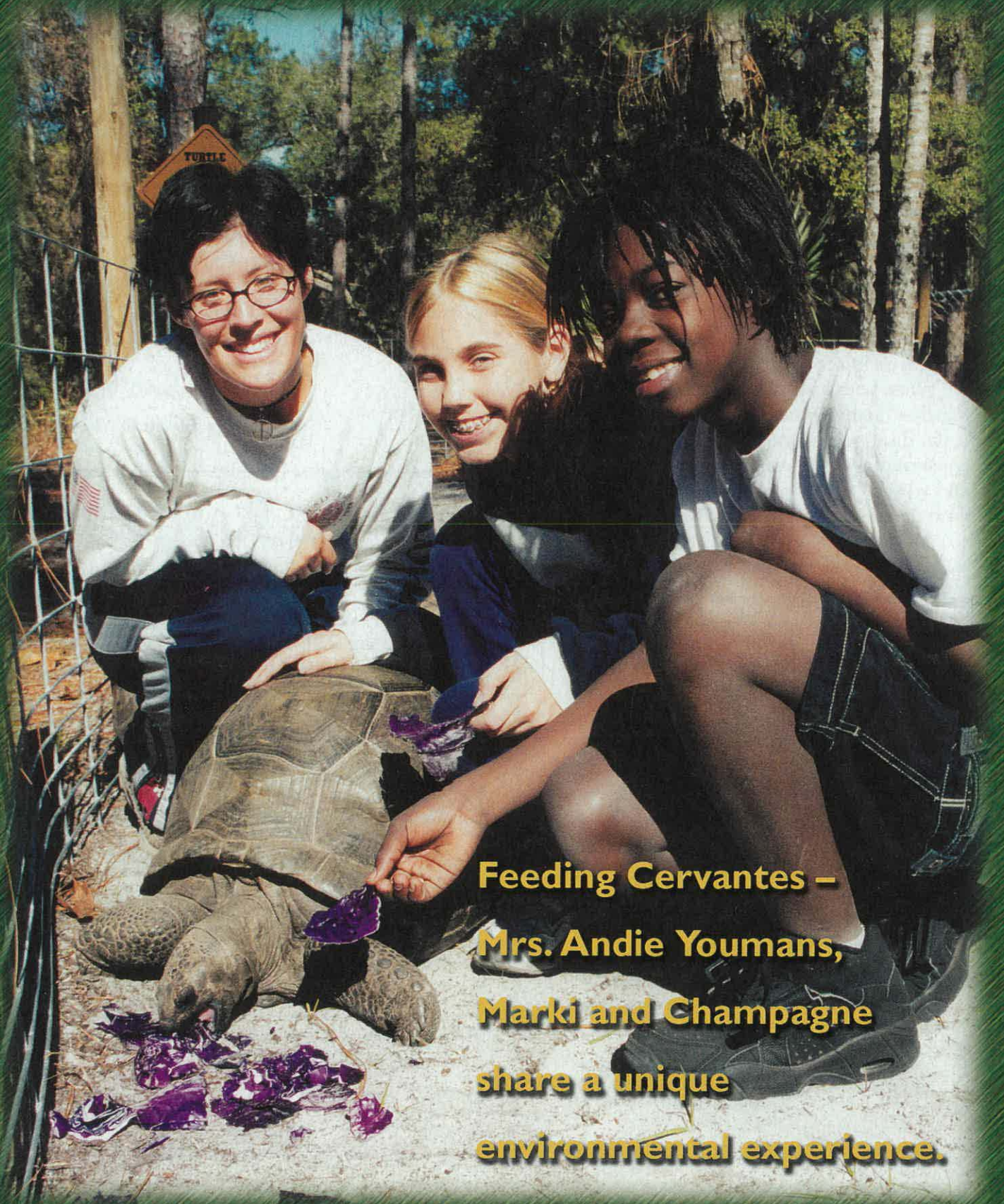

Exciting Exotic Animals

An educational experience to remember!

Dana and Andie Youmans have a very unique family. Their "children" include Skippy the caiman, Oedipus the yellow bellied slider turtle, Snuffy the duck, Darwin and Cervantes the tortoises, Nora the boa constrictor, and many other fish, birds, snakes, spiders and even a gecko! Each one has experienced some type of injury, neglect or abuse and now they have a safe home where all of their needs are met by this trained and caring couple.

