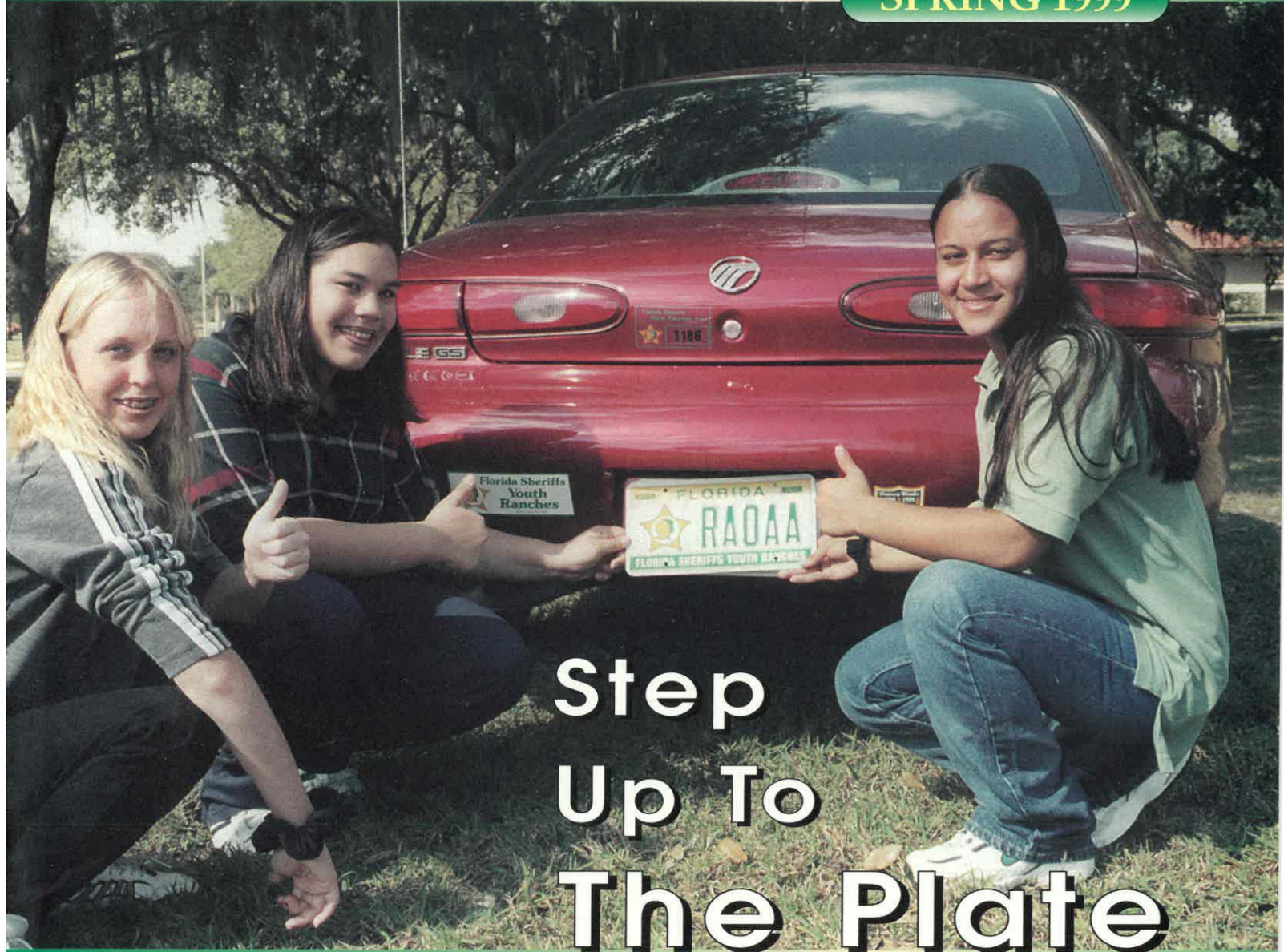

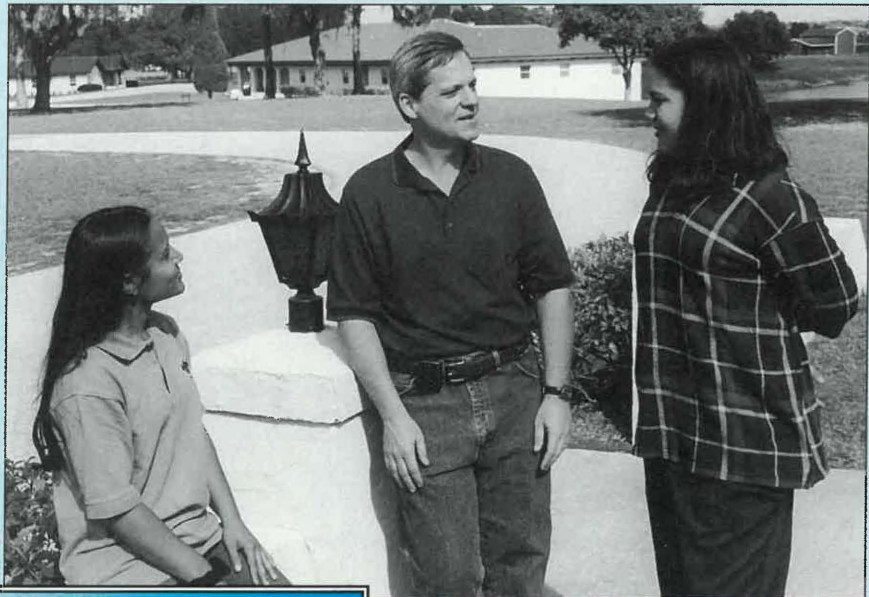
"We (Board) dedicated much time and effort reviewing numerous candidates for the position of President," says Youth Ranches Board Chair and Calhoun County Sheriff Buddy Smith. "We were confident Mr. Bouchard was the best candidate to help provide the Youth Ranches with faithful guidance into the 21st Century."

Now that his second term as Youth Ranches President has drawn to a close, long-time Youth Ranches leader Harry K. Weaver has immediate plans to resume his retirement. "I enjoyed serving as President as the search for a successor moved forward," says Mr. Weaver.

Mr. Bouchard joined the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches on July 9, 1990, as Resident Director of the Boys Ranch. On April 1, 1992, he was promoted to Vice President of Program. Prior to arriving at the Youth Ranches, Mr. Bouchard had worked extensively in direct childcare, social services, and ministry throughout the world, in Florida, Alabama, Hawaii, and Guam.

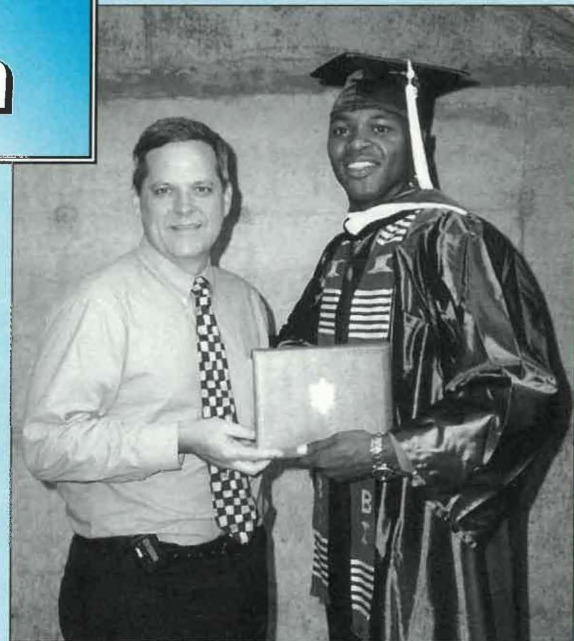

President's Perspective

A message from Roger O. Bouchard, Jr.
President of the Florida Sheriffs
Youth Ranches, Inc.



In September of 1973, my wife and I were hired by a small agency to serve as houseparents for eight teenage boys. We cooked their meals, tutored them in their homework, played countless hours of games, and spent long nights discussing their hurts as well as their hopes. It was the most challenging but most rewarding job we ever held.

Twenty five years have passed since then, and many changes have taken place in our society and our young people. The field of child care has changed dramatically.

The Youth Ranches has always embraced traditional values such as hard work, sound education and family-

style living in the cottages. With these, we have added professional counseling, computerized learning and other new technology to ensure the best services for the boys and girls in our care.

Working with children is very much like raising children. We rarely get the opportunity to see the results of our work until years go by and the child returns home again.

