Their adventure took them on a tour of the Charles Hosmer Morse Museum of American Art where Mrs. Griffith is President of the Board of Advisors, on a boat ride of Lake Osceola, and to the Mennello Museum of American Folk Art. The Morse Museum boasts a permanent collection of the works of Louis Tiffany, whereas, the Mennello Museum of American Folk Art, in contrast, contains pieces of work using wood, pebbles, feathers and beads. Many of the girls found themselves intrigued and inspired by the many works of art. Some of the girls expressed a sincere interest by the end of the day.

"I want to be an artist now," said one of the girls.

Mrs. Griffith was delighted with the response she received from the girls. But still, she wishes she could do more. "Perhaps when my term is up at the Morse Museum, I will have more time to help the girls," Griffith







e pick up the story amidst the pines of north Florida, nestled along the Suwannee River, at a ranch, carved from the rolling hillside and pine trees, for needy and neglected boys. It is home to nearly 80 youth now. But it all started with just an idea, a simple plan, and a seed of hope by a handful of Florida's caring Sheriffs, to help troubled and potentially delinquent boys.

In the mid-1950s, two veteran Sheriffs, Hillsborough County Sheriff R. Ed Blackburn, Jr., and Marion County Sheriff Don McLeod, arrived in Amarillo, Texas, to return a pair of teenaged armed-robbery suspects back to Florida. While the extensive paperwork for the extradition was finalized, the two Sheriffs were escorted on a tour of a nearby canyon by one of the local Texas

Deputies.

Along the trail, the Texas lawman told them of a ranch for needy, neglected boys, established by former wrestler Cal Farley, converted into a home for hundreds of underprivileged and unwanted boys. Inspired by the

Texans' success, and clearly influenced by the plight of their two adolescent prisoners, Blackburn and McLeod discussed the prospect of starting a similar ranch for the troubled, neglected youth of Florida.

Today, the Florida Sheriffs Boys Ranch is eight cottages strong and provides sanctuary to nearly 80 boys. From farm and woodlands, the Ranch has become a thriving community, home to a campus cafeteria, Learning Center, chapel, swimming pool, gym, firehouse, gas station, airfield, and even its own water tower. As the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches celebrates 43 years of successfully saving so many of Florida's hurting children, it is also an occasion to say "thank you" to those early visionaries and to the thousands of Florida citizens who have helped support this simple plan to save lives.

Over the past 43 years, through a statewide network of residential campuses, summer camp programs, and community-based counseling, the Youth Ranches has helped over 40,000 boys, girls, and their families get a fresh start. Always a special time to remember and reminisce, the anniversary weekend was highlighted by a traditional chicken pilau (per-low), an old-fashioned "Southern" barbecue enjoyed under the shade of oaks along the Suwannee River, and the annual horse show at the Clay Mavericks Arena. This year, Grand Marshal Robert L. "Bob" Crowder, Sheriff of Martin County, helped kick off the weekend of special events.

"Year after year, it gets bigger and bigger," said Sheriff Crowder. "I feel very lucky to have been a part of this year's celebration."

And, at 43, the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches shows no sign of aging and certainly no signs of slowing down. With over 3,000 people in attendance and over 1,000 horses registered in the horse show this year, the Boys Ranch Anniversary Celebration set records for the largest crowds ever. Thanks to everyone, including the Clay County, St. Johns County, Suwannee County and Bradford County Sheriff's Offices, for helping make this year's open house the best ever.

During each holiday season, the Florida Sheriffs Youth Villa gives the ultimate gift by helping youngsters discover the talents that make them unique.

"What would you like to be when you grow up?" This is something we ask all of our children at one time or another. Many of them will have answers, like doctors,

teachers, astronauts, or police officers. Perhaps they choose these professions because their own father is a teacher, or their mother is a doctor, or because they have met someone in their community who has inspired them. But, some kids will not know, will not have an answer; some boys and girls don't think about the future. Sometimes, children are not given the chance to succeed or dream. They must simply survive.

The Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches helps youth like these find meaning in their young lives, and helps give youngsters the self-esteem they need to find their true talents, the gifts they were given, and the confidence to pursue their hopes with energy and passion.

Everyone is born with a set of particular talents, or gifts. Some may be musically inclined or good at writing stories, while others may be good with animals or have a head for numbers. No matter what the talent, boys and



Angel

Angel was no angel.

Like many teens who struggle as they grow up, Angel was beginning to rebel, hanging out with the wrong crowd, getting into trouble, and even experimenting with drugs. But, things could have turned out worse.

"I could have ended up dead without the Villa," said Angel.

At 15, Angel arrived at the Florida Sheriffs Youth Villa, unsure, scared of change. And while the Youth Villa could teach her right from wrong, and her cottage parents could help provide her with the proper social skills to make it through life, Angel would have to be willing to

change her behavior; she would have to want to look inside herself and find the dynamic young woman waiting to come out. Thankfully, she has.

At a recent speech, Angel outlined everything she has learned so far. "I have learned to trust people; to put my family above everyone else; to put education first; that help can be a good thing; to trust people and put faith in God; that people can change; that choices I make effect those around me; and, that life is not always fair, but that's O.K."