With college degrees, teaching certifications and the proper special permits to house and care for these exotic animals, the Youmans wanted to find a place of employment where they could teach youngsters how to appreciate and respect these special creatures. The Florida Sheriff's Youth Camp proved to be the ideal location for their unique family.

"Challenge by choice," exclaims Mrs. Youmans as the group of girls approach the Environmental Education Center that houses the animals. She goes on to explain, "each person comes to this class with a different set of experiences and fears. We want the kids to learn, without fear, so we let them choose how close they want to get to the animals. We talk about respecting the space and feelings of the animals (i.e. no taunting or tapping on the glass) as they have a first-hand experience in environmental education."

Starting with some known and familiar animals, Mr. Youmans talks to the children about, Snuffy the duck, Oedipus the turtle and the two rabbits. "We rescued Oedipus in the middle of I-95. His shell was

cracked and we didn't think he would survive. We took him home, put him in our bathtub and figured out a way to keep his shell together until it healed." Obviously the process took time, a safe haven and lots of loving attention. Except for the scar on his shell, he is now thriving and doing very well.

Then, inside the building, the youngsters see more unique animals. Naturally, some kids move to the back of the group while others surge forward to see

each and every member of the Youmans' family.

"Wow – A REAL GECKO!" or "Eeeew – a big, slithery snake" can be heard as the group stops at each animal's home. Questions flow freely as the campers learn how to hold some of the animals, what they eat, where they live and why they do some of the things they do. "This is pretty cool," claims one youngster "...much better than seeing it in a book!"

And finally, as the girls exit the building, they walk through a habitat set up for Cervantes and Darwin –

two huge tortoises. By now, much of the fear about these animals has disappeared. They kneel down and hold some cabbage for the tortoises to eat as they gently stroke their shell. Somehow, these young teens truly understand what it is like to be different, to need special care and to appreciate the healing tenderness and attention of others. This unique educational experience will surely be one to remember!

"Writing makes me feel good...my mind uses it as an outlet to express my feelings and emotions."

Quiet, almost shy, this 17 year-old budding author begins to speak with an awkward hesitation. She shares fragmented pieces of her past...living with extended family, struggles in several different schools and other complicated issues that led her to live with us at the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranch. "It is not easy for me to talk about my feelings," Summer softly said.

Wanting to trust, she cautiously steers the conversation to an area of comfort and success...creative writing. "I have always been creative and knew my future would involve some form of art. The turning point for me was in the 9th grade when I realized I could express my thoughts and feelings on paper."