Recently, I had the opportunity to attend the college graduation of one of the young men who was living at the Boys Ranch when I was first hired in 1990. Willie is one of the most motivated young men I have ever known! (Please see his story on page 8.) He had been told at school that he had learning disabilities and needed to be in special classes. He asked to be kept in regular classes and promised to study hard and do whatever it took to complete the work.

During his high school years, Willie had special permission to stay up past bedtime in his cottage, often working until midnight or later on his schoolwork. Along with academics, Willie was on the wrestling and track team and a leader in the Naval ROTC as well as several other clubs. After graduating from Suwannee High School, Willie attended college through the Youth Ranches scholarship program. In his four years at Florida A&M, he continued his hard work, earning a Bachelors Degree in Criminal Justice.

Over the Christmas holidays, Willie stopped by the Boys Ranch for a visit. He had just been accepted into graduate school and was setting up his living arrangements and a part-time job. After he receives his Masters Degree, his ultimate goal is a career in law enforcement.

Willie is only one of hundreds of young people who have the will and desire to make something of their lives. With the help and generous support of our donor family and caring staff, he was able to make these dreams come true.

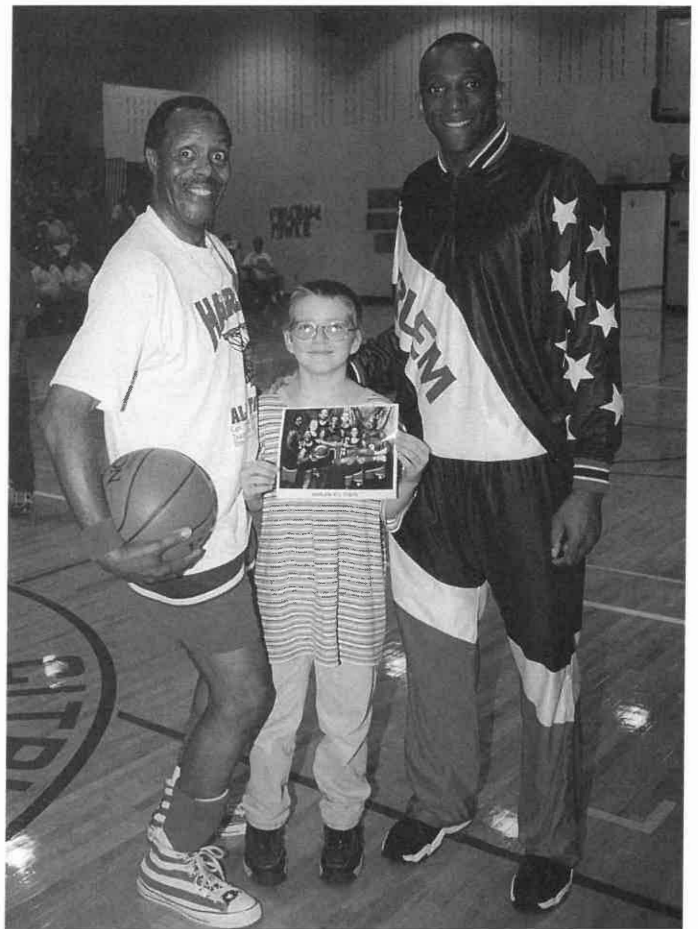
Twice As Nice

The first comedy basketball game helped raise much needed funds for Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches boys and girls. "The game was such a hit in our community last year," says Sheriff Jeff Dawsy. "We were more than happy to do it again."

Led by team captain "Magic" Valentino Willis, the Harlem All-Stars is a group of former NBA, European Pro League and Harlem Magicians who stage basketball games around the country in an effort to entertain and educate kids about the hazards of drugs and the importance of a solid education. Magic takes great pride in working with children.

"I tell kids to never give up," says Magic. "I always emphasize education . . . I urge them to stay in school."

Tag Team

It's been said, "A mind is like a parachute, it works better when it's been opened." Those words remind needy girls at the Florida Sheriffs Youth Villa that education is the cornerstone to a successful future.

