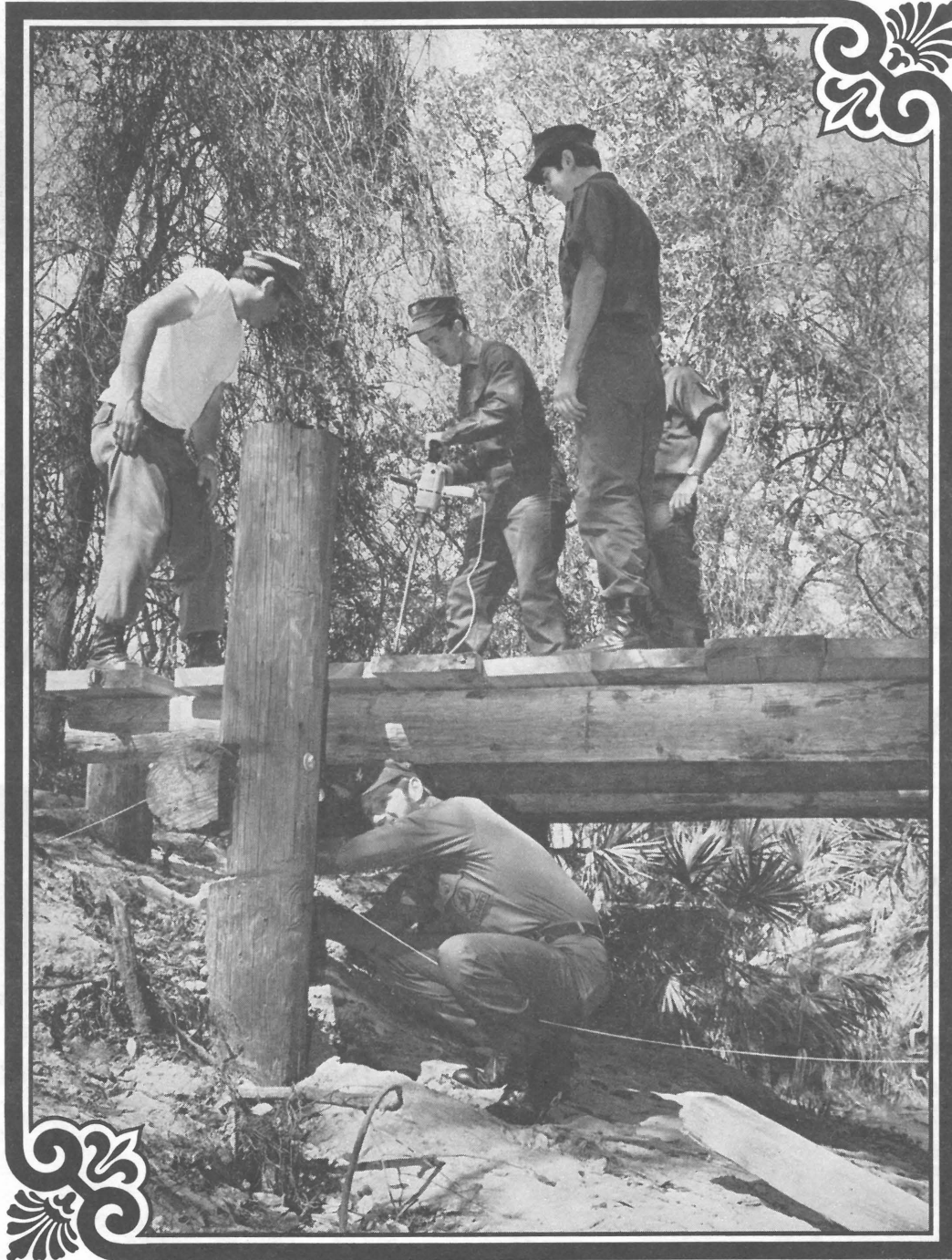

Better Than the Tooth Fairy

We're not knocking the tooth fairy, but frankly, given a choice, we would much rather have a visit from the U.S. Navy Seabees. The benefits are fabulous. About two years ago the U.S. Navy Seabees based in St. Petersburg contacted Resident Director Joe Spenard at the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranch and told him they were willing to do some chores for free.