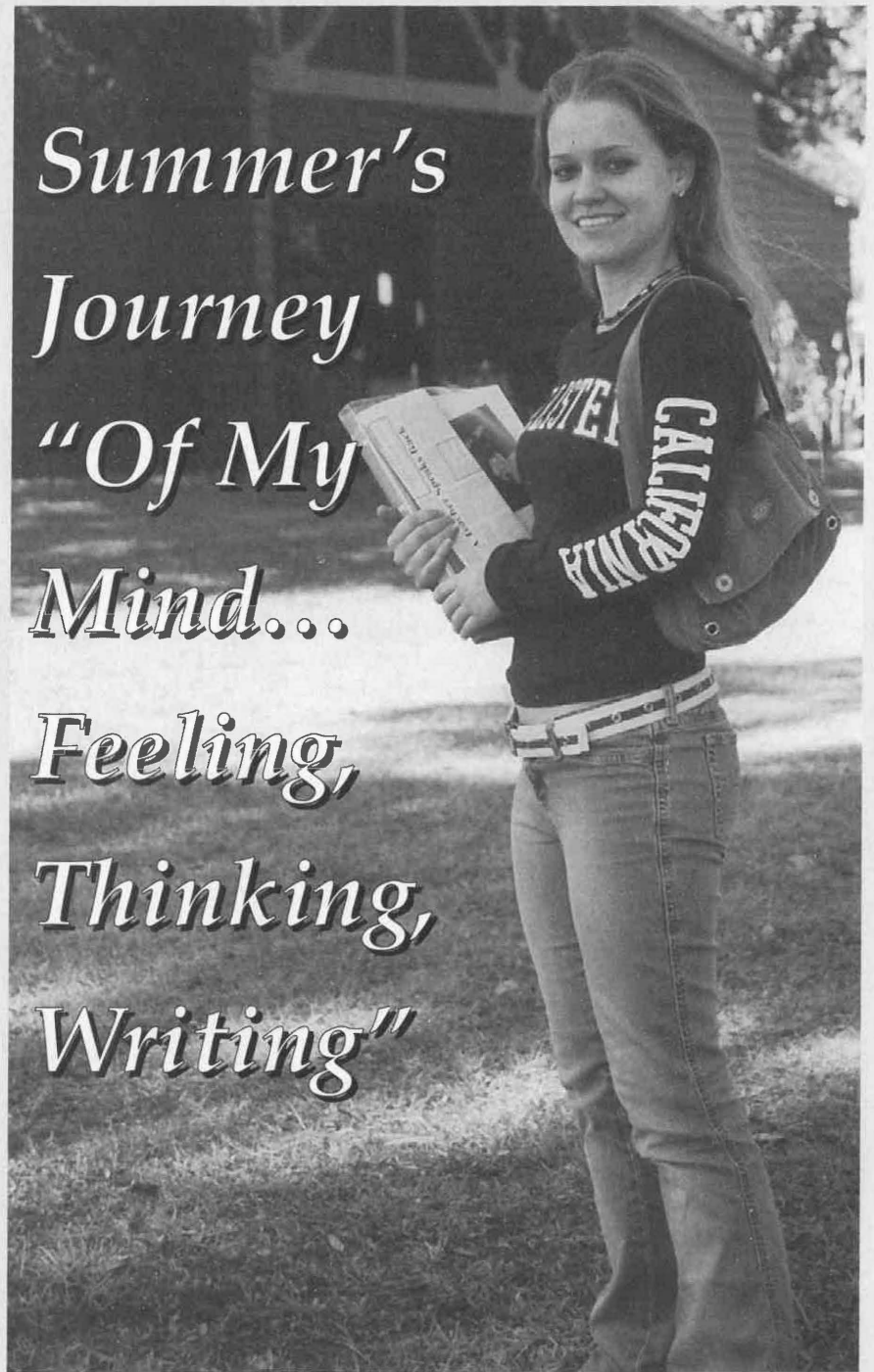
"It is therapeutic – I can genuinely convey my anger, frustration and other emotions..." she adds with candor.

There is a dramatic flair and a unique sense of isolation in Summer's writing. Yet, she is open to constructive criticism. "I appreciate feedback, as long as it is not destructive." One of the most important lessons she has learned is to try to read her work from another person's point of view. "If you connect with another person's thoughts and emotions, then you have truly achieved something."

With her future coming into focus, Summer plans to study journalism in school and pursue a career as a fiction novelist. She envisions herself as a successful, self supporting author, living in a big farmhouse near a small country church. "I want to have time by myself – peaceful, quiet and serene – the perfect setting to explore my thoughts and write stories that are grounded in reality, but full of suspense, emotion and imagination."

And, when that day comes and Summer publishes her first novel, there is no doubt it will be dedicated to the most important person in her world – her best friend and much admired older brother J. D. "More than anything else, I want to make him proud of me!"

