

New Residence Becomes Boys Ranch Birthday Gift

Dedication rites for a \$250,000 residence cottage made possible by a generous bequest from the late Harry M. Hauer, of Miami Shores, Florida, was the highlight of a three-day celebration marking the 23rd Anniversary of the Florida Sheriffs Boys Ranch.

The new facility will provide a comfortable, attractive home for 12 boys and a married live-in couple employed as cottage parents. It is the eighth residence cottage built on the steadily expanding Boys Ranch campus, bringing the enrollment to 96 boys.

During the dedication rites, Florida Sheriffs Youth Fund officials expressed appreciation for the generosity of Mr. Hauer, who was represented by his daughter, Mrs. Kathleen Garlick; also, appreciation was expressed to Gerald Stevens, a member of the Florida Sheriffs Youth Fund governing board, who provided the interior furnishings for Hauer Cottage.

Leonard Russek, who grew up at the Boys Ranch and is currently serving on the Youth Fund Board of Directors, delivered a short dedicatory address in which he not only praised Mr. Hauer's generosity, but also aimed a special message at the Boys Ranch youngsters sitting in the audience.

"You each can have a hand in shaping the todays and tomorrows for the Boys Ranch," he told them. "I am one of the boys who lived here before you, and I plan to do all I can to make this a better place."

Russek, who is a certified public accountant and has his own investment consulting firm, told the youngsters they have a responsibility to take good care of the facilities at the Boys Ranch, and he also urged them to take full advantage of the many opportunities the Ranch offers so they can make right choices about their futures.

Still on the job after 23 years as "super chef" for a long succession of Boys Ranch celebrations, former Suwannee County Sheriff Duke McCallister was in charge of this year's anniversary fish fry. Used for the first time were some gas-fired fish cookers donated to the Boys Ranch.

"No one can guarantee that you will be successful," he added. "You will have to achieve success on your own."

The three-day anniversary celebration opened on Friday, October 3, when visitors began arriving for the annual Boys Ranch horse show. It continued on October 4 with open house tours of Boys Ranch facilities and a Suwannee River fish fry attended by some 1,900 guests. It wound up on Sunday, October 5, with an outdoor worship service at the horse show arena, and the Hauer Cottage dedication rites. The grand entry procession officially opening the horse show was led by Suwannee County Sheriff Robert Leonard.

Weather-wise and attendance-wise this was one of the most successful events ever held at the Boys Ranch. It also focused attention on a success story that began 23 years ago.

The Florida Sheriffs Association founded the Boys Ranch in 1957 with \$5,000 in cash and 140 acres of donated land. The land was raw and undeveloped, but it was ideally situated on the banks of the scenic Suwannee River.

The Sheriffs who founded the Boys Ranch had no experience in operating child care institutions, but they were strongly motivated to provide a place where dependent, neglected, or homeless (but not delinquent) boys could get a new start. Their enthusiasm and the generosity of thousands of beneficient donors set the pace for 23 years of uninterrupted success, and the Boys Ranch is one of the finest residential group child care programs anywhere.

This is the saga that was celebrated on a sunny weekend in October, 1980, with prayers and praise and thanks and good fellowship . . . and so we grow!

Riding Ranchers have Won At Least Thirty Trophies

We have three kinds of riders at the Boys Ranch: good, better and best. We also have the best of the best, and we call them Riding Ranchers. These boys are the cream of the crop, and they have proven it by winning at least 30 trophies in various Florida horse shows during the past three years.

To become a Riding Rancher a boy must have good conduct as well as riding ability. He must demonstrate his concern and affection for horses on a consistent basis. He must also learn how to care for, handle and treat horses in a skillful manner. The requirements are tough and the membership is small.

Once each year, in October, one of the Riding Ranchers is selected to receive the Carleton F. Tweed Memorial Horsemanship Trophy --- the highest honor any rider can receive at the Boys Ranch. This year's winner is Grady Crunkleton, a friendly, well-mannered young fellow who wants to become a farmer so he can follow in the footsteps of his grandfather and great grandfather. Surely winning the Tweed Trophy is a step in the right direction.

President's Perspective

A message from Harry K. Weaver, President of the Florida Sheriffs Youth Fund



Many people express an interest in the youngsters we serve ... who they are ... where they come from ... why they need special help.

There is a common misconception that we deal with juvenile delinquents. The assumption is understandable because of our relationship with the Sheriffs of Florida, but it is an inaccurate assumption. Our original program, the Florida Sheriffs Boys Ranch, was conceived for the purpose of delinquency prevention rather than rehabilitation, and the Youth Fund has retained this policy as it has grown and developed new programs at the Girls Villa and Youth Ranch.

We do not accept youngsters who have been adjudicated delinquent by the courts. Instead, we try to identify youngsters who are headed for delinquency and turn them around before they commit unlawful acts that might result in adjudication.

