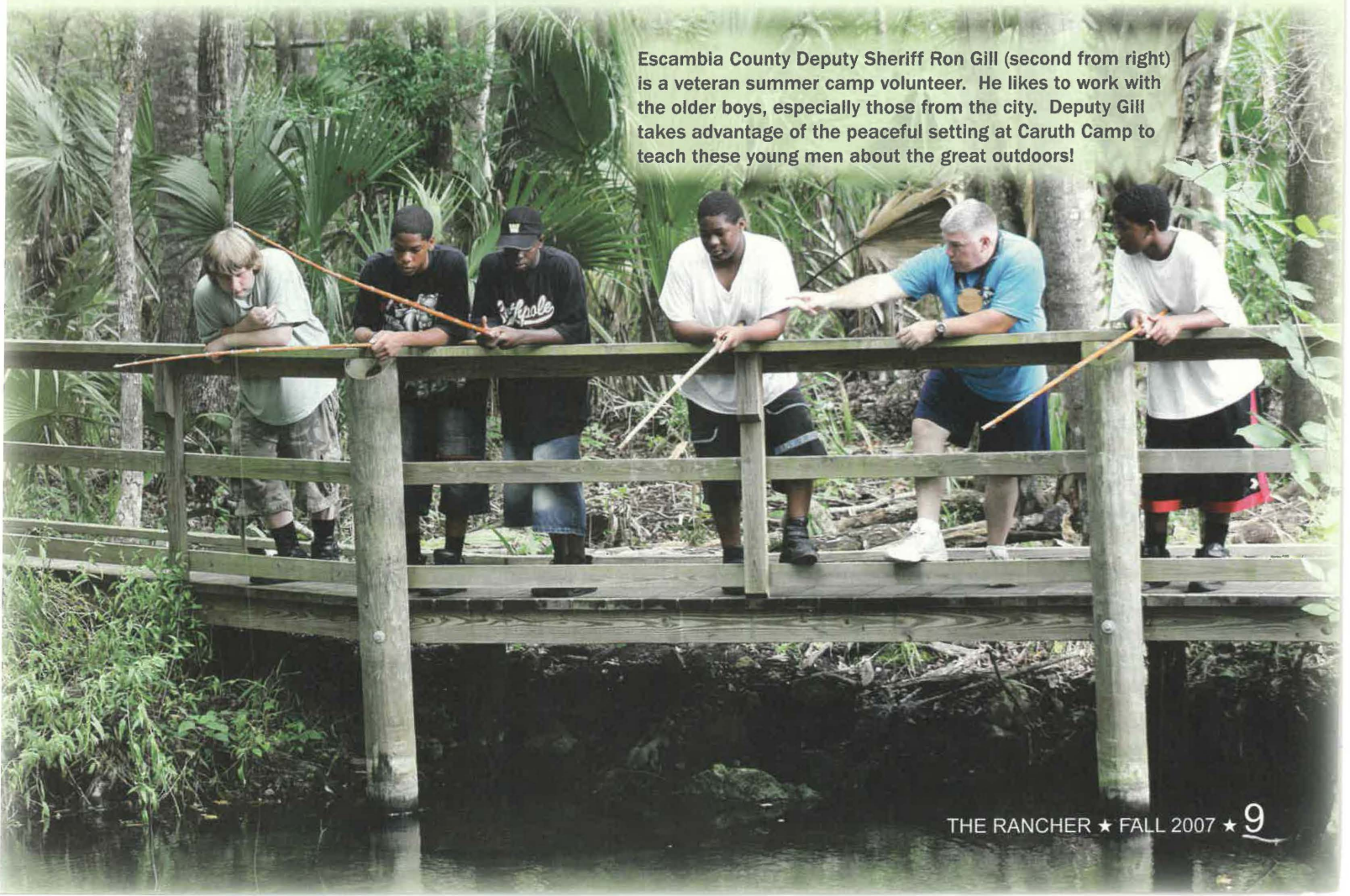

Indiantown, Florida.