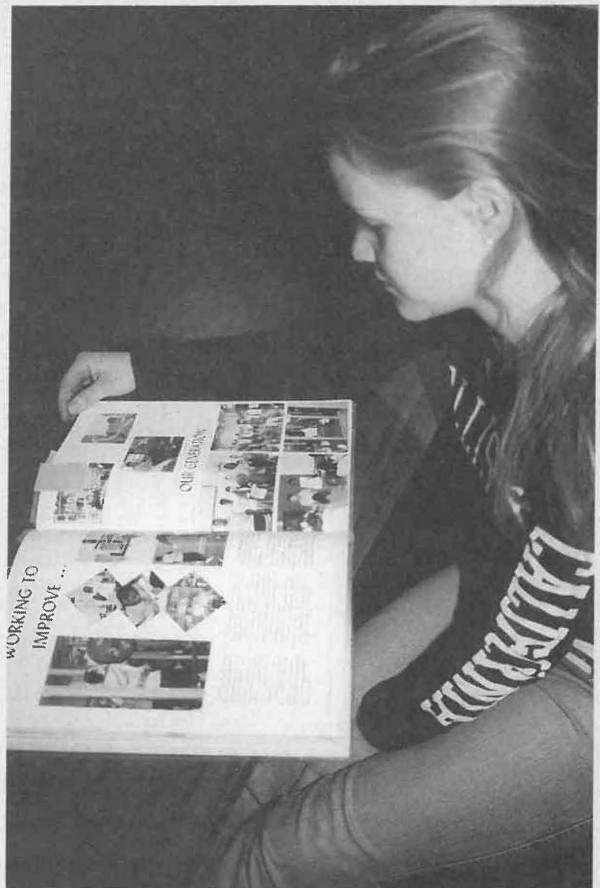

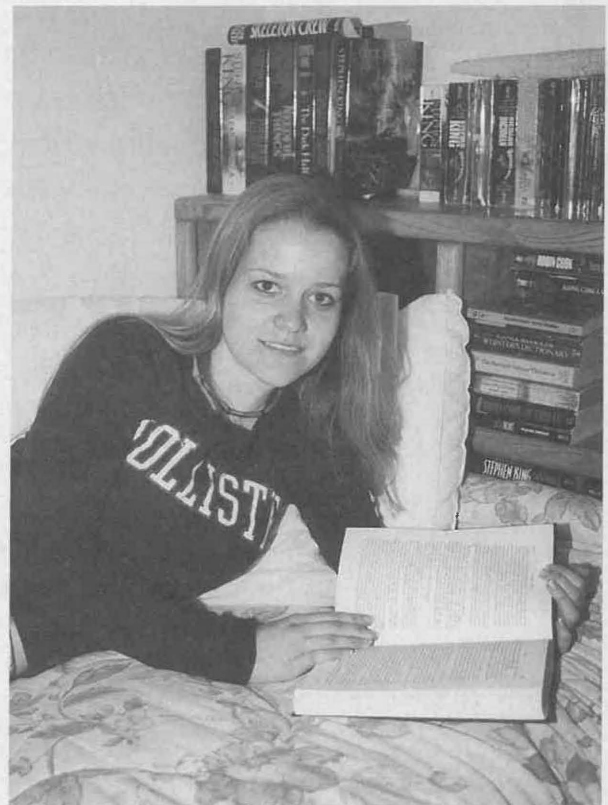
Of My Mind

Since I've Come to the Ranch

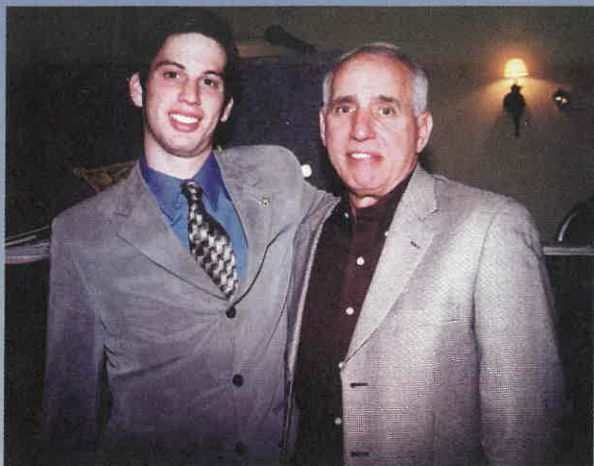


Since I've come to the Ranch I've been able to stay clean

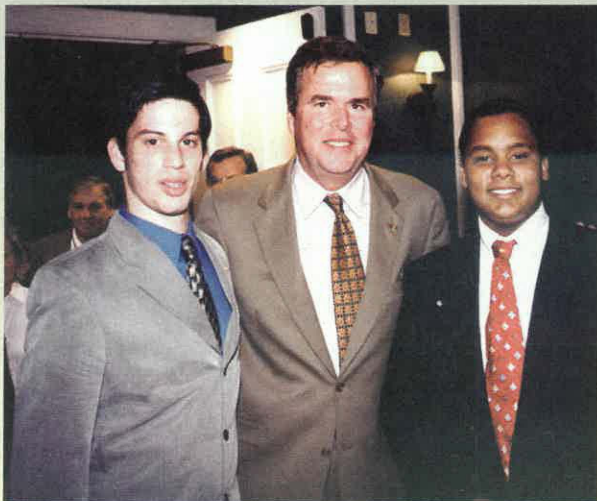


Ryan Shines

Boot Camp "Gives Back" Car in "Operation Fender Bender"

"Operation Give Back" allows the Pinellas County Boot Camp Cadets the opportunity to repair donated bicycles which are given to youngsters who would otherwise not have bicycles. As a spin off from the "Give Back" program, "Operation Fender Bender" was instituted to provide the Cadets with the opportunity to do body work on a car and give it back to the community.

Approximately 100 hours of work was put into a 1996 Oldsmobile Cutlass Supreme vehicle with three to five Cadets working on the vehicle at a time. Largo Auto Body Shop donated a new paint job to complete the project, and a resident of the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranch in Safety Harbor was selected to be the recipient of the car.

