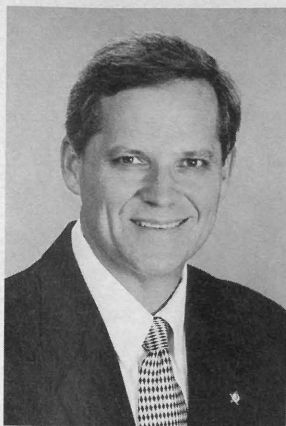

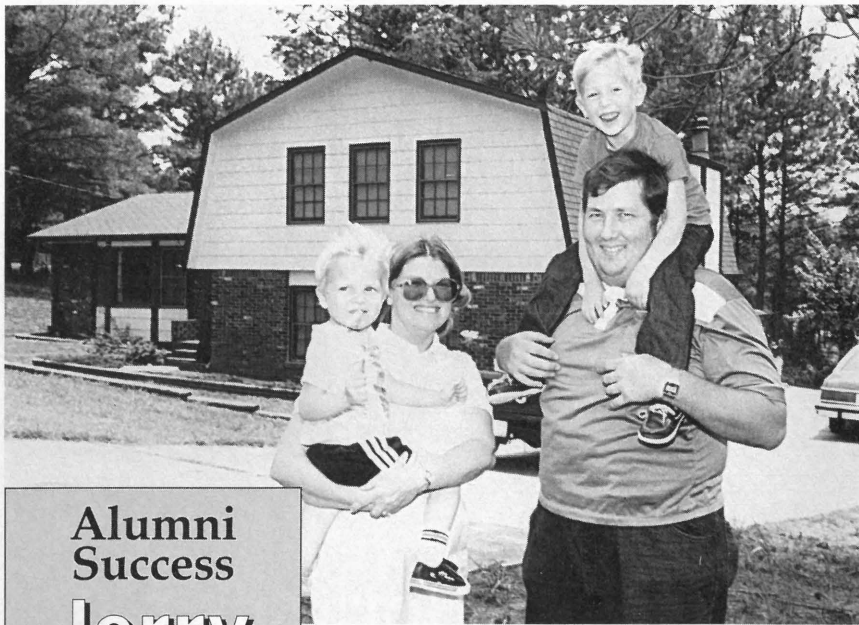

Alumni Success Jerry Willard

Jeanne and Jerry Willard raised their sons with some of the same strong family values taught at the Boys Ranch.

Life was tough for little Jerry Willard, but thanks to former Pinellas County Sheriff Don Genung and the generosity of our donor family, he found a new life at the Florida Sheriffs Boys Ranch.

Think back to 1956. Even as the idea of a Ranch for needy and neglected boys was just a thought, tragic things were happening in the life of this little eight year old boy. His mother had committed suicide and his absent father was an alcoholic. Nearly an orphan, his grandmother took him in and did her best to provide the basics of life.

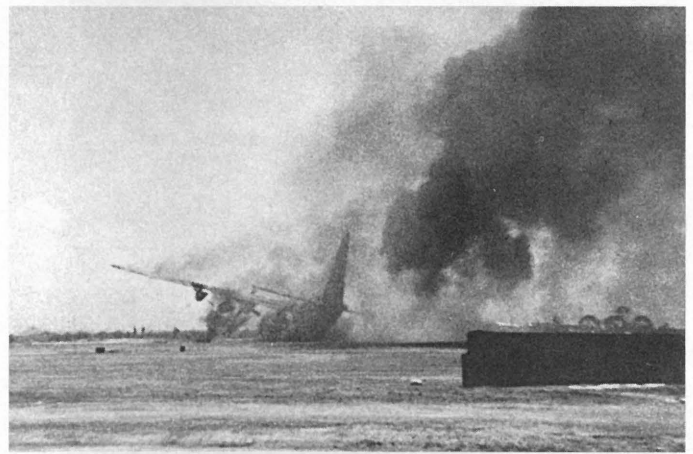
By 1960, this sweet young child had grown into an active young teen and his grandmother, now 75, wasn't able to keep up with the changing needs of a boy his age. She knew his behavior was headed down the wrong path so she sought the help of her local Sheriff Don Genung. He knew the answer right away. The Florida Sheriffs Boys Ranch would be the perfect place for a boy like Jerry.

On a hot August day in 1960, Jerry Willard began a new chapter in his life as he became the 22nd boy admitted to the Florida Sheriffs Boys Ranch. The Ranch was still in its infancy, with only two cottages and a barn built on 140 acres of land. However, there was plenty of room for a boy to grow and learn.

Jerry needed structure and loving guidance in his life. He would benefit greatly from a well-rounded education and the development of some hands on work experience. He got all this and so much more at

the Boys Ranch. In fact, the essence of what he needed was exactly what he found. Here, Jerry discovered both a home and a family.