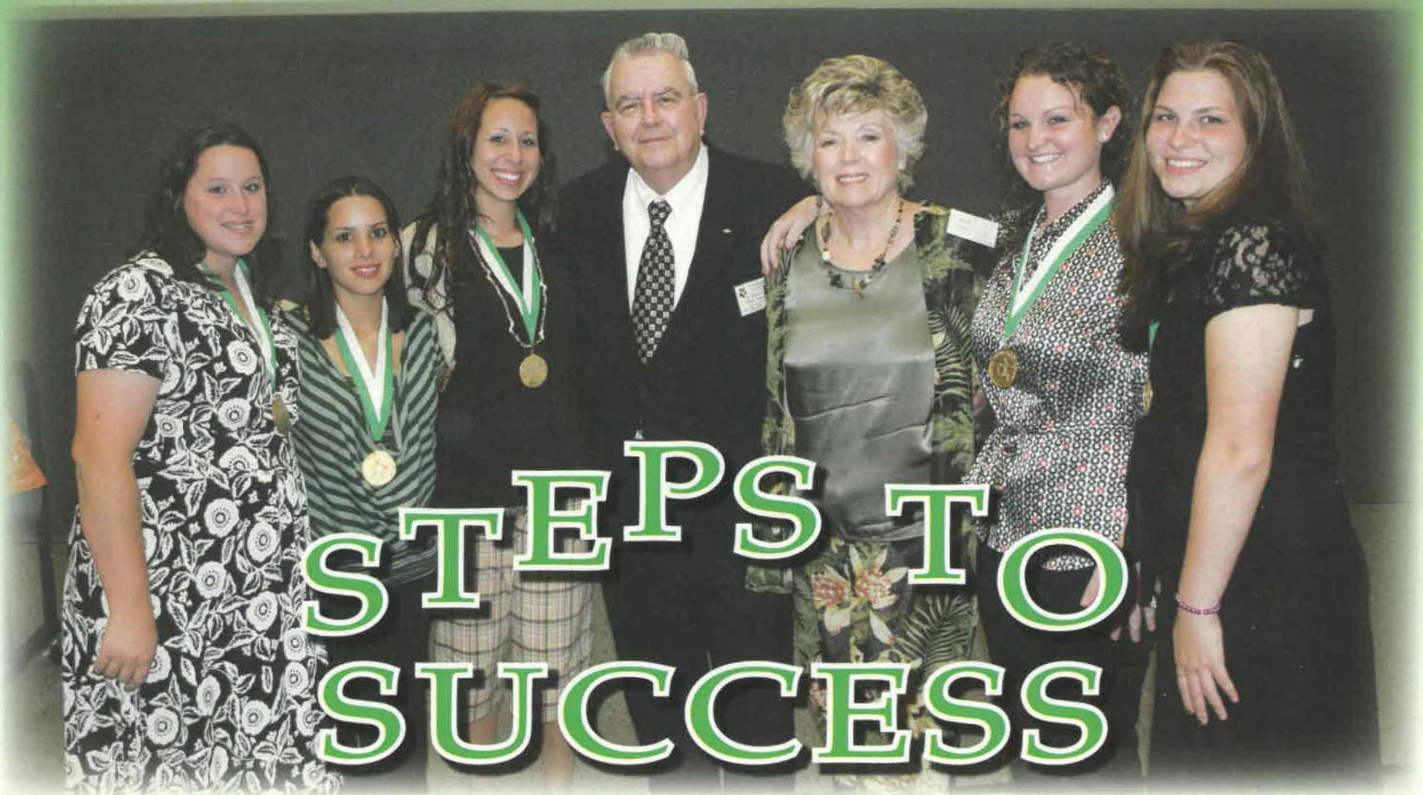

has been estimated at 5,000 for each two-day event. Adult tickets are available for an advance price of \$10 and will be sold at the gate for \$15. vendor displays.

Dr. Sherman Pace – Our Family Doctor November 15, 1923 to May 13, 2007

Born in St. Petersburg, Sherman Pace graduated from St. Petersburg High School in 1940, received a BA in 1943 and his medical degree in 1947, both from Duke University. He served in the Army as a Captain in the Medical Corps and as a Naval Reserve Veteran.

In 1955, he moved back to Clearwater, and opened a general family practice with a specialty in obstetrics and gynecology. He was affiliated with Morton Plant Hospital and was one of the founding staff members of Clearwater Community Hospital.

Over the past 21 years, our friend Dr. Pace was attending physician for the children served at the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranch in Safety Harbor.

Many of our boys and girls had received limited, sometimes substandard medical attention before coming to the Youth Ranch. Dr. Pace's care was immediate, thorough and very comprehensive. If a child had a need outside his area of expertise, Dr. Pace would personally secure a commitment for medical care often at no cost to the child's family or to the Youth Ranches.

Dr. Pace served on our Board of Directors and supported the Youth Ranches generously with contributions for the children in our care.

We were blessed to have Dr. Sherman Pace as our family doctor and will always remember and honor him for his commitment and heart for the children.

