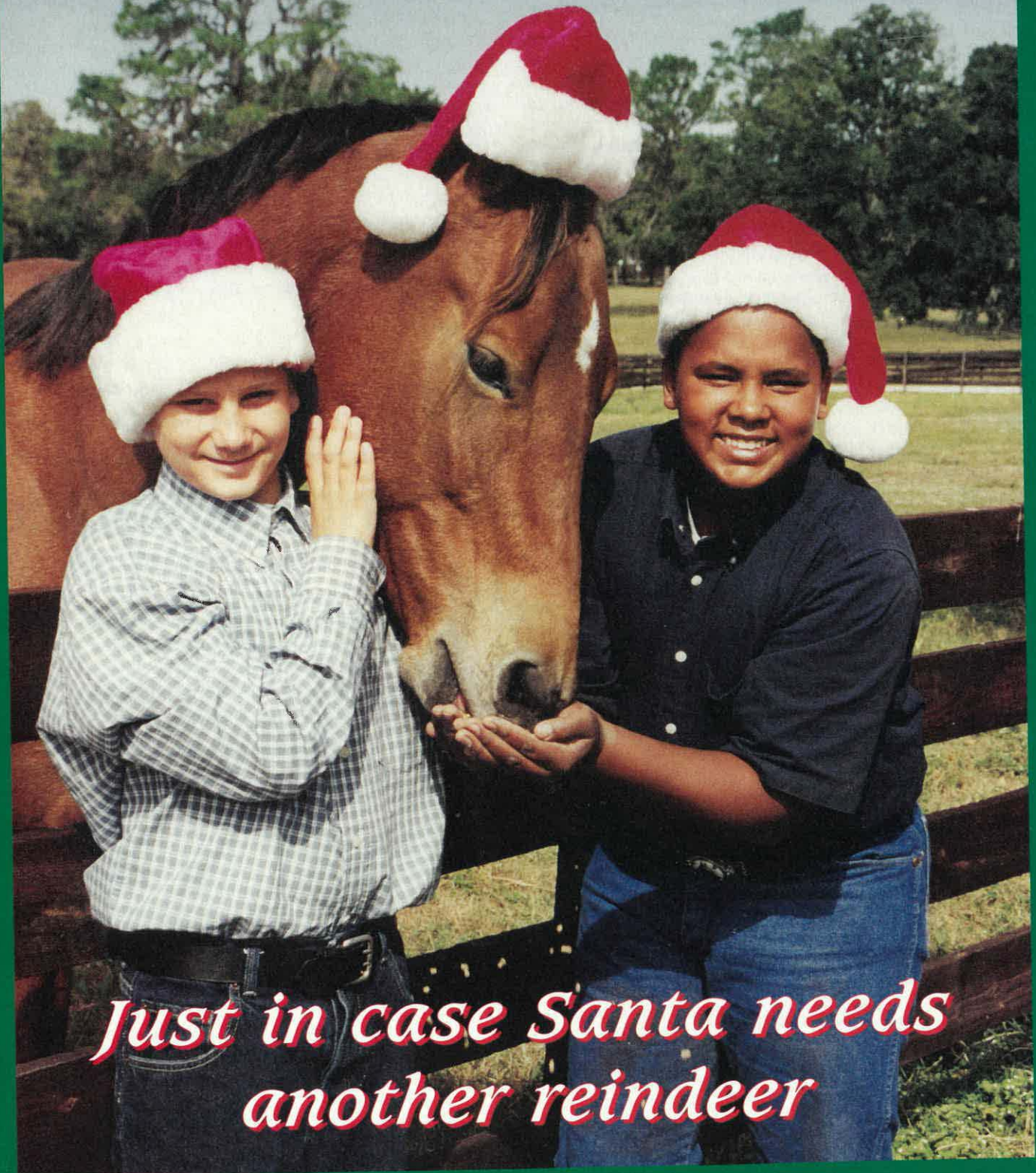

President's Perspective

A message from Roger O. Bouchard, Jr.
President of the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches, Inc.



As I write this perspective for the winter issue of *The Rancher* magazine, we are getting ready for our 44th anniversary Open House and Horse Show at the Boys Ranch. This has been much more difficult than usual in light of the terrorist attacks on the United States. On September 11, staff and children of the Youth Ranches joined the rest of the country in shock and mourning for the victims of this tragedy. As we watched the news reports, staff were barraged with questions from the boys and girls. All of the questions of "Who?" "Why?" and "What do we do now?" had to be answered to the best of our abilities. Unfortunately, there are no easy or even adequate answers to these questions.

