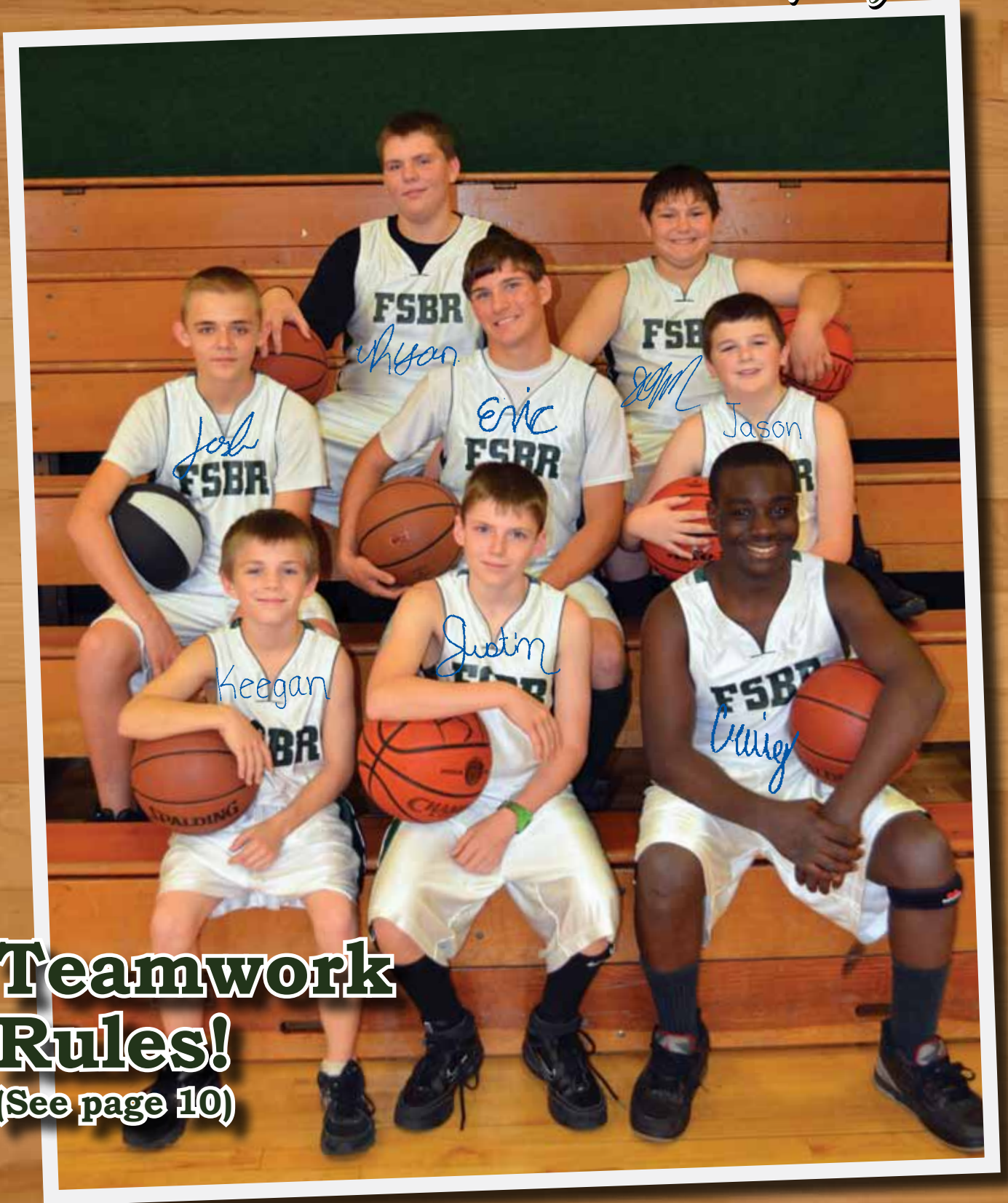

Imagine two boys under the age of 10, worlds apart by distance yet discovering the same fascination for pipe organs in an identical way. Sitting on a pew, feet dangling, bored by the sermon, each stared ahead and began counting pipes.



When the words stopped, glorious music filled the sanctuary and soothed the soul. Forty plus years later, each one describes the beginning of their life's passion as they work together to restore the beautiful pipe organ at a local church.

Known as the "King of Musical Instruments", the pipe organ has more harmonics than a symphony orchestra. This particular organ has 657 handmade pipes and 10 ranks. Damaged by flooding from Tropical Storm Debby, the church called upon Boys Ranch Alumnus Jerry Stacy to help rebuild this grand and glorious masterpiece.

Because Jerry built his own pipe organ at his home, he knows all the experts in the field. Organ Builder Bob Weaver, a member of the American Pipe Organ Builders Association, immediately agreed to help Jerry with the restoration. "My mentor was Mr. William D. Manly of Oglethorpe University," Bob said humbly as the two men attended to this magnif-

icent, delicate and complex Schantz pipe organ. "It is a lost art and takes a keen ear and craftsman's hand to do it right."