Families in turmoil and broken homes help to foster juvenile delinquency, and it is from this type of environment that we take most of our youngsters.

Statistics on the last 100 children admitted to residential care at the Boys Ranch, Girls Villa, and Youth Ranch show that 41 percent came from homes in which there was a natural mother and a stepfather. We took 21 percent from single parent homes in which there was only the natural mother. There were 16 percent from situations in which grandparents had custody.

Statistics can be misleading. Interestingly, there were many cases in which one or both parents had legal custody, but the only real relationship that the youngsters had was with grandparents. When these cases are considered, it brings the number of cases involving grandparents up to well over 50 percent of the total.

The Youth Fund gets involved when the grandparents, because of advancing age, bad health, or other problems, are no longer able to cope with troubled and rebellious pre-teen or teen-aged children.

Following through with our statistics, for what they may be worth, we see that homes in which there was a natural father and a stepmother accounted for nine percent of our last 100 admissions. There were six percent that came from so-called "intact" families with both natural parents living together. We took three percent from situations in which the natural father had sole custody of the youngster, and there was a variety of

other situations which accounted for the remaining four percent.

We encounter very few true orphans these days. Medical science has eliminated most of the afflictions that once wiped out entire segments of the population and left orphaned children in their wake. More common today is what we call the "half orphan" with only one parent living. Also related to this are the factors of a higher adoption rate, the increasing use of birth control measures, and more babies being kept by unwed mothers.

As a legacy of the past, we are conditioned to think of all residential child-caring institutions as orphanages. In modern times, this is rarely the case. Most child-caring institutions are now dealing with mentally or physically handicapped children or, as in the case of the Youth Fund, with youngsters who are the emotionally troubled victims of a skyrocketing divorce rate or otherwise broken homes.

Geographically, as might be expected, most children come to us from the more populous areas of the state. Florida's ten largest counties (in terms of population) account for nearly 57 percent, or 461, of the 815 youngsters who have been served in Youth Fund residential programs since 1959.

Although the Youth Fund does not operate orphanages, neither does it serve as a handy receptacle into which irresponsible parents may deposit their unwanted children. We believe very strongly that parents are responsible for their children and, in the absence of responsible parents, that other family members should be involved.

The Youth Fund insists upon continuing family involvement. We will admit the child to one of our residential programs, and we will provide counseling to help the family work out its problems, but all of our efforts are aimed at putting the child back into his own home or a good family home at the earliest possible time. If all efforts to do this fail, the child may remain in Youth Fund residential care until his future is secure.

The average length of stay in residential care at the Boys Ranch, Girls Villa, and Youth Ranch is currently less than 14 months. This is indicative of the success we are enjoying in the achievement of our goals for the youngsters we serve.





Final Diagnosis:

Dr. Blais Believes in the Boys Ranch

It was a bright, sunny day. The fish were biting, and Dr. Michael R. Blais loves to fish, but Dr. Blais was not fishing. Instead, he was spending his weekend at the Boys Ranch Medical and Dental Clinic thumping knees with his little rubber hammer, listening to hearts and lungs with his stethoscope, inspecting eyes, ears, teeth and throats, prodding abdomens, studying height and weight records.

He said he had been coming to the Ranch once or twice a year for 12 years to give free physical examinations --- taking time away from his Daytona Beach medical practice and passing up opportunities for fishing and other types of recreation --- but he declared he had no regrets.

Why not? In 12 years he had given up some 18 or 20 long weekends --- or the equivalent of at least 60 fishing trips. Was it worth it?

The answer came in bits and pieces.

Waving a medical chart, Dr. Blais exclaimed: "Here's a boy who gained 13 pounds in one year!." The doctor couldn't have been any more excited if he had hooked a 40-pound bass.

A few moments later, as he was rummaging around Rancher Dan Higginbotham's mouth with a tongue depressor, he turned to a visitor and said, "Look at this one. Isn't that beautiful dental work? I haven't seen one cavity today!"

Dr. Blais was obviously having himself one heck of a time and enjoying every minute of it. Working away with hammer and stethoscope, he sang the praises of the Jacksonville dentists who, like him, donate their services to the Ranch. He also talked about the dramatic changes he has observed in boys living at the Boys Ranch.

Newcomers are often scrawny, show signs of malnutrition, have teeth that are badly neglected, act insecure and hostile, and have bad manners, he said.

After they live at the Ranch for a while, the newcomers become "just completely different kids," he said. They fill out, become healthier and more alert. Their attitudes improve. Their manners improve. The "yes sirs" and "no sirs" come out easily and naturally.

"There is no doubt in my mind that the Boys Ranch benefits boys physically, emotionally and socially," Dr. Blais said as he poked at a boy's stomach muscles. "That's why I come here year after year," he added.