"Great," said Joe, and thus began a whole series of weekend visits by the talented reservists from the Navy's 14th Mobile Construction Battalion. It soon became evident that these men in Navy fatigues were skilled workers with real calluses on their hands — electricians, plumbers, heavy equipment operators, carpenters and machinists who were dropping in to do a bit of serious work, not just fool around.

Joe was delighted. All he had to do was mention some repair or construction job that needed to be done, and the Seabees did it.

One weekend they worked on the electrical system. Another weekend they built a fence. A few weeks later

they checked and repaired the plumbing. Using heavy equipment loaned by Overstreet Paving Co. and Brookings Ford Sales, they also cleared six acres of heavily overgrown Youth Ranch property for use as a horse pasture. The land clearing job alone was worth about \$15,000, but it didn't cost the Youth Ranch anything except a relatively small amount spent for diesel fuel to power the heavy equipment.

"Hey!" said Joe, "having these guys visit us on weekends is better than a visit from the tooth fairy."

It certainly looked that way, especially when something was said about building a bridge over Bishop's Creek, a small stream that crosses a corner of the Youth Ranch campus. A bridge was definitely needed to give access to the proposed horse pasture, but nothing was being done about it because of estimates that the cost would be about \$15,000. The Youth Ranch could not afford a \$15,000 bridge. However, if the Seabees wanted to build one for practically nothing, who was going to try to stop them? No one did.

An engineering firm was hired to draw up plans and specifications, inspect the work and O.K. the complete span; but actual construction work was delayed for quite a few weeks while Joe hacked his way through the red tape of getting permission from government agencies.

Once local and federal officials were convinced that the proposed bridge would not pose a threat to Pinellas

County's fragile environment, the Seabees went to work. Heavy equipment was borrowed. Used utility poles were rounded up for the bridge frame, and the Youth Ranch bought some miscellaneous supplies such as wooden planks, bolts and nails.

The bridge was nearing completion as this issue of the Rancher went to press, and Joe declared he was thoroughly pleased with the results. He estimated that the land clearing and the bridge were worth about \$30,000, but the Youth Ranch spent only about \$2,000.

For the Youth Ranch this was a real bonanza, but for the Seabees it was just one more chapter in a long history of public service. A spokesman said the Seabees have been donating their skills to charitable and civic projects for many years. Recent examples include working on Heritage Park, an historical preservation project; building a bicycle moto-cross track; and helping to erect a memorial to the men who lost their lives in the Tampa Bay sinking of the Coast Guard ship Blackthorn.

It's the Seabees' business to help win wars, but they are equally adept at winning friends and collecting grateful admirers. One thing certain: they sure have impressed us, and we want to keep them as our buddies right on.

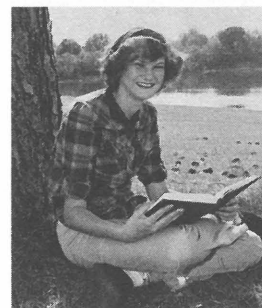

It's sort of scary to think about our girls going out into the world on their own. Fortunately, they can get help and counseling from our social workers, and their chances of success are better than usual.