Heather

Heather needed help. Luckily, she found it.

At the Florida Sheriffs Youth Villa, Heather while others discover that using found a network of family and friends to support and guide her. She found teachers who encourage

So begins Dale Perelman's intriguing book 100 Centenarians. He continues, "Who among us has not marveled at some senior citizen who excelled as a painter, actor, philosopher, businessperson or just a golfer still capable of shooting his age? How unique it becomes when that person has attained the age of 100."

It is estimated some 70,000 centenarians live in the United States. As the trend toward longer life continues, it is conceivable some of the Ranchers featured in this issue may reach the mark!

Regardless of their ultimate longevity, the youth helped by the Youth Ranches will have a better chance to become lawful, productive citizens. Their adulthood will be enhanced and they will be better prepared to be positive role models for the next generation.

As you consider your year-end giving, we hope you

will consider the advantages of gifting appreciated securities or other appreciated property, such as a vacation home, acreage or farm.

Giving long-term appreciated stock offers you a two fold tax saving. First, you avoid paying any capital gains tax on the increase in value of your stock. In addition, you receive a tax deduction for the full fair market value of the stock on the date of the gift. For income tax purposes the value of such gifts may be deducted up to 30% of adjusted gross income, with an additional five year carry forward.

A charitable gift of real estate can be especially tax advantageous. The property may have so appreciated in value over the years that its sale would result in a sizeable capital gains tax. If given outright to the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches instead, you avoid the tax and, at the same time, realize a charitable deduction for the full fair market value of the real estate.


In their youth, Ruthe and Evelyn played basketball together. Today, they have been immortalized together.

After a childhood faced with divorce and instability, Stacey Freihoffer needed structure and discipline. At the Florida Sheriffs Youth Villa, she found guidance and order. Today, as an honorable member of the United States Air Force, she's learned to "Aim High."

It was a family tradition.

Like her father, Stacey joined the military after high school, enlisting in the United States Air Force. In only four short years, she has risen up the ranks quickly to Senior Airmen. In January, Stacey will be eligible to apply for status as a Staff Sergeant.

"I don't know where I would be right now without the Villa," said Stacey. "I just know I wouldn't be where I am today."

As an Information Management Journeyman in the United States Air Force, Youth Villa Alumna Stacey Rolen (Freihoffer) helps provide military personnel with the necessary information it takes for them to do their jobs and maintain national security. She provides

answers when officers need it. Not long ago, it was Stacey who was looking for answers.

"I needed a place to get my priorities straight," said Stacey.

As a teen, Stacey began mixing with the wrong crowd and skipping school. Her grades were slipping; she was failing, in school and in life. Stacey had become disrespectful and rebellious, especially with her family. At the Florida

Sheriffs Youth Villa, Stacey would have the opportunity to learn self-respect, build her self-

esteem and find the motivation to raise her grades, renew her education and earn a second chance at life.

"I learned there were consequences for my actions," said Stacey. "I learned, with people's help, I could begin to solve my own problems."

Some of the most important lessons Stacey learned were thanks in part to the kindness of newfound friends and the advice of faithful cottage parents. Through their constant love and support youth like Stacey are able to put aside negativity and embrace the future; youth like Stacey

find the courage to stand up for themselves and reach for their dreams.

"I really realized how to become an adult thanks to the Villa and my cottage parents," Stacey remembered. "Everyone always made me feel at home . . . without them, I would not have been able to establish such a strong bond to my family and friends."

Succeeding as a brand new adult thanks to the Youth Villa, Stacey has also become a brand new wife, and now, a brand new mother. Her daughter, Alexa, will turn two in the coming months. Because of the special sacrifices and support Stacey experienced at the Youth Villa, she has been given the proper tools to effectively raise her own daughter. Stacey plans on sharing the nurturing and guidance she received at the Villa. Stacey is committed to teaching Alexa the value of respect early.

"I will always be there for my daughter," said Stacey.

Being in the military certainly has its advantages. Stacey enjoyed her official military wedding, complete with an Honor Guard and the traditional canopy of swords. And recently, she received orders to report to the Pentagon to provide computer support for various national security procedures. But one of Stacey's dreams still remains unfulfilled. "I want to be a film director," she said.

In the Air Force there are opportunities in the field by becom-

ing a member of the Battle Cams, a crew enlisted to photograph during wars or conflicts. Of course, there are always those impressive Air Force commercials to direct. The ones that urge you to "Aim High." Something Stacey has certainly gone on to do.

"My favorite director is Steven Speilberg," said Stacey. "I want to do what he does . . . I like to be behind the scenes."

Even today, Stacey still contacts old cottage parents and talks to old friends from the Villa. Living with girls who had similar problems and fears helped Stacey


Hall spent most of his career as a businessman, but also worked in law enforcement, serving as a Deputy with the Clay County Sheriff's Office. His own father was Sheriff of the county for 36 years. Through this involvement, Hall discovered the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches. It quickly became one of his favorite charities because of its devotion to helping children.

Hall, and his sister Dena Mae Lemen, were integral in producing the Youth Ranches 40th Anniversary Pictorial History Book. They helped get the book off the ground by covering the costs of printing through a substantial donation.