Preparing for the Fair

For some people, the county fair is little more than some bright lights, zany rides and tempting junk food all geared toward spending some of your earnings on an evening of fun. But, for others, the county fair is a huge multi-day event requiring hours of preparation and planning.

The Florida Sheriffs Boys Ranch is located in a small rural county and we think the county fair, and especially the livestock show, is a very big deal. Our boys spend hours preparing to show their heifers in the hope of winning the coveted blue ribbon.

In late fall and early winter, Farm Manager Dustin Jones sizes up the boys interest, talent and dedication to the heifer program. He prepares the boys for the challenges before them and reminds them every competitor is deemed a winner if he puts forth his best effort.

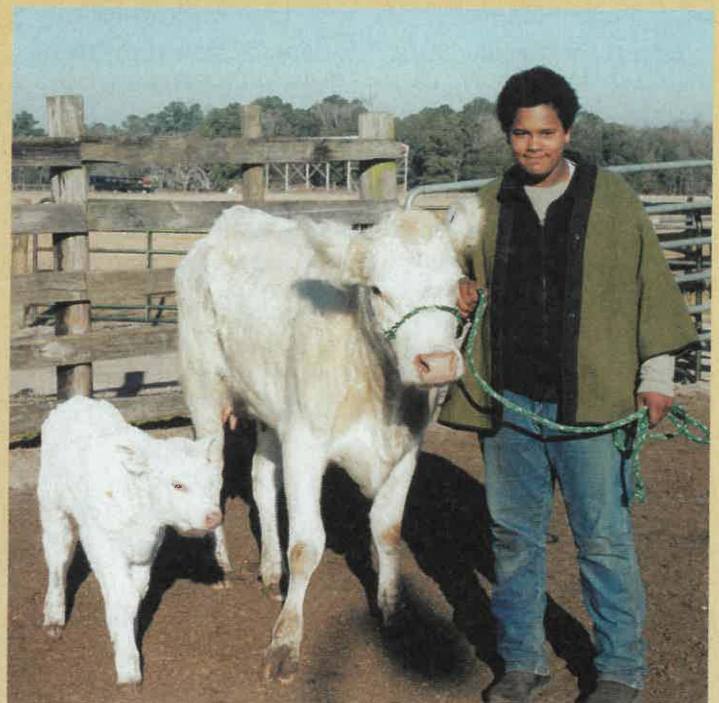
Only a handful of boys are selected to compete. They must demonstrate a willingness to work hard, get dirty and be diligent in their responsibility to the animal in their care. The commitment includes weeknights, after school and time on Saturdays that may keep them from other activities on the Ranch. Each boy understands the choices as he agrees to do his best in the heifer program.

As the winter months progress, the boys will groom, feed and care for their heifer, begin to lead her on a rope halter, understand how to position the animal properly for judging and learn many other details unique to showing heifers in competition.

In the end, there will only be one "Best in Show" blue ribbon winner, but we know this experience will teach our boys many valuable lessons that will last a life time.