The children we serve have known heartache, sorrow and for many of them, violence, during their short lives. A tragedy such as this attack only magnifies the fear and confusion that already lives within them. The impact of terror affects each of us in many different ways. For these youngsters, the events of September 11 only reinforce their feelings of helplessness and hopelessness. It is our job to help them understand we live in a country and are part of a people who stand strong in times of trouble and have a marvelous resiliency in the face of tragedy.

One of the most encouraging and uplifting effects of the past few weeks is to see our country joining together with a unity and resolve that has been absent for many years. As we see the American Flag proudly waving and hear prayer being offered in public forums, I have great hope and faith that we will emerge from this

Sheriff Don Genung

April 2, 1917 – September 13, 2001

Don Genung had a major impact on the lives of thousands of deserving boys and girls. For over 40 years, he has inspired people to believe in and support the work of the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches.

Legendary in the Pinellas County area, Sheriff Genung took every opportunity to tell folks about the Boys Ranch. From the waitress at the coffee shop to the couple in the bowling alley, everyone (including Don's sister) knew his heart was in the right place! Don believed, once they heard about youngsters in need, they would help. He was a man who truly made a difference!

The lady at the coffee shop, Beatrice Remaly, remembers Don excitedly talking to her about the boys at the Ranch. She and her husband made the commitment then to help when they could. Now over 30 years later, she has kept her promise and made a significant gift to the children in our care.

Mr. and Mrs. Stephan Ivan recalled meeting the Sheriff in the 60's at a local bowling alley. "He was talking about this new ranch for abused and abandoned boys," said Mr. Ivan. "Right away, I knew I wanted to help! Ruthe and I then visited all the Youth Ranches sites. We felt good about helping those boys and girls."

As for Don's sister, she thought wayward girls needed as much help as troubled boys. With his help in the early 70's, she convinced the Sunshine State Women's Chamber of Commerce to begin the search for a sister program to the Boys Ranch, namely the Florida Sheriffs Girls Villa.

The list goes on and on... because of Don's work, we have the Youth Ranch in Safety Harbor that provides special care for sibling groups, keeping broth-

ers and sisters together on one campus. So many other projects and gifts can be linked to the goodwill efforts of Don Genung.

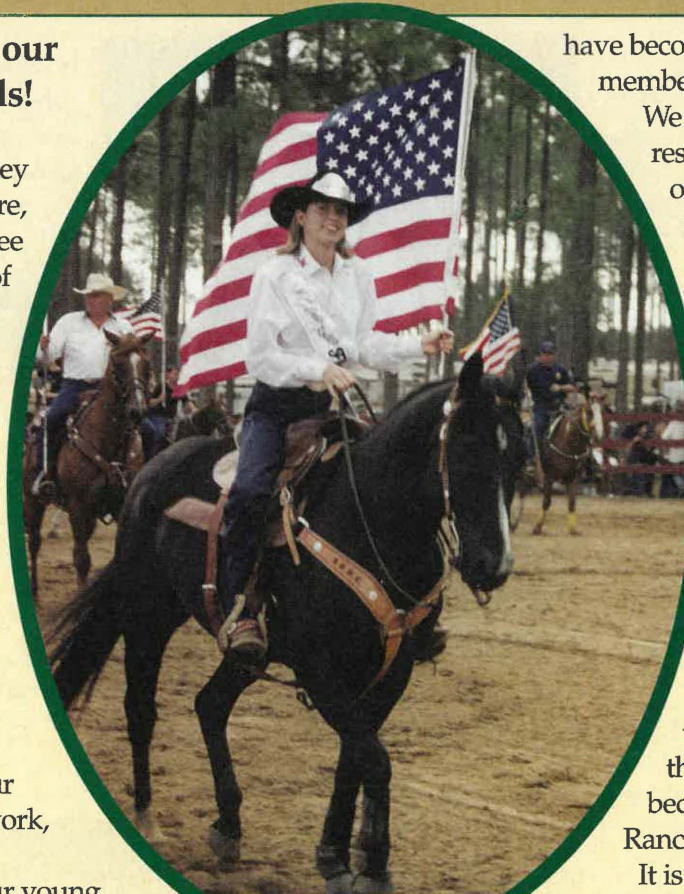
44 Years of Service to the Children and Families of Florida