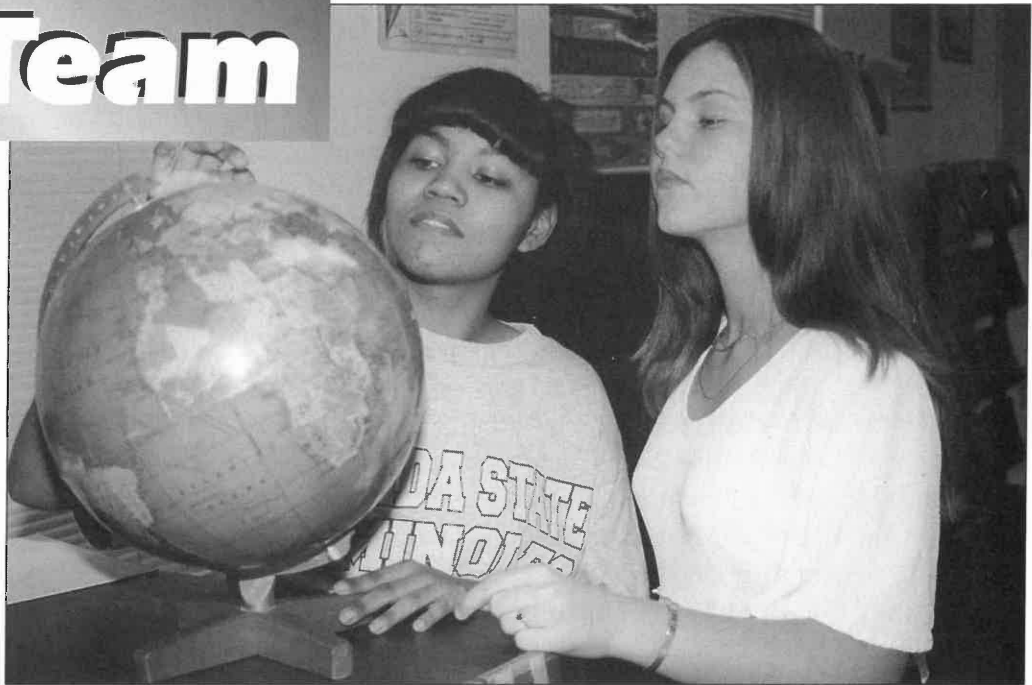
Students who attend on-campus Learning Centers, oftentimes lack a measurable amount of trust or solid set of traditional family values. Many youth carry a weak sense of personal as well as academic responsibility. Some have never had the satisfaction of completing a research project, while others have had little experience working within groups, using teamwork to meet goals and learn valuable lessons. In the Learning Center school atmosphere, at-risk youth can begin to rebuild educational skills through specialized, intensive team teaching methods.

"We truly practice a team approach to teaching," says one of the Youth Villa Teachers Lubertha DePrimo. "Each teacher covers a limited number of subjects . . . while one teacher leads the class, the others support and interact with students."

One of the Learning Center advantages is its ability to accommodate students with different skill levels. The individualized educational objectives allow teachers to tailor their instruction to meet the specific needs of each individual student. Thanks to this unique schooling opportunity, instructors are free to focus specific efforts on youth who may find themselves further "behind" than their peers.

"This is the first school I've been at where teachers really show they care," says one Youth Villa student.

In addition to standard educational courses, Learning Center attendees are exposed to vocational education as well as life skills classes. This reality-based training prepares troubled girls for eventual independent living, teaches necessary problem-solving skills, and helps build self-esteem. Teachers also serve as positive role models for troubled youth by helping to instill self-respect and social skills in girls in desperate need of guidance.

"It's my ultimate hope that one day something I've said or done will be helpful to them," says Mrs. DePrimo. "I always try and give them a little piece of something to take with them into the world."

Youth Villa students are also required to maintain a daily journal as part of their Learning Center curriculum. These ongoing diaries allow students to improve writing skills, reflect on daily accomplishments, and can provide a valuable medium for troubled teens to express themselves in a learning environment.