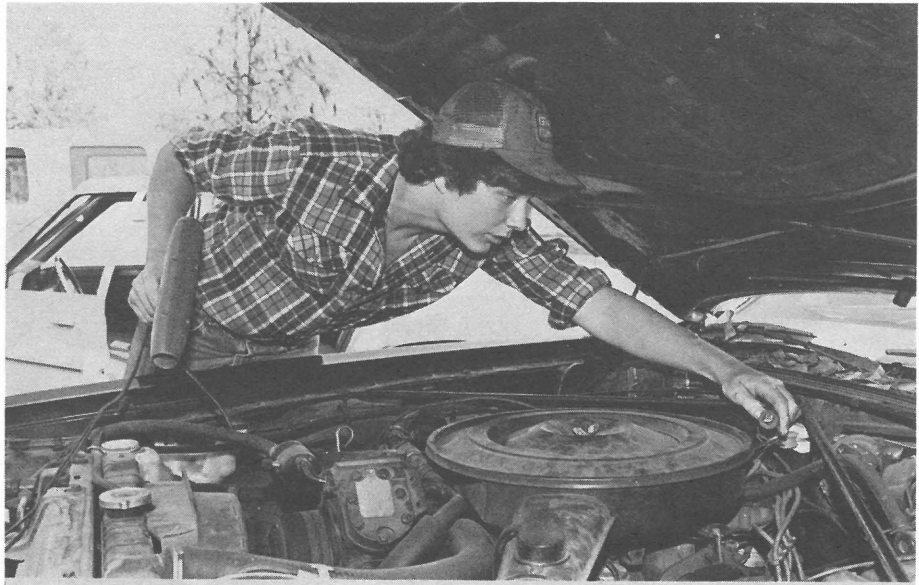

Bill James has been giving the U.S. Army some serious consideration. We expect him to enlist. Jim Deakin is completing a course in carpentry. And so it goes. . .

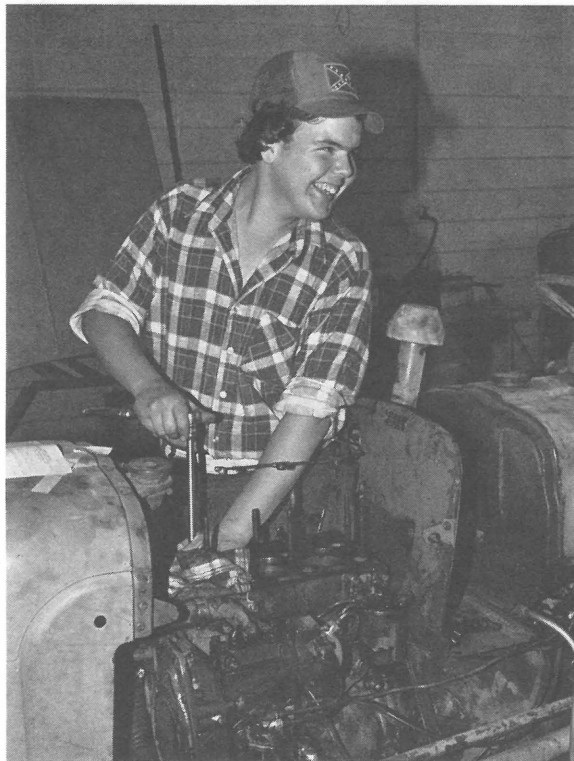

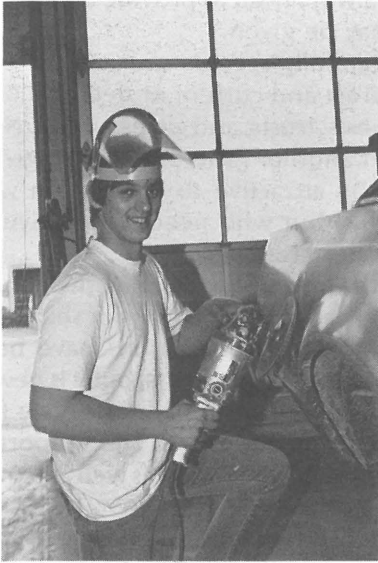

Henry Rauch built up his background of practical experience in high school cafeteria while completing a course in food services, and now he too is ready for his first full-time job.

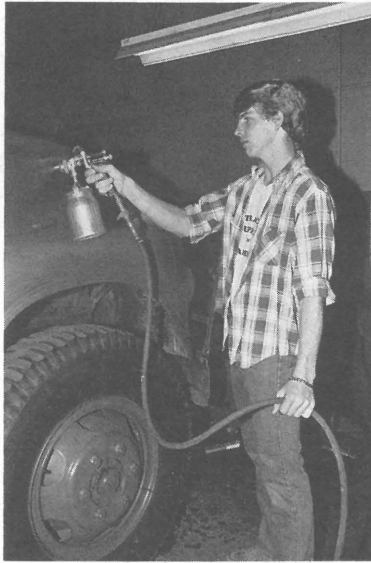
We are proud of all these graduates, and we wish them much success in their chosen careers.