Sacrifice

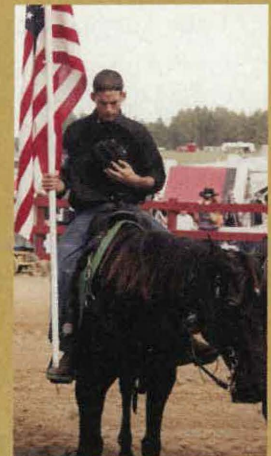

It is reflected in the faces of our young men and women who have served our country with honor. Those

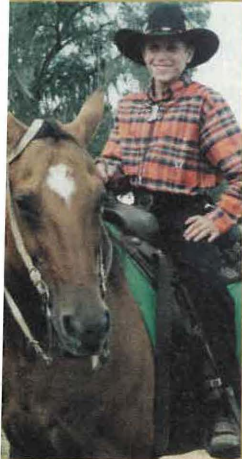

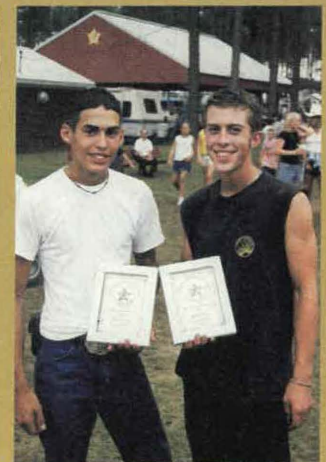
Welcome home alumni, family and friends!

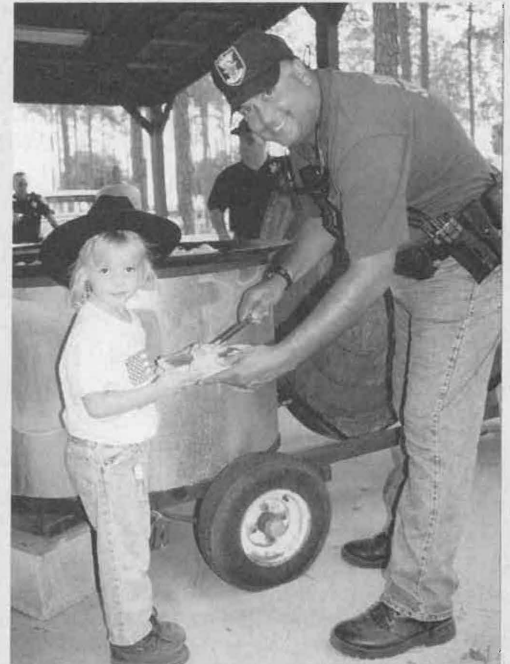
Little buckaroos like cowgirls, cowboys, and great explorers on the banks of the Suwannee River all add to the family atmosphere.

