National Accreditation Visit

The Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches recently completed a site visit from the Council on Accreditation for youth and family services. Three peer reviewers from across the nation met with Board Members, Sheriffs, staff and youngsters as they conducted a four day review covering 340 standards.

One reviewer said she found the Youth Ranches to be "extremely sensitive to the needs of children"... "kids feel valued and heard"... "a good environment for kids." The lead evaluator indicated the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches should be commended for the "highest quality of facilities and services" and the agency should be "universally commended" for creating a culture where "Children Come First!"

The Sheriffs of Florida, Youth Ranches Board of Directors and staff were all pleased to receive this excellent review and we wanted to share this information with our donor family to assure them we are serving children and fulfilling our mission at an exemplary high level.

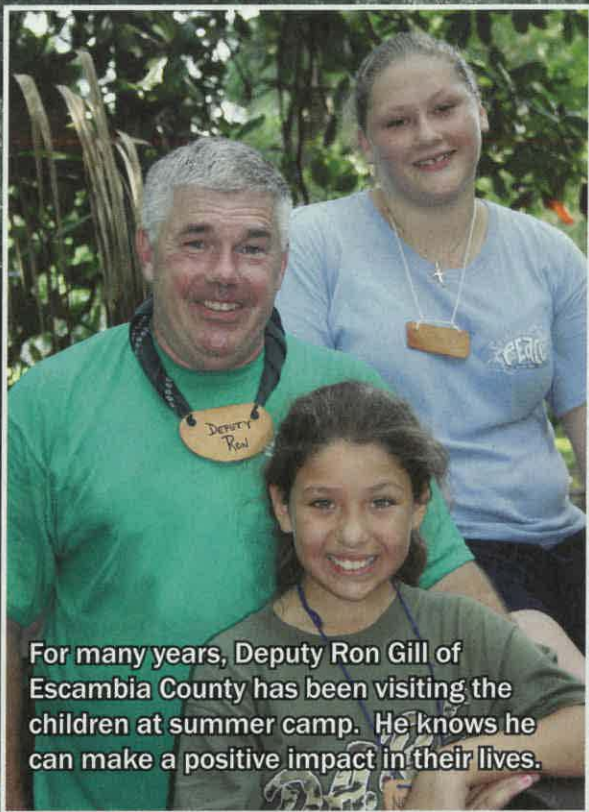

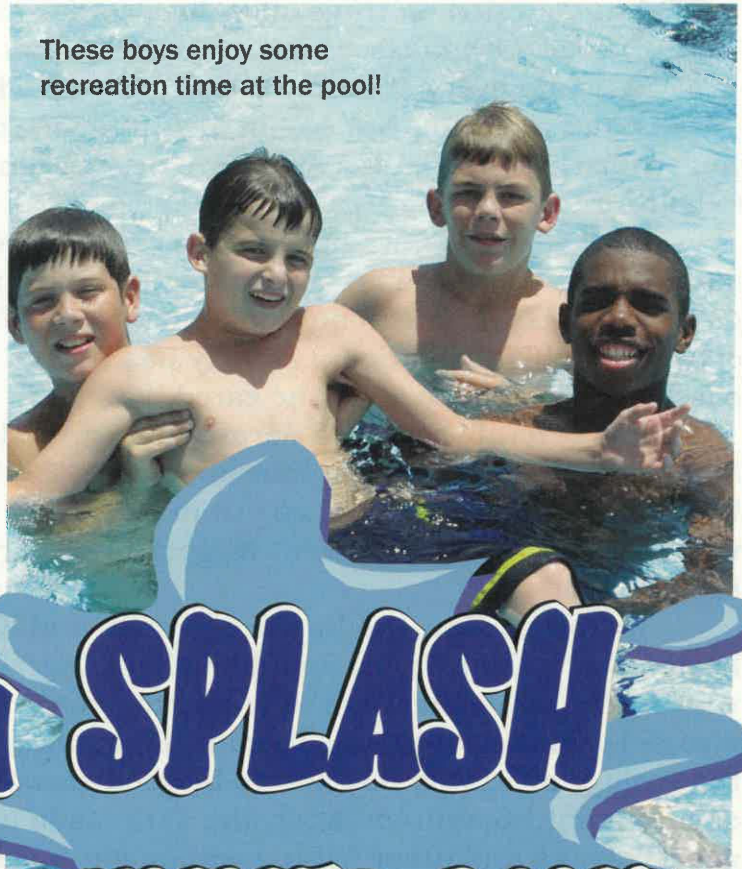

Over the years, we have had several interested individuals who have reached out to our boys and girls to give them this wonderful outdoor experience. For some of our kids this recreational activity has turned into a passion...all because someone cared.

