In my office hangs a small, wooden plaque given to me years ago by my wife, Sheila. Engraved on it are the words "Nothing you do for children is ever wasted." This quote is by the creator and central figure in "A Prairie Home Companion," Garrison Keillor. This program has aired on public radio for over thirty years.

Over the years, I have often looked at this plaque and been reminded of its words. I have come to realize the times I notice it most are during the tougher situations and difficulties. All of us need a reminder of why we do what we do and the reasons for our efforts, but during the most difficult times we need these reminders even more than when things are a little easier.

The past several years have been a real strain and struggle for our country. We are experiencing the worst recession of our generation and many families are without work. The number of homes in foreclosure are rising and more families are applying for food stamps and welfare every day which is overloading our social services system.

The Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches has not been spared the pain during this time. Charitable donations are down and our revenue is below what it was three years ago. As we meet with our staff and Board of Directors, we are diligently working on ways to meet our budget shortfall. So far, we have been able to fill the gap with money we put in savings during some better financial times. Because of these savings, we have not had to reduce any services to children. We are aware that our savings will not last much longer, but they have allowed us to continue providing homes, clothing, food, education and other services to the children in our care so far.

Each of you receive *The Rancher* because you have chosen to make donations to the Youth Ranches. I cannot express to you how much I appreciate your generosity and support. Without you, we would already have cut back on services and would have to tell children we could not care for them any longer.

As you read the stories in this issue of *The Rancher*, notice the pride and determination in the faces of the youngsters. Each of them has come so far and wants a successful life. I have been working with children for the past 37 years and have seen the difference we can make in young lives. I know more than ever that "*Nothing we do for children is ever wasted*." Your investment in them will pay great dividends in their homes and local communities for many years in the future.

As I close, I would ask each of you to keep us in your prayers. We not only need the funds to continue our work with children but also the wisdom and direction to know the best way to maneuver through this difficult time. I am fully confident we will make it through these times and continue to be there for the young people who need our care.

The Youth Ranches believes that for young people to grow into healthy and productive adults, it is important they are taught basic principles needed for success. We have narrowed these life lessons into four basic areas we call the Work, Study, Play and Pray philosophy. All of our programs weave this philosophy into the daily life on campus and use it to help build character and healthy self esteem in our children.

work: Everyone must learn the value of work if they are to be successful in life. A strong work ethic is learned through having regular chores as well as various jobs while growing up. Each Youth Ranches child is expected to keep their room clean, do their own laundry and help with chores around the cottage. They are not paid for these chores but expected to do them as a part of the cottage family.


Along with their chores, each child has a specific job on campus. In order to get a job, they must fill out an application and interview with their potential boss. Jobs are located at a variety of worksites around campus but can include farm work, maintenance, food services, grounds keeping, mechanics or office work. In their job, youth earn spending money but more importantly, they learn work skills and how to work with a boss and co-workers.

each child who comes to us should receive the benefit of as much education as they can absorb. Since many of our youth come with educational deficits, most begin their studies at one of our on-campus schools. Through personally designed education plans, tutoring and special classes, they are able to get caught up in their schoolwork and often are able to get back on grade average.

Along with their schoolwork, youth learn proper behavior, study habits and respect for their teachers. If they prove they can succeed, youth often are able to leave our campus school and attend public schools. This privilege enables them to try out their new skills in a more competitive setting.

For youth who graduate high school from the Youth Ranches programs, a wide variety of further

education is possible through the Youth Ranches Scholarship Program. This includes college, trade or vocational school, or other advanced training for those who qualify.

PLAY: One of the greatest problems we see in many young people is that they do not know how to use their time in a positive manner. Because of this, they watch hours of television, play video games or just "hang out" with their friends.



At the Youth Ranches, we want to introduce our youngsters to a wide variety of positive activities and show them the joys of having positive fun.

Activities at the programs include athletics of all sorts and all types of outdoor activities such as bicycling, fishing, camping, hiking and canoeing. Arts, music, drama and creative writing are encouraged along with woodworking and crafts. Some of our programs have active horseback riding programs and we have found this to be very effective in working with tough youth. It is a wonderful experience to see children learn to control a large animal and then use those principles to control their own behavior.

Our philosophy is to surround our kids with as many positive experiences as possible and encourage them to experiment with different activities to see which ones they enjoy and gain success.