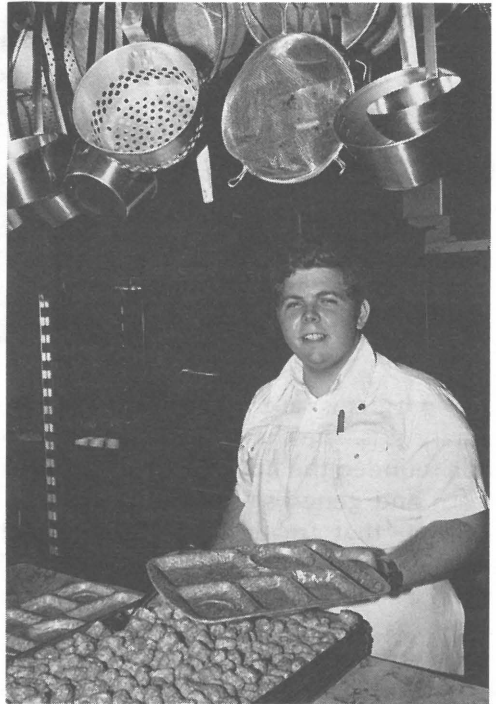

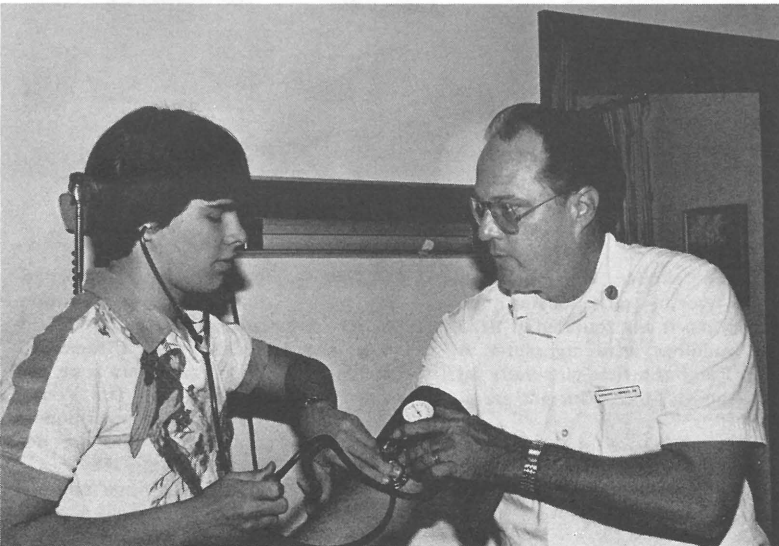

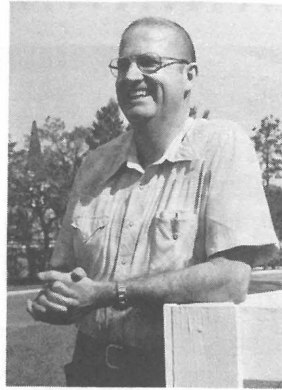

President's Perspective

A message from Harry K. Weaver, President of the Florida Sheriffs Youth Fund



Our programs are supported almost entirely by voluntary gifts. They have been ever since the Sheriffs of Florida founded the Boys Ranch back in 1957. It was the concern and generosity of the people of Florida and elsewhere that made the Boys Ranch program successful, enabled us to develop the Girls Villa in 1970 and the Youth Ranch in 1978 and to unite all three programs as projects of the Florida Sheriffs Youth Fund.

This great outpouring of concern, which we like to call "caring and sharing," has made it possible for us to touch the lives of more than 800 dependent, neglected, or homeless boys and girls in the past 24 years.

It didn't take us long to learn that people want to feel comfortable in their sharing and that different people

like to share in different ways. To accommodate these differences, we have always tried to provide a variety of ways in which gifts may be given.

The Youth Fund gratefully accepts cash or non-cash gifts which may be direct and current or deferred as in the case of wills, bequests, trusts, and gift annuities. Now we are developing yet another form of deferred giving that we believe will be attractive to the person who wishes to share with us, but who needs to receive an income during his or her lifetime.

Very soon, the Youth Fund will be offering the pooled income fund as an alternative opportunity for sharing. It is not something new. Many organizations have been operating pooled income funds for years, but it is new to us. We are developing this new fund, because we feel that it will appeal to many of our friends and supporters who are currently sharing in other ways as well as to new friends that we have yet to make.