For several years, the Sarasota County Sheriff's Office has held an annual fishing tournament for the boys. The Ranchers get the chance to go out in a nice big boat and win prizes for the "first catch," biggest catch" and "funniest looking fish!"

In Tampa Bay, the Bay Area Canoe and Kayak Club hosted the "Take a Youth Paddle-Fishing Day" for our youth. The youngsters not only had the chance to fish but also to learn some valuable lessons about water safety, the ecology of Tampa Bay and to be good stewards of the environment. Soon thereafter, the club made a special gift of kayaks and other fishing equipment for the Youth Ranches fishing program.

In Bartow, the girls have a nice lake located at the back of campus. Staff and volunteers have taught them how to fish from both a boat and along the shoreline.

A few of our youth have also been able to fish on the beach and take special trips along the Suwannee River.

Cowboy Days in Okeechobee

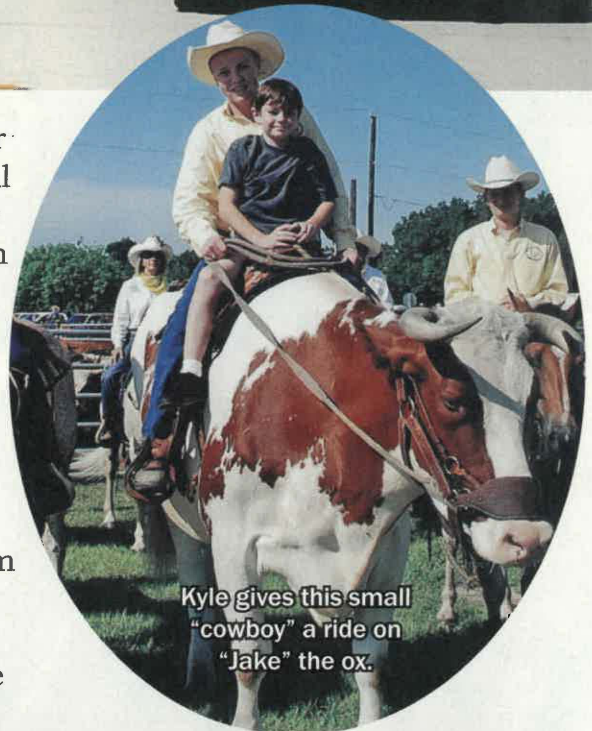

My life has changed by my living at the Florida Sheriffs Boys Ranch. Even though I have only been here a short time, it has stopped me from doing the things that got me in trouble. They stopped me from skipping school and getting suspended every other week or day. My former bad behaviors are starting to change day by day.

I am getting to know a lot of people, but not just anyone. Cottage parents, teachers and counselors help you make good choices. The Unit Directors and Program Director help also. I always ask adults for help. They have never given up on me since I have been here, and they have really helped me turn my life around. They never let you give up on yourself.

The Ranch is a better community to help me with my behavior. They are teaching me to deal with my problems and attitude. Without the Ranch, I would be locked up or on the streets. But instead, God thankfully blessed me with a huge opportunity to come here. I am thankful for my cottage parents helping with my ups and downs and through tough situations.

I started school with bad scores on my daily school notes; but if I was at home I would not even be in school. I was mostly suspended or skipping classes. All the stuff I used to do, I do not do anymore. My school notes are improving and I am in class learning every day.

The Learning Center has really helped me learn what I need for life. My class behavior has improved and so have my grades. I want to get back on track and take advantage of the opportunities I have been given. I have a new mentor, Coach Chapman, who is checking in with me making sure I improve my school note scores and my grades. I do not want to disappoint him, or the other people in my life.