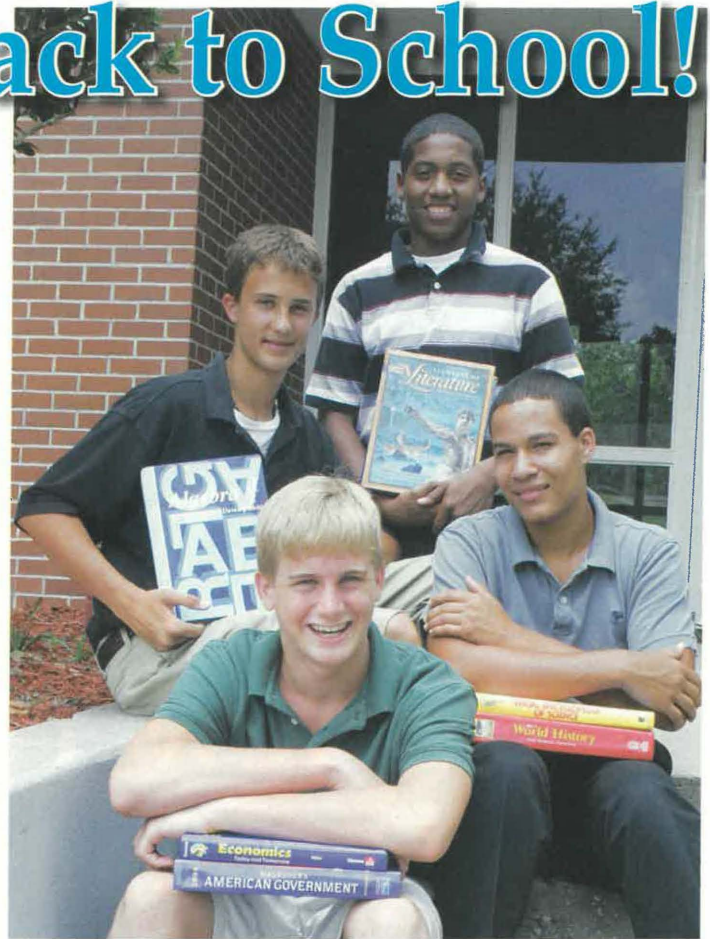
Time to Go Back to School!

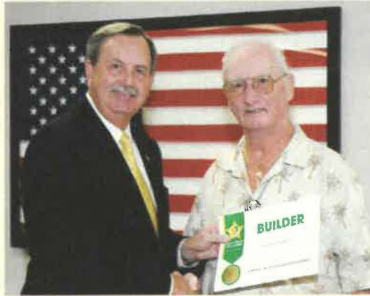

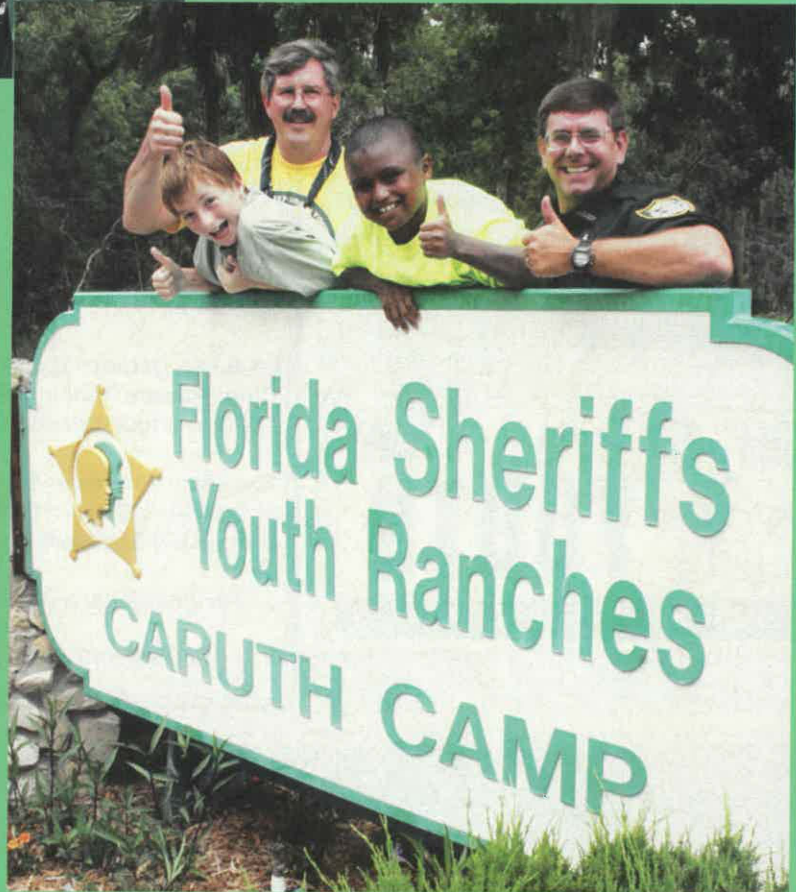