The pooled income fund is similar to a mutual fund. Your gift is pooled with the gifts of others and invested. You are allowed a charitable deduction on your federal income tax return for the year in which the gift is made. You can avoid long term capital gains tax on transfers of investments, secure a measure of protection against inflation, and receive a competitive interest return on your gift according to the fund's investment performance. FLORIDA SHERIFFS YOUTH FUND IS...

A charitable, non-profit corporation, sponsored by the Florida Sheriffs Association, to manage and operate the Boys Ranch, the Girls Villa, the Youth Ranch, and any other youth programs that may later be developed by the Florida Sheriffs Association. One of the most important functions of the Youth Fund is the raising, receiving, budgeting and disbursing of funds for its programs. Gifts and bequests can be made to the Youth Fund for the exclusive benefit of any single youth program, such as the Boys Ranch, Girls Villa, or Youth Ranch. They can also be made to the Youth Fund, without restriction, to be distributed among existing programs where they are most needed or to be used for the development of new programs at the discretion of the Governing Board.

BOYS RANCH

IS a home for dependent, neglected and homeless boys sponsored by the Florida Sheriffs Association and operated under the management of the Florida Sheriffs Youth Fund, Inc. It is not an institution for delinquents.

The Boys Ranch was founded in 1957 and is located nine miles north of Live Oak, Florida. It has approximately 100 boys in care at any given time, and it is supported almost entirely by voluntary gifts through the Florida Sheriffs Youth Fund, Inc.

GIRLS VILLA

IS a similar institution for needy and worthy girls located near Bartow, Florida. It was founded in 1970. The first buildings were completed in July, 1972, and the first girls were admitted in August, 1972. Current enrollment is 24 girls.

Mailing address and phone number for the Boys Ranch, Girls Villa and Youth Ranch are the same as for the Youth Fund.



YOUTH RANCH

IS the newest group child care facility sponsored by the Florida Sheriffs Association. It was founded in 1976, and is located near Clearwater, Florida. The first youngsters were admitted in August, 1978. The Youth Ranch provides a homelike environment for brothers and sisters who are dependent, neglected or homeless.

The pooled income fund requires an irrevocable contract which will provide income for you or for you and one other person for as long as either of you lives. At the death of the person or persons who are parties of this life income contract, the income payments cease, and the pro rata value of the gift remaining in the fund is dispersed to the Florida Sheriffs Youth Fund.

As with any gift to the Youth Fund, you will be sharing in the positive physical and emotional development of boys and girls who are not delinquents but who, through no fault of their own, have become statistics and who, without your help, are prime candidates for juvenile delinquency.

There are still some legal formalities to be concluded before we will be prepared to accept your gifts to the pooled income fund, but you will be hearing more about it, and we wanted you to have some advance information for your consideration.

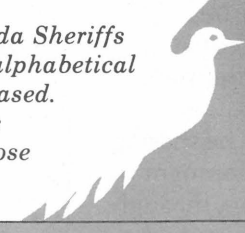

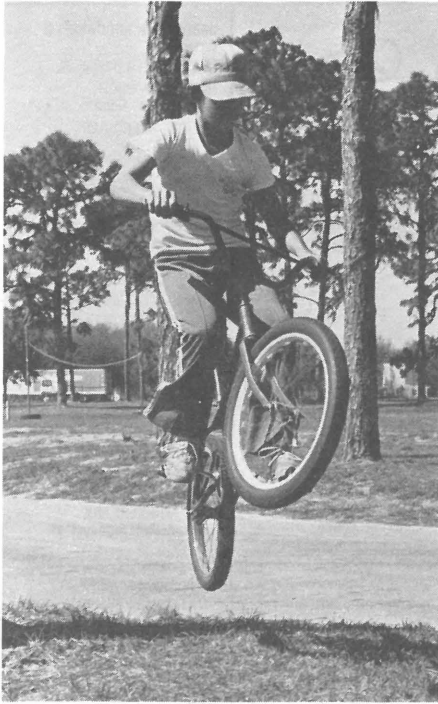