And, as boys will be boys, Jerry claims the title of many "firsts" at the Ranch. "I was the "first boy" to have his own go cart (without permission), the first boy to run away to Peoria, Illinois and only make it as far as the Live Oak train station, and the first boy to marry the daughter of his cottage parents."

Of course, this didn't happen until 1969, after he had left the Ranch and joined the military. On a very proud note, Jerry was also the "first Rancher" to enlist in the United States Air Force.

Having a long time fascination for planes, Jerry had signed up to be a Loadmaster - one of the few fly-

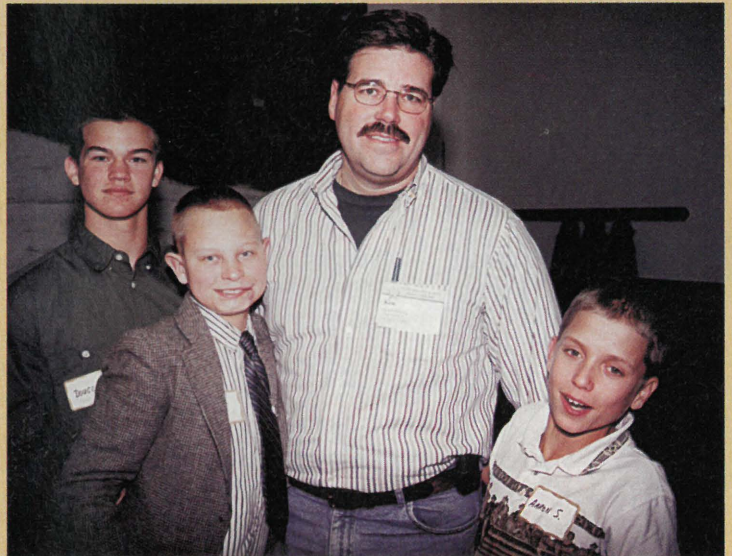


Suwannee County Sheriff Al Williams reminded everyone about the focus of the day... "getting involved and supporting the Youth Ranches."

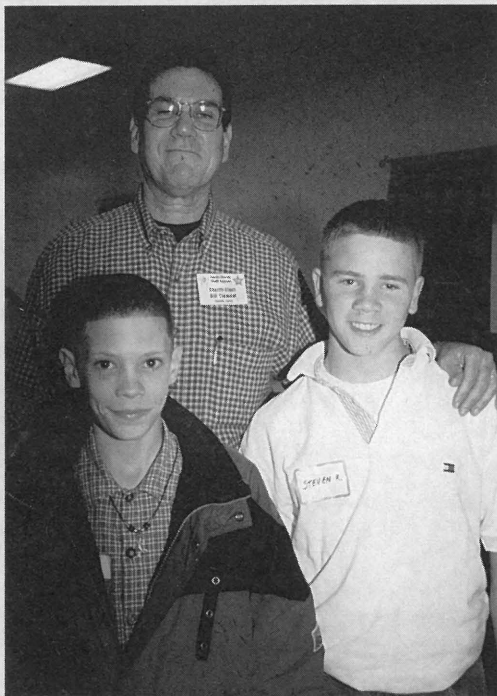

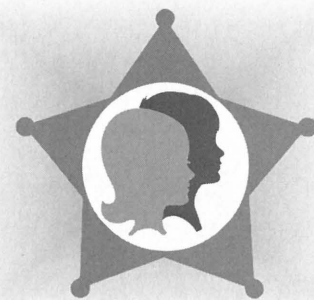

Three Brothers Find A New Home!

They were not the perfect family but life seemed fairly normal. A single mom working hard to support and raise her three boys. School, work and family filled their days and warmed their hearts. Then, one day on the way to work, tragedy struck! The fierce impact of an automobile accident immediately took the life of their mother and left the boys to face the world alone.

Other relatives cared deeply about the future of these young men, especially their Great Aunt Blanca. But, given her immediate family obligations, she could not take on the enormous responsibility of raising three teenage boys. The only available option divided the family by placing each boy in a separate home. The middle boy, Francisco, age 15, felt it was very unfair. "It wasn't easy. They just split us up and moved us apart."

Rich, the oldest son, was not happy about this situation either. He was now the leader of this fragmented family and fought hard to reunite his brothers. He was determined to find a place where they could be together. Understanding his feelings, family members and friends began to search for a better option. Everyone knew Rich was right and the boys belonged together!

A call for help to the Youth Ranches Social Worker began the process of reuniting the brothers. With a bit of extra effort and teamwork, a new plan emerged. All three brothers were soon accepted at the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranch in Bradenton/Sarasota. Here, they found a new home, living together in Sotatee Cottage with six other boys. The brothers all agree that their Cottage Parents are very special folks. Rich expressed it well, "Right now, I don't have a real mother or father and that is why Mom and Pop Pace mean so much to me. They are the best!"

