





At the tender age of 12, Albert Williams was left home alone to care for his two younger brothers and baby sister. He was told to make sure they all ate dinner, took a bath, and got into bed on time. As the very young "man of the house," he was determined to follow instructions and make sure his siblings did, too.

Unfortunately, Albert didn't know much about caring for infants. He turned on the hot water and went to get the baby. Her screams and red skin were evident immediately and have long lingered in his memory as the last time he saw his baby sister.

The neighbors came and helped do what they could, so did the police. The baby was whisked away to the hospital and the young boys became wards of the state. Fortunately, the Sheriff learned of the boys plight and did all he could to keep them together. He immediately called to see if there was room at the newly founded Florida Sheriffs Boys Ranch.

Albert and his brothers grew up at the Ranch. All three went on to become responsible and reliable men with good jobs and strong families. But, for Albert, there was always a lingering guilt about what happened to his baby sister.

Then, just this year, a call came into the switchboard at the Boys Ranch. The lady on the other end was asking if we knew anything about the three Williams boys from years ago.

With a few quick calls to verify the contact, Albert was on the phone speaking to his long lost baby sister! His joy was unspeakable as he learned she had no lingering effects from the burn and had been raised well.

With great pride and tears of joy, Albert brought his sister to the 2003 Alumni banquet and introduced her to his Boys Ranch family.

After he saw the amount of funds generated by various fundraising events, he leaned over to Community Events Specialist Claudia Patterson and said with confidence, "We can beat that!"

True to his word, the Sheriff (who does not play golf) launched the first annual Pinellas County Sheriffs Office Golf Tournament. Immediately, it was a success and quickly won the top spot as the single largest one-day fundraising event in the





Girls at the Youth Villa Give Back to the Local Community

Despite living in a nice home with up to nine other girls, some of our kids can still feel lonely. They miss their families and friends and sometimes wish for the way things use to be.


Maria Ewing, Clinical Director at the Youth Villa in Bartow began thinking about these challenges and quickly remembered how many

elderly folks who now live in a retirement home share these same feelings. They are separated from their families and miss the contact they use to have with friends and neighbors.

Initially, she explored the idea of an "adopt a grandparent" program to help our girls fill this gap and learn how to better communicate with senior adults. Over time, this evolved into a way for the girls to give back to the community as they visit with the residents of a local retirement home.

The weekly visits are especially meaningful to Karie age 15. For the past 13 years, she was raised by her grandparents and misses the gentle wisdom of this older generation. She wants to volunteer for something meaningful and knows these relationships can be very special.

The girls often play games (like Bingo or Trivia), join in




sing-a-longs or just sit and visit with the residents. Amber just enjoys the social aspects of their time together. "I like to talk to people and they seem to enjoy having a younger crowd

Andrea is a career minded young woman who believes this experience will help her in the future. She would like to become a nurse, just like her mom.

Sixteen year old Charlene sees this as a way to focus on her education. "If I stick with it, I will have my LPN when I graduate from high school. As I volunteer here, I have learned a lot about patience and the reality of this career choice."

Then with a slight smile she adds, "These folks are sometimes very funny. They are always making jokes and trying to pull a fast one on me. This one gentleman always wants to introduce me to his wife...and its always a different woman at the home - then he leans over with a wink and whispers...'she's really not my wife, I was just checking to see if you remembered!"

Overall, nearly a third of the girls at the Youth Villa have participated in this very special program. They learn about compassion, attentiveness and gentleness as they show their concern for these delightful senior citizens. And as they leave and wave good-bye, they smile and say "See you next week!"

Many caring individuals have chosen to support the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches by making an unrestricted gift that can be used to further the general purposes of the organization. Each year, the Board of Directors approves the annual budget. When a gift is made payable to the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches, without any specific restrictions, it is carefully and thoughtfully used where it is needed most.

The Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches has always valued and respected the right of a donor to designate or restrict the use of a particular gift for a specified purpose or service. We are committed to honoring these clearly defined requests with great care. Our goal is to work diligently with the donor to carefully plan a gift that will best meet the donor's wishes and appropriately serve the needs of the children in our care.

At times, we have had to decline a gift because we could not, in good faith, fulfill the donor's wishes. On other occasions, we have defended the donor's gift in court as others have tried to change or alter the donors specifie directions. Proper planning and complete documentation helps us maintain our ethical commitment to the donor's who choose to share their gifts with us.

The bottom line is the Florida Sheriffs Youth Ranches Board of Directors and Staff pledge to honor and respect each donor's instructions regarding the use of their gift.

Learning First Hand

With an eagerness to learn, our boys recently had a first hand lesson on the vital work performed by the volunteer firefighters of Florida.

Under the direct guidance and specific instruction of experienced emergency response personnel from Columbia City Station #44 and West Columbia Station #43, several Ranchers were given the privilege of utilizing lifesaving equipment as they helped extract a "volunteer victim" from a junkyard vehicle.

Donning the appropriate protective gear, three boys were paired with three trained firefighters as the simulated car accident scenario unfolded. With each purposeful action, the firefighters explained why and how they approached the task at hand.

The boys learned how to survey the scene for any unusual or dangerous conditions. Then, they made contact with the victim, providing protection, comfort and care. Next, they worked together to gain access to the victim by removing the automobile glass and operating the famous "jaws of life."


Step by step, the trained instructors explained the use of each tool and how it achieved the desired results. Properly aligned and clear of other debris, the powerful tools can cut through the mangled metal with unusual ease. "It's amazing," proclaimed Aaron. "We cut that door right off at the hinges!"

After the demonstration was over, the boys' questions continued. "Why do you remove the glass?" "How often do you get to use this equipment?" "What does it take to become a firefighter?"

Patiently, Clint Pittman answered every question. He told the boys about the training they attend and the many different opportunities available to them in this profession. And then, as a final word of encouragement, he reminded the boys they could always pursue the career of their choice and still serve as a volunteer firefighter. "We are just trained volunteers who wanted to protect our families and help keep our community safe."