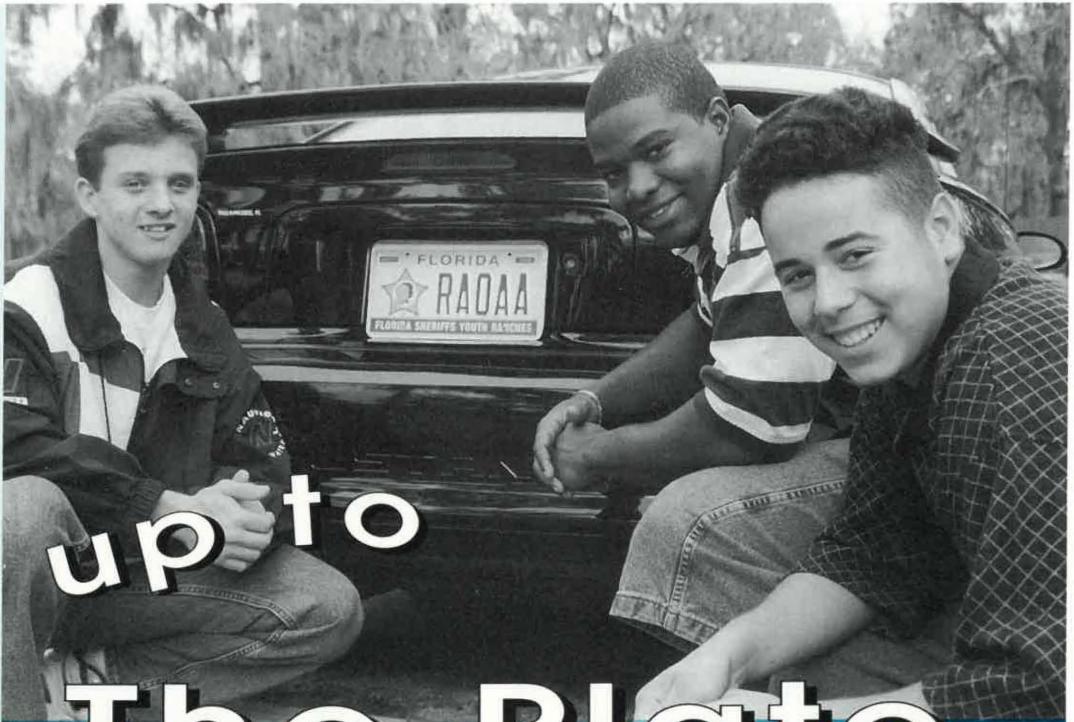

Step up to The Plate

After years of persistence, patience and painstaking planning, the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches Specialty License Plate is finally available. The Youth Ranches new tag was unanimously passed by the 1998 Florida Legislative Session and signed into law by the late Governor Lawton Chiles. It joins the nearly forty other specialty plates already in widespread use throughout the state.

Q: I'm interested in the new Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches Specialty License Plate, how can I get one?

A: The next time you're required to renew your car registration (usually your birthday each year), ask for the new Youth Ranches Specialty License Plate. You'll be asked to pay a small fee (\$20) which will be directly used by the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches to help needy boys and girls.

Q: I recently renewed my registration. If I want a Youth Ranches plate, must I register again?

A: No. Simply contact your local tag office, pay a small specialty plate usage fee (\$20), pick-up your new plate, and drive away.

Q: I already have a specialty plate. May I trade in my current plate for a Youth Ranches tag?

A: You may trade in your existing plate for a Youth Ranches tag at any time throughout the year. However, you will be asked to pay the additional specialty tag fee (\$20).