Jerry brought his love of music to the Ranch when he arrived in 1961 at the age of 11. His abilities and talent were evident, but the prodigy needed expert guidance. Ranch officials quickly reached out to Dr. Kent, Professor and Dean of Music at Florida State University, who traveled to Live Oak once a week to mentor the young pupil.

After attending North Florida Junior College and having studied composition and performance for piano and Orchestral Conducting at FSU. Jerry received a special award for composition of "The Tides" arranged for two pianos and voice. Jerry also recorded four albums, one of which he is particularly proud of "HEART KEYS" by Rising Star Records because it raised money for children and adults fighting AIDS. The album brought together 13 composers and

performers from all over the world, including the use of "I'll Be Seeing You" arranged and performed by Liberace. "I am so blessed to have had this career in music and it's all because the Boys Ranch offered me the chance to live my pas-

sion for music," Jerry said. Childhood experiences, often seeming insignificant at the time, can be vital to who we become. Imagine if Jerry's love for music had not been identified and nurtured at the Ranch...Imagine if a faithful mentor had not invested the time and commitment to the boy... Imagine if the local church community had not embraced and welcomed him...Imagine the difference you can make!

Think about your current support of the children in our care. Which one of them will grow up to become a masterful composer and performer? Which one will discover a cure for a disease? Which one will change the world?

A LEADER, A FRIEND, and A PHILANTHROPIST

Antoinette “Toni” Stabile is an award winning investigative journalist and free-lance writer. Her four books under three titles investigated cosmetics and grooming products used daily by the entire population. The *Los Angeles Times* called her first book, *Cosmetics: Trick or Treat?*, the most chilling expose` since *Ralph Nader’s Unsafe at Any Speed*. It prompted US Senate hearings, a TV award for Service to Consumers and mandatory ingredient disclosure and labeling of all cosmetic ingredients from toothpaste to foot powder.

Her next two books, *Cosmetics: The Great American Skin Game* and its updated version, told of the journey to the enactment of the law. The final book, *Everything You Want to Know About Cosmetics or What Your Friendly Clerk Didn’t Tell You*, wrapped up her investigations and answered questions she’d received during her appear-

ances, TV specials and correspondence.

After successful careers in journalism and advertising, Toni became the vice president, then president of the family foundation named for her late brother, Vincent A. Stabile, who was a very successful engineer, inventor and industrialist.

Vincent led in degrees with an ME in Mechanical Engineering and PHD in Humanities from Pratt Institute and an MA in Industrial Engineering from Columbia University. He interrupted his career to enlist as a Naval Officer in World War II.

Toni graduated with a BA in Journalism and Advertising from the University of Kentucky with post-graduate study at Columbia.

The Stabile philanthropies in Florida include buying the original land for the Naples Botanical Garden, the Vincent A. Stabile Building at the Mayo Clinic in Jacksonville, the Vincent A.

Stabile Research Building in the Moffitt Cancer Center in Tampa, the Toni Stabile Educational Building at the Naples Philharmonic for the Arts, Harry Chapin Food Bank refrigerated truck, the Toni Stabile School of Nursing, Collier Campus, at the Edison State College, the Naples Junior Deputies, and others.

Toni’s interest in the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches began by funding a new water system. Hearing that two cottages had been closed because of a shortage of funds, she gave enough to re-open them. She then funded the remodeling of a 30 year old commercial kitchen at the Youth Camp in Barberville.

Recently, Toni established an endowment for continuing education of our young adults.

Sinibaldi. He has motivated me to finish my Biology and English for the school year and my GPA is now a 3.5.

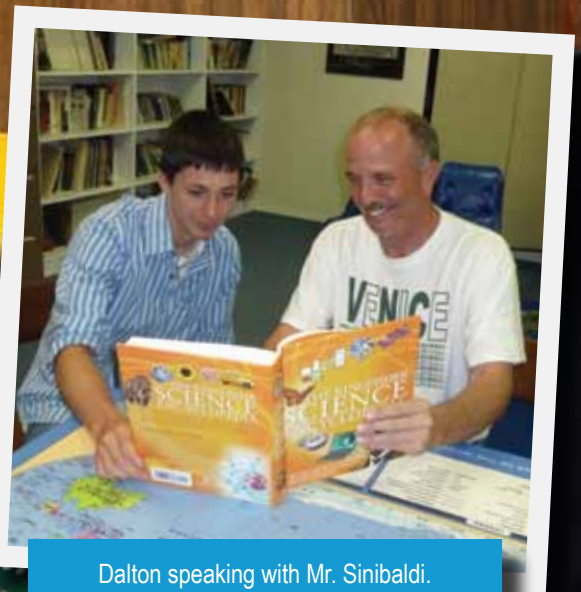