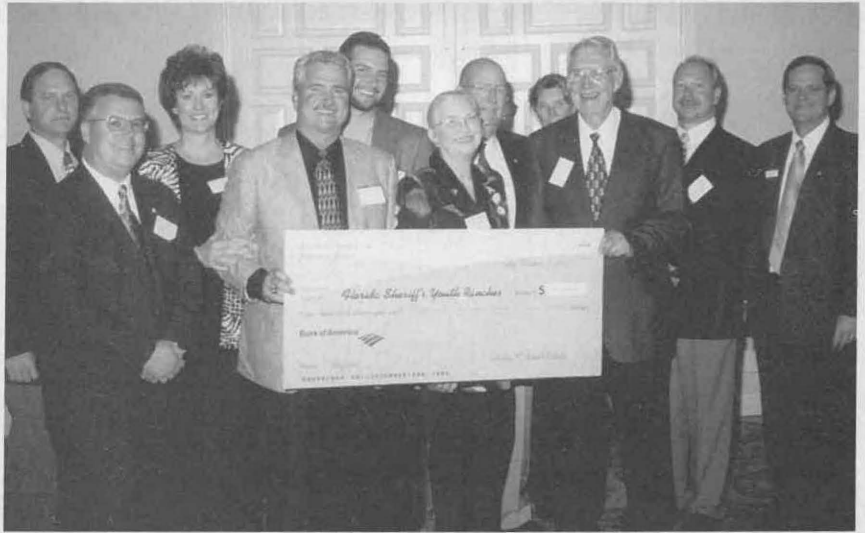

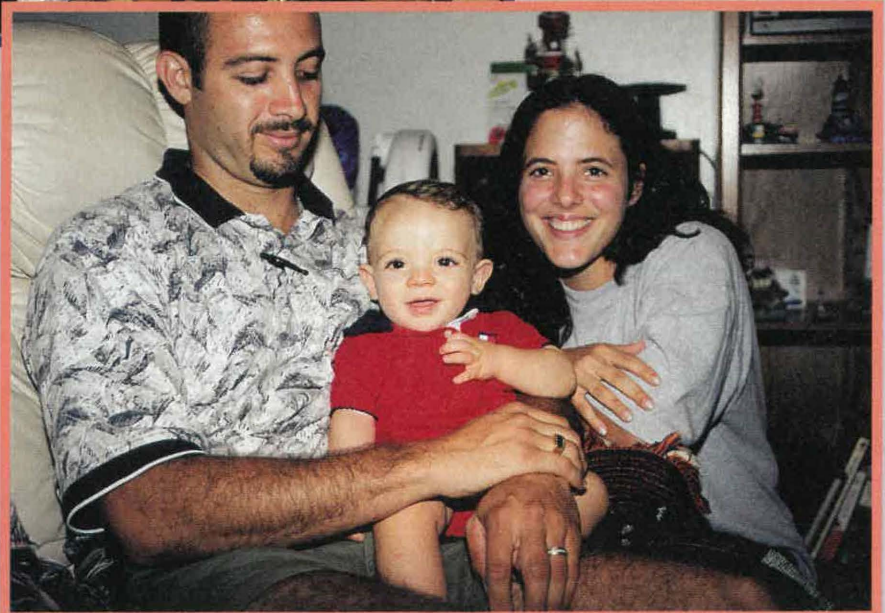
In 1997, they were married and began a new life as husband and wife. They

CONTRACTOR BY DAY, COUNSELOR BY NIGHT

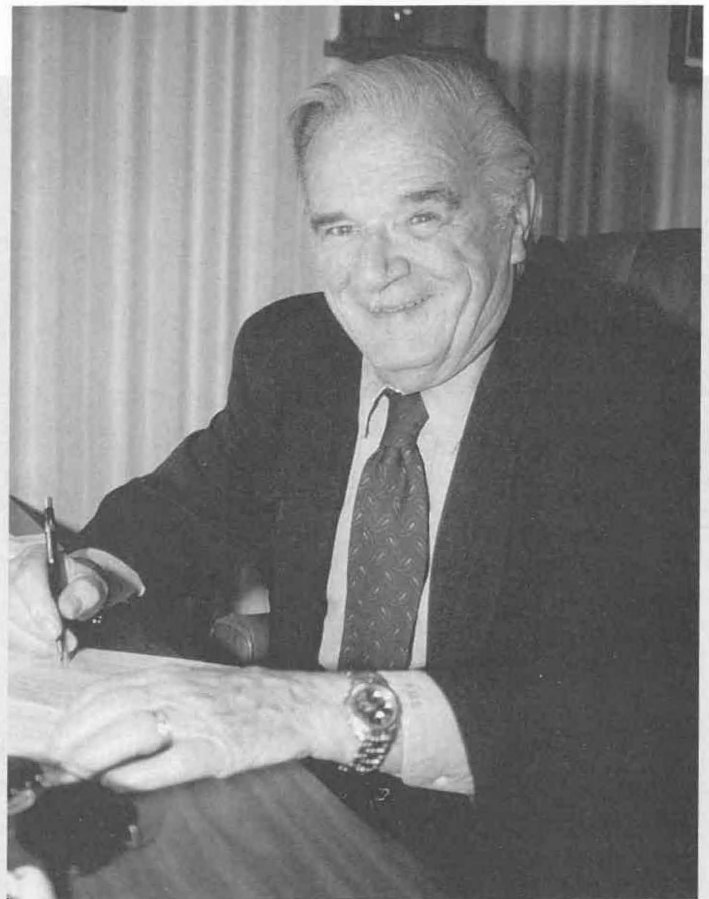
Spend just a few moments with Bob Sharkey and you see he's a typical guy who built his company from the ground up through many years of hard work and pure sweat. A man who speaks his mind, means serious business, and won't tolerate much fooling around. Then spend a few more moments with Bob and you will see so much more!