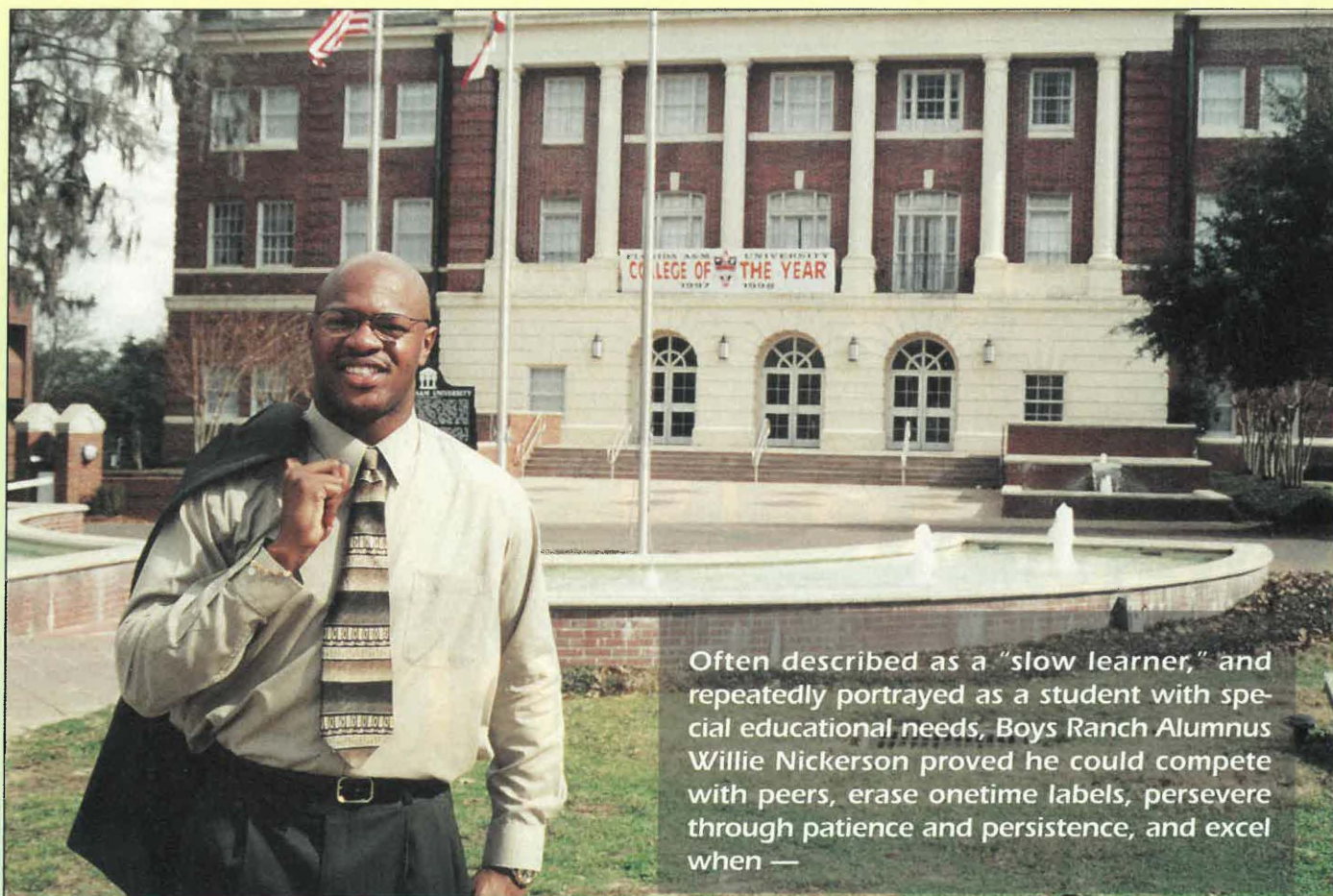
Q: Why must I pay an additional charge if I want a Youth Ranches plate?

A: Proceeds from the specialty tag fees go directly into the care and service of Youth Ranches boys and girls.

Q: Florida is a huge state, you don't really need my help. Right?

A: Wrong. Competition guarantees to be strong. The Youth Ranches must rely on its faithful donor family to help spread the word about the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches. Specialty tags have helped raise much needed funds for participating organizations and their respective causes.

Life is filled with choices; twists to manage, turns to make, paths to follow. Even individuals with mountains of potential must navigate through life. They alone decide their fate. Thanks to late night study sessions, encouragement from cottage parents, tutoring from best friend and fellow Boys Ranch alumnus Jeremy Goodrich as well as his unique passion for perseverance, Willie graduated from Suwannee High

School in 1993, and received his Bachelor's Degree from Florida A&M University last summer. Currently, Willie is pursuing his Master's Degree at Florida A&M. "I'm a fighter," says Willie. "I don't give up."

