If You Only Give Me a Chance.

I cannot begin to tell you how many times I have heard those words in my lifetime. While there are only seven words in this statement, they are very powerful. They imply a willingness to change, to improve, to try harder, to go the extra mile and to succeed. Over my thirty years with the Youth Ranches, I have heard these words from children, parents, employees and applicants. On each occasion, they have caused me to step back and take a closer look at the person asking for the chance. As a result, I have given many chances and on all but a few occasions, I have not regretted that decision - especially with the children. Most of them had already been discarded or not given that second chance and they simply did not need to hear the word "no" at the moment of their request.

How many times have most of us regretted a decision? Decisions made in anger, in haste, or at a moment in time when all the facts were not available? How many times have we blurted out a statement and in the flash of the moment, instantly regretted what we said? How many times have we carried the guilt of an action much longer than needed? How many times have we said to ourselves, if only I could start over?

This is what we do at the ranches: we create opportunities for children to succeed. We give them something as simple as a second, third or even a fourth chance to learn from their mistakes. Providing opportunities to start over through loving acts of forgiveness, allows us teachable moments where problems can be resolved and lives are forever changed.

As you know, the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches is not an organization supported by governmental funding. This is in contrast to many other childcare

## A Forever Home



n 2011 our staff received a phone call from the Highlands County Sheriffs Office about a child. This young man's father was terribly ill and his mom had passed on some years before. Highlands County Sheriffs Office Deputy Bobby Burch had met Robert through Big Brothers, Big Sisters.

During his father's illness, Deputy
Burch spent a lot of time with Robert. As
time drew short for his dad they talked
about where Robert would live after his
father passed. Deputy Burch helped
research options for Robert and his one
question always was, "If Robert comes to
live with you can I still be part of his life?"
This was very important to both of them.

Robert and Deputy Burch came to explore the Boys Ranch and decided it would be just the right fit for Robert. Robert moved on campus and enjoyed life at the Boys Ranch. Deputy Burch came for regular visits and played ball or went on cottage trips with the kids to bowling or the movies.

Robert fit right in. "It really felt like a family. Mom and Pop Diaz and their entire family treated all of us like family. We would have cookouts and go to baseball games and spend time together like most families." This was just what Robert needed, a family of his own.

The next year passed quickly. Although he enjoyed the Boys Ranch and his cottage parents, Robert longed for parents of his own. He asked our staff how he could go about getting adopted. About this time his cottage parents were considering a job change. When they made their decision to leave the Youth Ranches they asked Robert if he would like to come live with them. Robert loved the Diazes. "They already treated me like a son and it made me so happy that they wanted to continue the relationship," says Robert.

Robert recently graduated from high school and joined the Army. He has finished basic training and has moved on to Advanced Individual Training. He shared, "I think about how going to the Boys Ranch changed my life. I would have been homeless and without a family. I probably would not have chosen the military for my career. I am thankful God guided me to a place where I could have the best future."

Our vision is to see young men and women who, because of the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches, are able to face the future with a sense of direction, ability, and hope.

Tia shared, "I lost hope. I lost hope in my ability to change. I lost hope in ever having a good relationship with my mom again."



The daily schedule with strict expectations was one thing but having someone home everyday to reinforce the expectations was new. After a few months Tia found she really enjoyed the structure and caring environment. She settled into a new routine.

Chapel attendance is part of Ranch life. Tia found herself looking forward to chapel each week. The hope, grace and mercy taught by their chapel volunteers appealed to Tia. She found herself believing in her ability to change. Tia found hope again!

She followed up a very successful junior year of high school with a trip to Washington D.C. As part of the Envision program Tia was offered the opportunity to go to Washington D.C. and observe the government in action. Envision matches up excellent students with special educational opportunities.

Tia will graduate this year and continue on to college. Tia hopes to work in criminal justice and specifically with youth.

For Josh the most important part was getting out and taking photos. "After we learned how to use the camera we would take pictures and then critique them. Each one of us would talk about what we liked or didn't like about the photo and then what would make it better."



## It's Blooming Time

t the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches we grow all kinds of things! Hay, trees, cows and horses are a few things you hear about regularly. This year the girls at the Youth Villa have branched out in their education to include a robust horticulture course.



The girls learn about responsible fertilizing. They want the plants to be healthy but not endanger the environment.

When you walk into the greenhouse at the school you are overwhelmed with color. There are amazing bright green tomato plants reaching to the sky. Look carefully and you see each plant laden with baby tomatoes. There are pepper plants adorned with a variety of red, vellow and orange

peppers just waiting to be picked. Glance around and you see decorative coleus of a bright green and deep burgundy spill

out of their planters. No garden is complete without the natural pesticide provided by lovely marigolds.

The girls are learning how to propagate plants through seeds and cuttings. They are learning how to correctly fertilize and support plants for successful growth. We have a tilapia tank which raises fish and supports an aquaculture bed that is a great example of natural fertilizers and symbiotic relationships.

Agriculture Teacher Mr. Curtis works diligently to provide a well-

rounded curriculum related to all areas of agriculture. As the girls were sharing their beautiful greenhouse they discussed a recent study unit on swine. They cheerfully chatted about the breeds, names for each gender and age, and the cuts of pork.

We are grateful for our partnerships with our local school districts that enable us to offer classes with low student to teacher ratios. The ability to tailor education to meet our students needs guarantees success in the classroom. We

#### **Making Work Fun!**

Ranch sorting is a western style equestrian sport that evolved from the common ranch work of separating cattle into pens for branding, doctoring or transport. Ranch Sorting is an event that pits a team of two riders on horseback against the clock. Teamwork is the key with both riders working in harmony to cut out the correct cattle and drive them to the pen while keeping the wrong numbered cattle back. There are several variations of ranch sorting with one, two or three riders on the

team, but all require sorting the cattle from one pen to the other in the correct order.

For our boys at the Boys Ranch the activities of Florida Ranch Sorting are a natural fit. Essentially, they make work fun! Our boys do these activities as part of their regular work process. Having an opportunity to compete makes their daily chores more interesting.



# Family Legacies Come in Many Forms

isiting with different donors, we get ideas about how they want their family to be remembered. Some choose to leave all their money and property directly to their family, hoping they will continue to support favorite charities.

Others have made specific plans to ensure their charitable wishes are followed.

Here are a few of the more creative ideas we have seen in recent years:

- Naming the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches as a beneficiary of a life insurance policy, retirement account or bank account
- Specifying a particular percentage of your estate for the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches <u>OR the opposite</u>, specifying a particular percentage or piece of property for your heirs and leaving the remainder of your estate to the Youth Ranches
- Investing in a charitable gift annuity where the remainder after death goes to the Youth Ranches
- Making a cash gift of \$1,000 or more to the Youth Ranches in honor of a family member and request they be made a Lifetime Honorary Member of the Florida Sheriffs Association

- Contributing a minimum of \$10,000 and creating a family named endowment fund at the Ranch
- Establishing a Charitable Remainder Trust where distributions (set amount or %) are made to family members for a period of years and once complete, the balance is donated to the Youth Ranches
- Establishing a Charitable Lead Trust where a distribution (% or set amount) is made to the Youth Ranches for a period of 10 or 20 years, then the balance is distributed to your heirs when they are older and better prepared to receive these funds

These are just a few options to consider. As always, we encourage you to discuss this with your personal attorney or advisors to chart the best course for your future and remember to update your will annually as things and people in your life change!