I go to chapel every Sunday and pray to God to help me do better in school. I want to stay on track at the Ranch and improve myself. I am blessed to have a chance to change my life. By coming to the Florida Sheriffs Boys Ranch, my family and I have a chance to turn my ways around.

I have apologized to my Mom for giving her a hard time. She worked 11 hours a day just to feed, clothe and shelter me. She works too hard for me to treat her bad. I am sorry Mom, I love you. 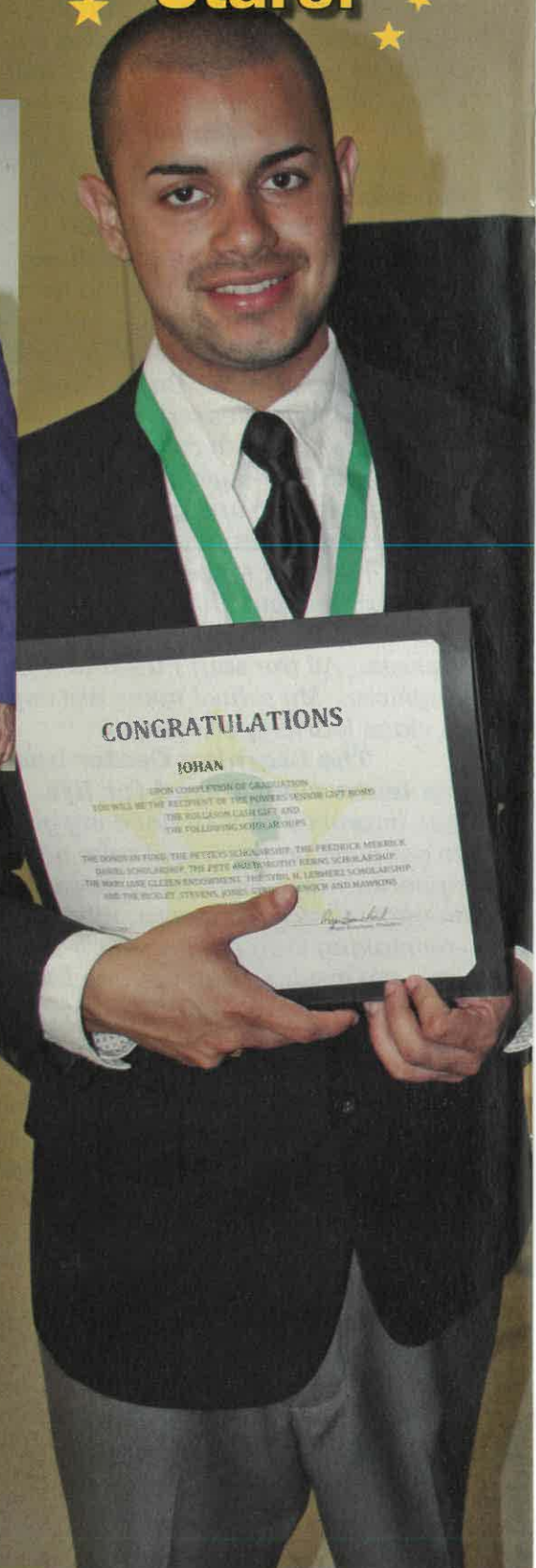