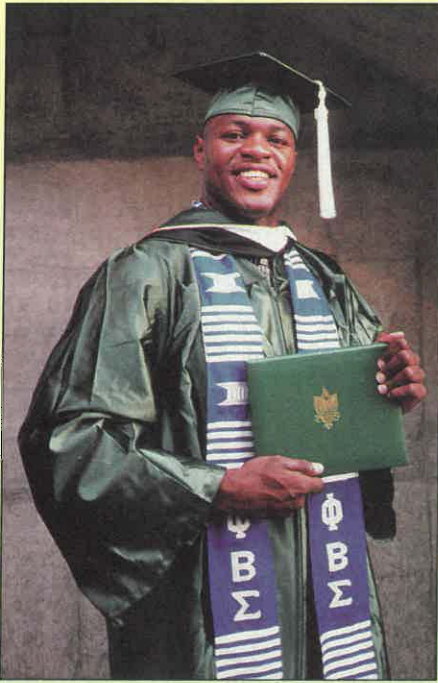
Pat on the Back

One of the primary reasons Willie maintains such a positive outlook on life is thanks to the advice and wisdom of the late Boys Ranch Director Pat Monogue, who died of a heart attack in 1997 at the age of 48. Monogue was a mentor, counselor, father and friend to Willie. He was a great listener, motivator and always treated the boys with dignity and respect.

"He (Monogue) was always there for me," says Willie. "He taught me . . . no matter what happens, I can overcome . . . I can persevere."

Fraternal Order

Oftentimes, belonging to a brotherhood helps young men develop a sense of family and self-respect. By joining the Phi Beta Sigma Fraternity while attend-

ing school, Willie had the opportunity to form valuable friendships as well as serve the local community. Established in 1935, the Phi Beta Sigma Fraternity at Florida A&M was the first chapter established in the state. The order devotes much of its time to community service projects like Sleep-Out for the Homeless, Bigger/Better/Business, and a unique educational program which targets a different local school each year. Members of the fraternity help tutor at-risk students.

"Being a part of the frat reminds me of the Ranch," says Willie. "It's like a family."

Phi Beta Sigma also participates in the Department of Juvenile Justice (DJJ) Role Model Program. The particular program requires DJJ youth to receive special mentoring from responsible members of the community as well as enroll in youth management classes.

"We act as Big Brothers," says Willie, of him and his fraternity brothers. "I look at myself as a leader, someone who can talk to these kids about college, education, hard work . . . we show them you can enjoy life and have fun without causing trouble."

Working For Justice

From an early age, with three cousins already revolving in and out of the "system," Willie became passionate about juvenile justice. Oftentimes, obscure references and technical courtroom terminology was discussed in his presence. Frustrated as well as curious, Willie wanted desperately to understand the foreign world he watched. It was this interest, those

memories and long-time devotion that spurred Willie to pursue a degree in Juvenile Justice as well as involvement in the Criminal Justice Association at Florida A&M. After earning his Master's Degree, Willie has decided to enroll in the FBI Academy in hopes of becoming a U.S. Marshal.

"I always wanted to be in Juvenile Justice," admits Willie. "I wanted to learn . . . I wanted to help."