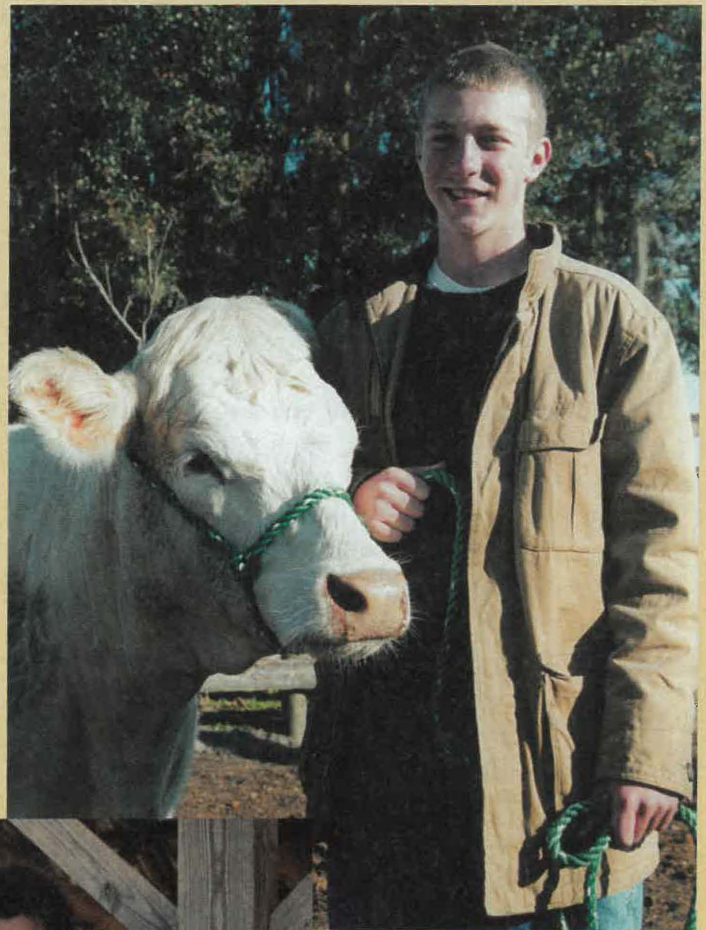
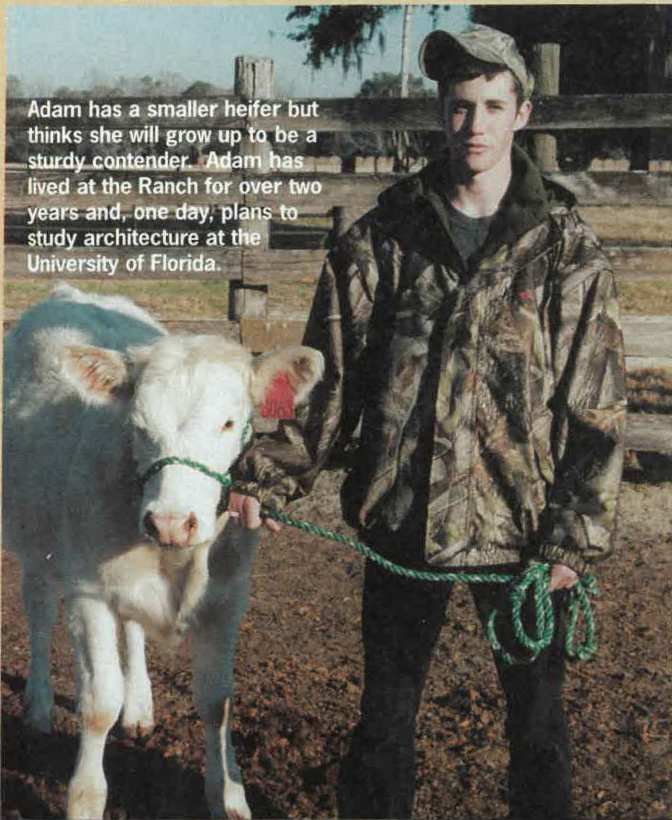

Will you help a child get to Summer Camp?

"If something does not change that child's life, he will end up in jail one day."

Willie was one of those kids...

He grew up in a very poor, crime-infested area. His grandmother could not afford to move, so Willie went to school and tried his best to stay out of trouble...something that was not easy to do in his neighborhood.

Then, one day, a school counselor told him about the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches Summer Camp. The camp brochure said, "If you don't have everything on the list of items to bring, please come anyway"... so he did.

Healing Help

The headlines of the local paper read "Abused Animals Treated," but the hidden story is found in hearts of those who helped in the healing.

Eight horses and several other animals were found in terrible condition in a small barn and car port during an investigation by the Polk County Sheriffs Office. The animals were immediately taken to the Sheriff's farm for evaluation, treatment and rehabilitation. After the veterinarian's examination was complete, the process of nursing these animals back to health began.

Based on his volunteer work at the Florida Sheriffs Youth Villa, Detective Shawn Stephenson knew right where to find the help he needed. Instead of going to the movies or mall with their cottage, three compassionate and hard-working young ladies volunteered five hours on a Saturday to assist Detective Stephenson in the care of these abused horses.

When she saw the condition of the horse, Amber was shocked. Their manes and tails were matted and covered in manure. She immediately wondered "how can anybody do that to an animal?"

The girls quickly went to work bathing, grooming and feeding the horses. Carefully and patiently, they combed out the snarls and knots as they tenderly provided healing help for these hurting horses.

"I am so glad they are now in the Sheriff's care," said Charlene. "I hope they get placed in the right home where they will be cared for and loved."

Ironically, Charlene's words apply not only to these abused and neglected horses, but also to the basic core mission of the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches as we care for the abused, neglected and troubled children of Florida.