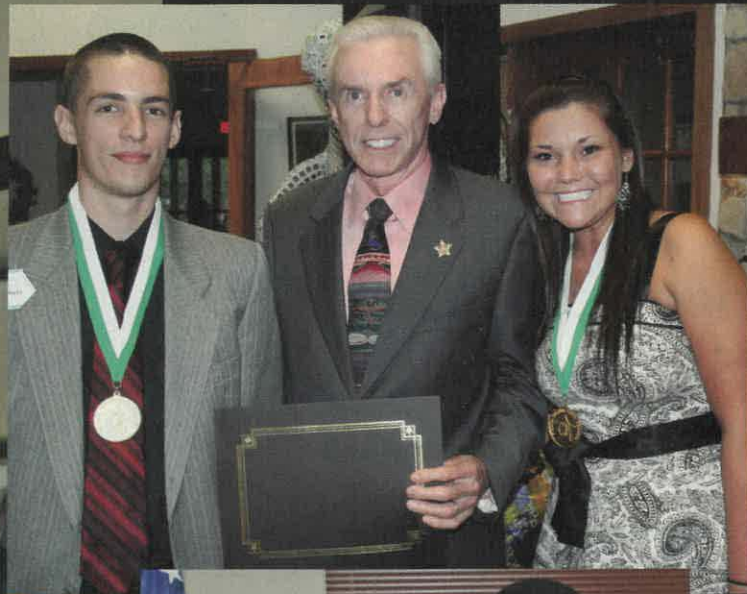

The Cornerstone of a Productive Life

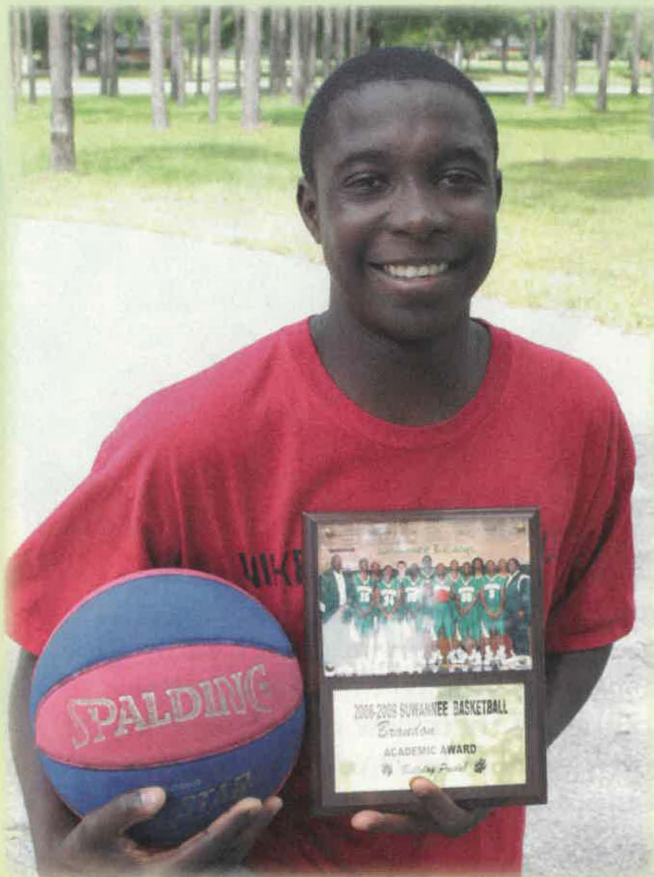

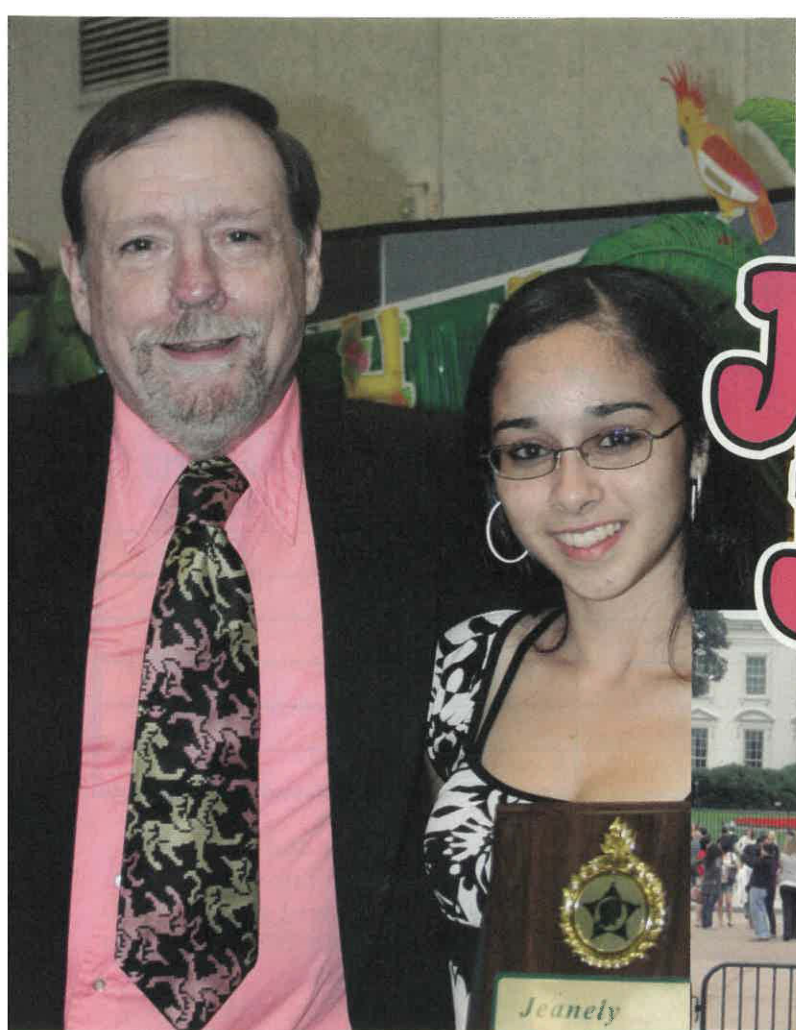

Jeanely's Journey



"The best part of my trip was visiting Washington DC and the Smithsonian Museums...they were incredible!" proclaimed Jeanely. She also got to see the White House and grasp a special part of American history.

She is young, bright and ambitious... but also well-grounded, thoughtful and very eager to learn!

This spring, Jeanely was nominated by her school to attend the National Youth Leadership Conference in Washington, DC. Less than 1% of high school scholars are invited to this prestigious learning academy. During this 10 day journey, she visited many of our nation's monuments and museums but also worked with 350 other teens from all over the United States and territories in a simulated government. During this model congress experience, the young men and women took on official roles, tested the constitution and debated proposed legislation – their energy bill passed, but the immigration bill failed.

On another day, they simulated grass-roots advocacy and built a plan to implement similar activities within their local communities. In a very different exercise, the teens took on a global challenge involving international issues in Darfur which proved to be quite interesting