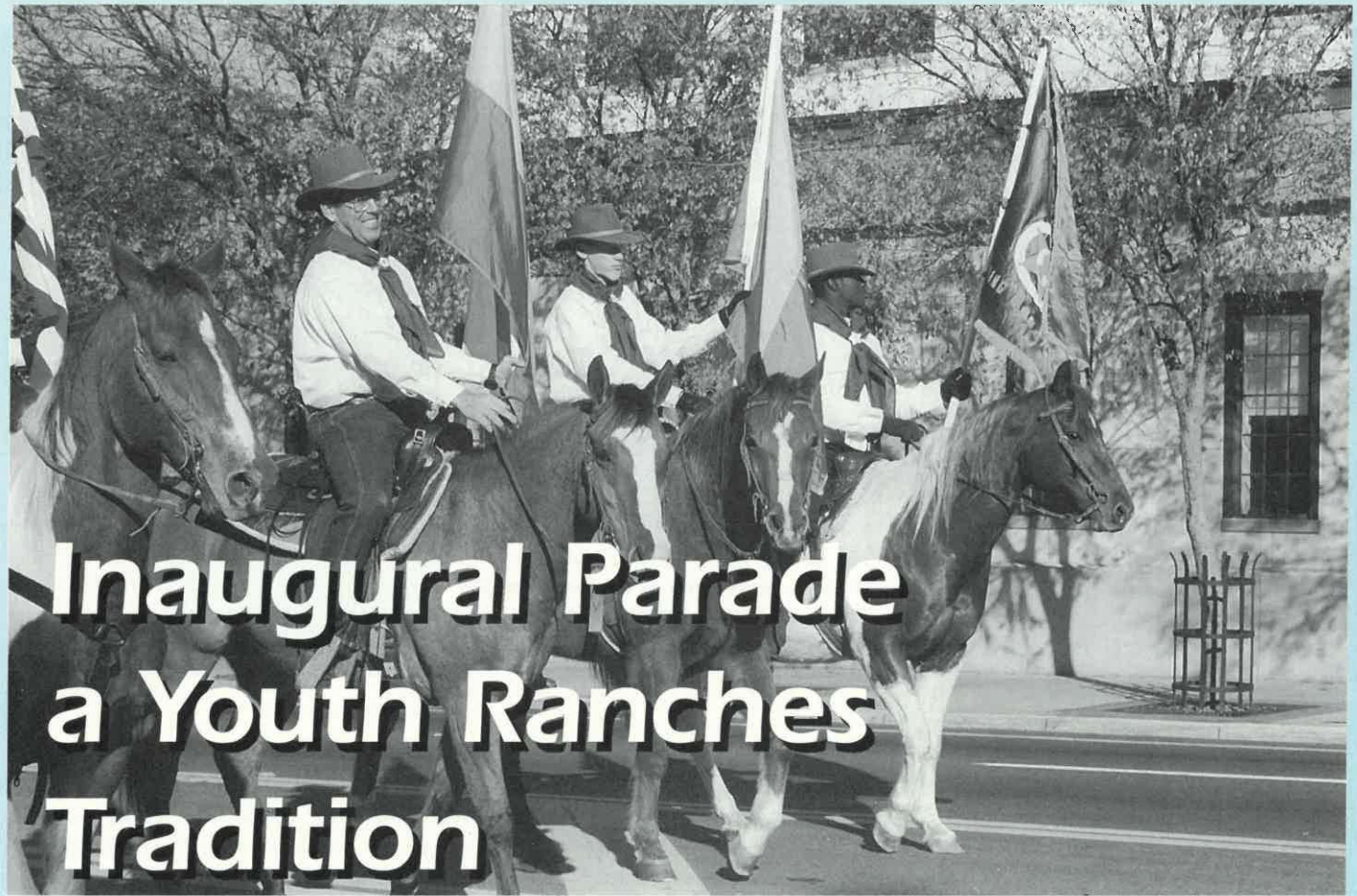
Underestimated, Overachieved

"It's up to you to stay out of trouble," says Willie. "It's up to you to succeed, whenever you're given the chance."



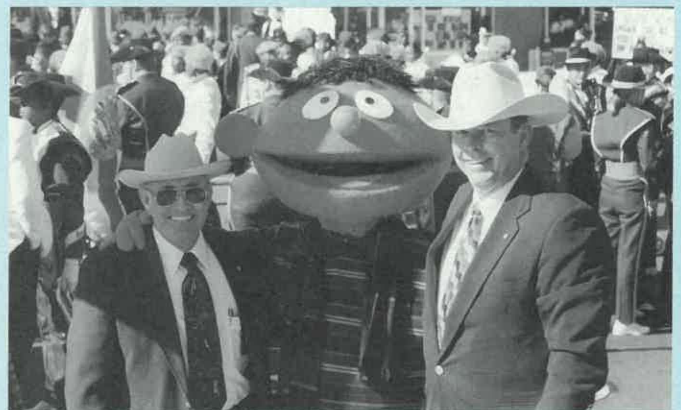
Inaugural Parade a Youth Ranches Tradition

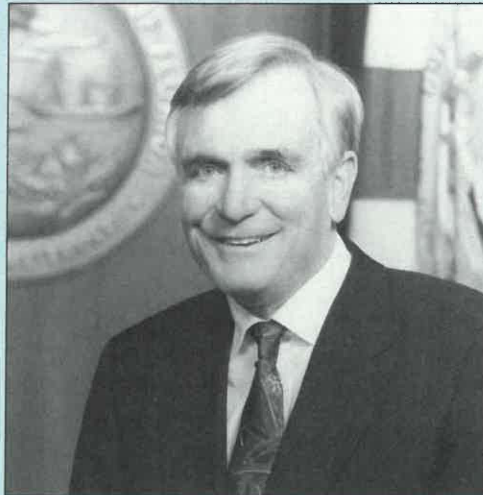


Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches Lose Friend and Advocate in "Walkin'" Lawton