PRAY: Although the Youth Ranches is not a religious or denominational children's home, we have found and truly believe that life is not complete without a spiritual base. Each resident of our programs is required to attend religious services weekly. Prayers are said at each meal and regular devotions are held in the cottages.

It is our belief that young people need to know there is a God who cares deeply about them and has a plan for their lives. As youth attend church or chapel services and learn more, they are encouraged to commit their lives to God and allow Him to guide them as they grow and mature.

Sounds simple, right? Well you would be amazed at how many children we serve who have never experienced these basic concepts. It takes time, patience, attention and so much more to nurture our children into productive, healthy young adults. If you believe and embrace these principles, please know we are only successful because of you...your gifts provide the day to day funding we need to ensure these children have a brighter future.




The need is evident and ongoing. Florida is a large state and we want to continue to serve as many children as funds permit. Thank you for giving thoughtful consideration to provide us with the tools





Another thing the Ranch has taught me was to be more confident in myself and that in life anything is possible. Especially when you have help like I have here living at the Ranch. I live in the transitional cottage on campus where we use the positive peer culture to help bridge the gap between the Ranch life and the adult world off the Ranch. This cottage is designed to teach us day-to-day life skills like how to complete a resume', cook meals for yourself and schedule out or day to day planning.

The Ranch has also helped me work out my future plans. At this time, I want to join the Army, become a Ranger and to prove to myself that I am somebody and that nothing is going to stop me from doing what I want to do."





ur mom died when we were very young," 17 year old Laurelee said rather matter-of-factly. "My dad was a truck driver who was rarely home. I was the older sister, so naturally I helped 'raise' my little sister."

Being in an adult role while still young is never easy. Laurelee did the best she could, but there seemed to be a growing resentment between the sisters. Over time, Laurelee began to realize she needed help, especially in school. About two and a half years ago, she found a new home at the Florida Sheriffs Youth Villa.

"I am really glad I am here. Without the Youth Villa, I know I would have struggled more in school. I use to get F's because I never went to school. Now, I make A's and B's and live in a stable home with great Cottage Parents who give me the guidance and support I need to succeed. The Youth Villa has completely turned my life around."

Six months later, Laurelee's younger sister Audrey joined her at the Youth Villa. Audrey had been fighting with their dad because of trouble with school. She was so far behind, she just wanted to give up! Audrey's progress has been remarkable. She credits her Cottage Parents for her success. "Mom and Pop know what to say and what to do...they can be pretty strict but they know I need

it. They hold me accountable and encourage me to do my very best. Now, I am making A's and B's and hope one day to be a traveling nurse."

The relationship between the sisters is healing, too. Initially, they purposely lived in different cottages so each could grow and mature under the nurturing love of their Cottage Parents. "It was tough to transition back into being a sister, not the parent," said Laurelee, "but now I can be a mentor and leader for all the girls here, including my sister."

Audrey added, "I once looked at Laurelee like a mother which was sometimes tough. We are doing okay and now we live in the same cottage." And just like sisters sometimes do, the girls share similar interests such as being avid GATOR fans and a desire to continue their education after they graduate from high school. "We are trying really hard to make it. We know we have opportunities here and we are very fortunate to be here."

Katharine Doe Chalmers wanted to serve her country and received a direct commission into the United States Naval Reserves in 1942. She served on the Headquarters staff at the Naval Air Station in Jacksonville, reporting directly to the Chief of Naval Air Operations. During this time, she was promoted to LCDR and was involved with development of THE BLUE ANGELS, becoming fondly known as the "Mother" of THE BLUE ANGELS.

In 1948, she transferred from the Naval Reserve to the US Navy and reported to the Chief of the Bureau of Aeronautics. Among other duties, LCDR Chalmers worked as The Naval Liaison Officer to the United States Congress and handling assignments issued by The Secretary of the Navy and The Judge Advocate General. In 1962, she retired from the Navy but continued to serve her community in many different ways.

"Kitsy" (as she was known to her friends) and her husband, David, retired to Florida in 2003. They shared a desire to have a secure retirement and make a substantial gift to a worthy charity. After careful consideration, Mr. Chalmers purchased a Charitable Gift Annuity with the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches. He was quite pleased with the arrangement which paid Kitsy a fixed percentage of the original principal (based on her age, this was 11.3% annually) until her death earlier this year. "She would be so proud to know that the income was available to her while she lived and now that she is gone, her money is being used to help the boys and girls of the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches."


Youth Villa Classic Check Presentation