to Jeanely. They were divided into seven groups representing various governments and voices, who tried to find a way to stop the war and bring peace to the region. Jeanely was assigned to the group representing the Darfur rebels. The

overall goal was to get five of the seven groups to agree on an initiative and it never happened. "It was very difficult to represent a

cause you don't personally believe in, but it was equally as challenging to try to understand the issue from all points of view," she said.

Before coming to the Villa, Jeanely struggled with many challenges in her life, including hanging out with the wrong friends and losing ground in school. When she made the move to the Youth Villa, she knew she had a unique opportunity and she never looked back.

Jeanely is currently attending high school and earning college credits at the same time. By the time she participates in her high school graduation, she will have almost completed her AA degree in college. Then, she plans to attend Florida State University or the University of North Florida and study sports medicine. Eventually, Jeanely hopes to go to medical school and become an orthopedic surgeon. She has already proven to us that she is smart, hard working and incredibly goal oriented... not bad for a 16 year old who will turn 17 this September!

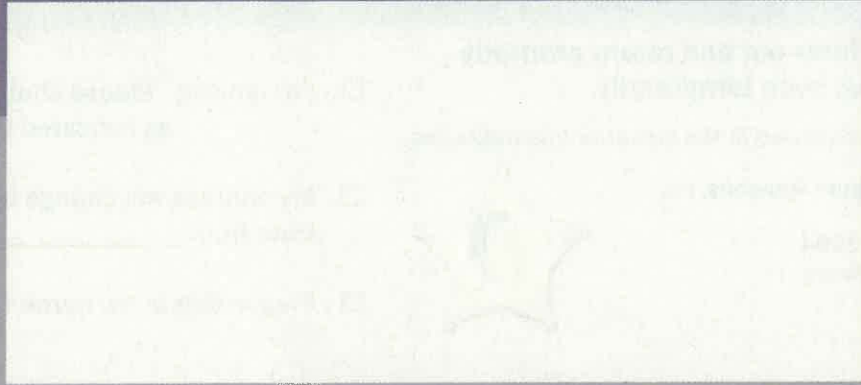