To know the feeling is mutual, all you have to do is drop by the cottage after school. As Mom brings out the



chips for snack, she also gathers the ingredients for some homemade dip. "Everything is ready for Francisco," she quips, looking forward to teaching him a new recipe. "He loves to help in the kitchen!"

She then recalled a story when the boys were planning to host some special guests for dinner. Francisco made three different homemade desserts - a pumpkin cheesecake, a cherry cheesecake, and a peanut butter pie. One of the guests was so impressed and eager to sample Francisco's culinary talents, she requested "a sliver of each." With a slightly puzzled look, Francisco nodded his head and returned to the kitchen.

He leaned within earshot and quietly whispered, "Mom, What's a 'sliver'?" She smiled and gently responded, "a thin slice, son." Once again, she was reminded that each interaction is an opportunity to teach these youngsters something new.

Pop agrees, and continues to brag about Francisco. "He



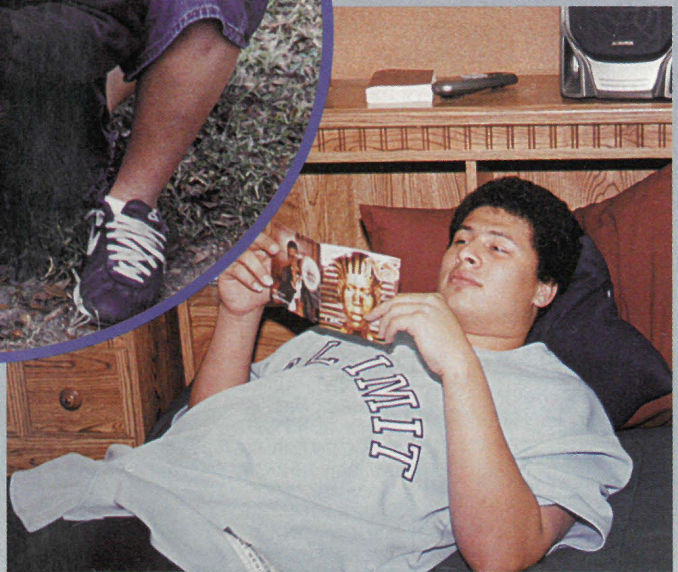

also has a real knack for fixing things. The other day his chores included mowing the lawn, but the machine wouldn't start. He called me and together we took the mower apart, fixed the problem and put it back together. You should have seen the smile on his face when he pulled the cord and the engine fired up!" When asked about these things, Francisco shrugged his shoulders and replied, "I am a hard worker. I don't stop until the job is done and I get it done right!"

David (13) is the youngest of the three brothers. He prefers to be called "Chi-Chi" because it was the affectionate nickname given to him at birth by his mother. He is a typical, energetic youngster who enjoys computer games and dreams of playing professional football for the Miami Dolphins. "I want to be a running back," he fiercely proclaims. Mom Pace winks and then boasts, "Chi-Chi is also a very good student. His teacher said he was one of the hardest working guys at the Learning Center. If he keeps

going in this direction, we hope he can transfer back to the public school and then join the football team!" And like most mothers, she then adds, "All our boys received great reviews at school. They work very hard and make good grades!"

So for now, and until they turn 18, these boys have found a home, a life filled with love, guidance and structure. They will grow and change, learn and dream. Each will find his way, knowing the path is a bit easier because they will not walk alone. Rich acknowledges this fact with great appreciation "This is the best place for us because we can be together."

Roster of Builders - This Honor Roll gives special recognition to generous supporters of the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches and its six child-care programs: the Florida Sheriffs Boys Ranch, Youth Villa, Youth Ranch/Safety Harbor, Youth Ranch-Bradenton/Sarasota, Youth Camp, and Caruth Camp. Those who give \$250 or more in cash, or \$500 or more in non-cash gifts, receive a Builder Certificate. For gifts of \$50,000 or more, there is the Golden Star Award. Donors of \$100,000 or more receive the Grand Star Award. We want our donors to know we have never permitted other organizations to use our lists of supporters, and we will continue to do everything possible to preserve their privacy.

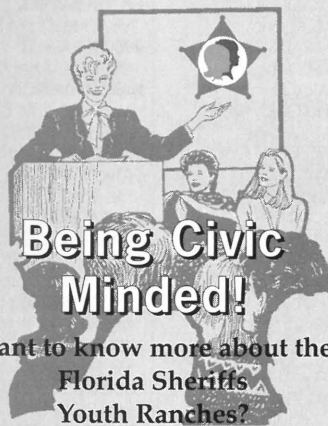
