Last spring, the Youth Ranches family celebrated as two of our young ladies received college diplomas. Cathy and Victoria had been roommates during their years at our Safety Harbor campus. Both of them had overcome many obstacles while in our program and with the support of their cottage parents and other staff, graduated high school and qualified for the Youth Ranches college scholarship program. As Cathy began her studies at Stetson and Victoria enrolled at Flagler College, they were assigned staff mentors who encouraged, assisted and supported them as they adjusted to college life.

Both of these young ladies made us proud as their excellent grades and the wise choices they made enabled them to don caps and gowns and be recognized for their work with hard won diplomas from these prestigious colleges.

Now, Cathy is working in the field of business and Victoria is pursuing a Masters Degree in New York City. I have every confidence these women will continue their success as they reach for and attain the goals they have set.

I relate this story because Cathy and Victoria are just two of the many stories of what the Youth Ranches means in the life of children. Every day, young people come to us who have been broken by life. Their experiences have been difficult at best and in many instances their hurts can seem insurmountable. How can a youngster overcome rejection, abuse, neglect and hard times and turn into a caring and productive person who is able to give back to a world that seemed to be against them?





At the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches we are responsible for raising lawful, productive citizens. When taking care of boys and girls we provide a warm home, food, education, teach social skills and prepare them for the future. Preparing for the future includes teaching young people how to drive!

Keenan has been with us for 6 months now. He received his drivers permit in August of 2012. Keenan needed the opportunity to practice his driving skills so he could earn his regular license. Mom Gillum has had experience with several teen drivers so she stepped up to the challenge.

Keenan enjoys these driving sessions with Mom Gillum. “I don’t worry about anything when I am driving

because my mind is on the road, he says. It is a ‘get-away.’” Like most teenagers, the thing that is most difficult about driving is staying at the appropriate speed limit. 
Her achievements are a testament to her feelings. Amber has excelled at the Villa. Over the years, she has received recognition for her improved social skills, cottage pride and academic achievement.

Living in New York has been overwhelmingly exciting to say the least! There is always something to do here; it really is the city