Behind the no nonsense, business mind is a heart of pure gold! For the past 17 years, this contractor by day has been a counselor by night at the Youth Ranch in Safety Harbor. He graduated with his degree in 1983, but was not actively seeking a career change. He just wanted to help troubled kids and knew that a formal education was the first step. "I was a kid of the streets, so I can understand some of the issues in these kids' lives," said Mr. Sharkey.

One night a week, he volunteers his time as a Licensed Mental Health Counselor Intern, gradually closing in on the 3,000 hours of supervised contact he needs to obtain his license. Bob specifically focuses on the family, offering guidance to the parents of the children in our care.

He said, "During the counseling session, it is so rewarding to see the "light go on" in a father's eyes as he gains a new understanding of his child's behavior. The Mom is absent in this family, so Dad's role is vital for these kids. The key is to sustain the progress from week to week and continue to work as we help the family move through the issues.

Since he does not receive a paycheck, one

wonders why Bob continues to volunteer his time. "This is my way of giving back. You may never know the real impact of this work, ...never really know if it "took" but, every once in awhile one of our kids returns – and you know its all worth it!

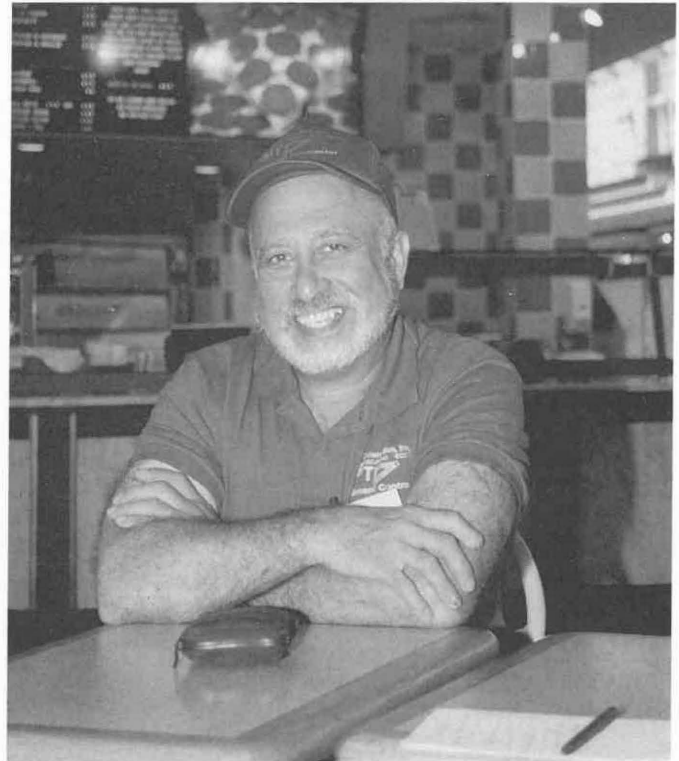

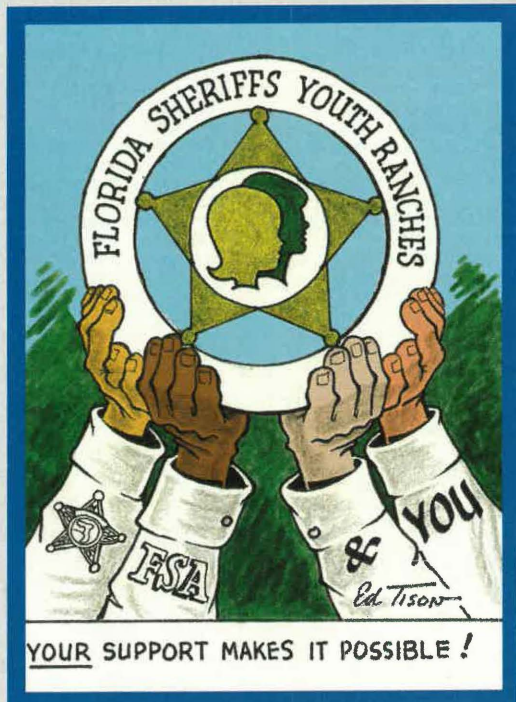

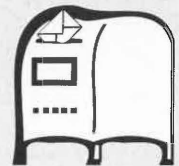
