## Public's invited to 20th birthday party

A weekend of special events is being planned for September 30, October 1 and October 2, 1977, to celebrate the 20th Anniversary of the Florida Sheriffs Boys Ranch.

It will be a time for fun and games, as well as a time for prayer and serious reflection upon the countless blessings that have lifted the Ranch from the realm of dreams in 1957 to its present pinnacle of success and national prominence in 1977.

It will be a gala party and the public is cordially invited — especially the thousands of good friends from all areas of Florida who have helped to sustain the Ranch with their gifts, their prayers and their heart-warming concern.

Special events will include an open house, a horse show, a Suwannee River barbecue and an outdoor worship service during which a new residence cottage will be dedicated.

On Friday, September 30, overnight visitors will begin arriving at the campsite near the Boys Ranch horse show arena, where they will be greeted by the aroma from a huge pot of chicken pilau simmering on an open campfire.

Horse show events will begin at 8:30 p.m. under the new lights that have been installed at the arena.

Saturday events (October 1) will begin with the horse show grand entry at the arena, at 8:45 a.m., and continue with open house tours of Ranch facilities from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m.; an address commemorating the 20th Anniversary of the Boys Ranch at 11 a.m.; a free barbecue on the banks of the Suwannee River at Noon. The horse show will resume at 1 p.m. and will extend far into the evening under the lights.

Sunday's events (October 2) will include a worship service and dedicatory rites for the new Jellison residence cottage starting at 8:30 a.m. The final phase of the horse show will begin at 9:15 a.m. with a grand entry procession.

## MERGER : A step into the future

On October 1, 1977, the Florida Sheriffs Boys Ranch Fund and the Florida Sheriffs Girls Villa, Inc. will merge with the Florida Sheriffs Youth Fund, Inc., to mark the beginning of a new era of efficiency and expansion in the child-care activities sponsored by the Florida Sheriffs Association.

The Ranch and Villa programs will continue to operate as before, but they will no longer exist as separate and individual legal entities. They will have become a part of the Florida Sheriffs Youth Fund, Inc. Their identities will be preserved through appropriate court action and their names will be reserved with the Florida Department of State.

When the merger goes into effect, there will be just one legal entity — the Florida Sheriffs Youth Fund, Inc. — with central offices located at the Boys Ranch, as is now the case.

After October 1, all gift checks should be made payable to the Florida Sheriffs Youth Fund, Inc., but those who wish to designate their gifts to the Boys Ranch, Girls Villa or Youth Ranch may do so by simply making their wishes known. Undesignated gifts go into the general fund which supports all Florida Sheriffs Youth Fund facilities and programs.

The change will be felt in a very beneficial way through enhanced efficiency and economy of administration. This will apply not only to the existing child care programs, but also to any future programs which may be developed under the sponsorship of the Florida Sheriffs Association.

At present, the Ranch, Villa and Youth Fund are separate legal entities, each with its own Board of Trustees, its own staff, its own budget and its own accounts and records.

# That Tallahassee trip!

TALLAHASSEE — It was a short course in the mechanics of government for 26 youngsters from the Boys Ranch who visited here in May while the Florida Legislature was in session.

On arrival they were greeted by Leon County Sheriff Ken Katsaris and State Representative Ed Blackburn, Jr., who is a former Sheriff of Hillsborough County and a former (the first) Executive Director of the Boys Ranch.

They toured the old capitol; had a brief tour of the new high-rise capitol which was still under construction; met Lt. Gov. Jim Williams; and talked with their "man in Tallahassee," State Representative Wayne Hollingsworth, who explained the business of making laws.

Boys Ranch staff members said the boys had been studying state government, and the tour turned out to be a valuable field trip for them.

Nevertheless, boys will be boys, and they were actually more impressed with the Governor's pretty receptionist than they were with the various dignitaries they met. They jostled each other for the privilege of having their pictures taken with the receptionist.

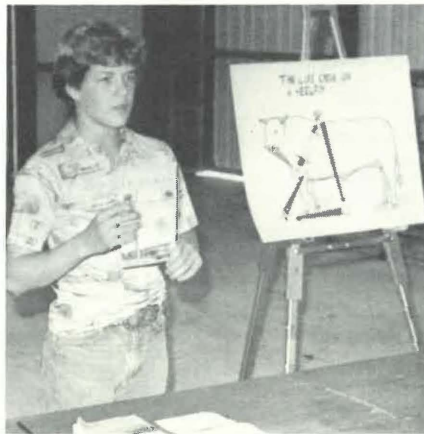

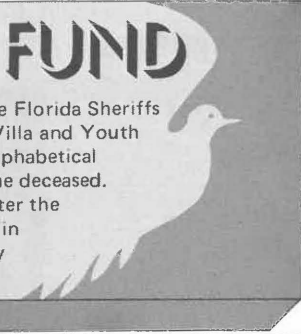

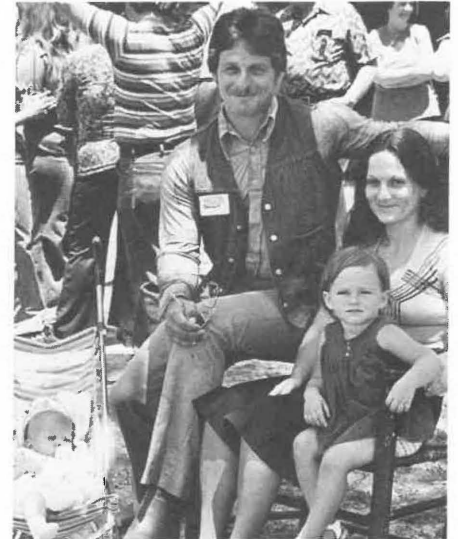

# “I’LL ALWAYS COME BACK”

Once again the Alumni Reunion Reveals the Kind of Results the Boys Ranch is Producing

The volleyball tournament was over. The alumni banquet was history. The bull sessions, business meetings, handshakes, and late night reminiscences were just memories, and now the annual Boys Ranch Alumni Reunion was drawing to a close.

In the pulpit of the Boys Ranch Chapel, Alyne Auxier, a handsome young alumnus, seemed to be summing up the sentiments of hundreds of young men who have called the Boys Ranch home over the past 20 years.

“I’ll always come back,” he told an audience of Ranchers, staff members, alumni and their families — and he went on to explain why. He said he had left the Ranch years ago “thinking I knew everything.” Then he had drifted into “drugs and the whole bit,” but his Boys Ranch upbringing had enabled him to turn his life around, and now, through church work, he was helping other boys to “do things the right way.”

He thanked the staff, and then he said: “The Boys Ranch has done a lot for me. I’m glad I was raised up the right way.”

Alumnus Darrell LaMontaigne followed Alyne to the pulpit to express similar sentiments. He said he had “tried all the wrong things — drugs — alcohol. I was really confused, but I gave my life to Christ. The Lord forgave me and changed my life.”

Earlier in the weekend Boys Ranch Executive Director Harry Weaver had spoken to an Alumni banquet audience about the many changes that have taken place at the Ranch, and he had strongly underscored that there had been no change in the emphasis the Ranch has always placed on “religious instruction.”

“I am proud of you,” Weaver told the members of the Boys Ranch Alumni Association, an organization that includes on its membership roster an impressive number of college graduates, a Certified Public Accountant, a medical school student, many skilled tradesmen, and a high percentage of young men who have been successful as fathers, husbands and self-sustaining citizens. *(continued on page 12)*

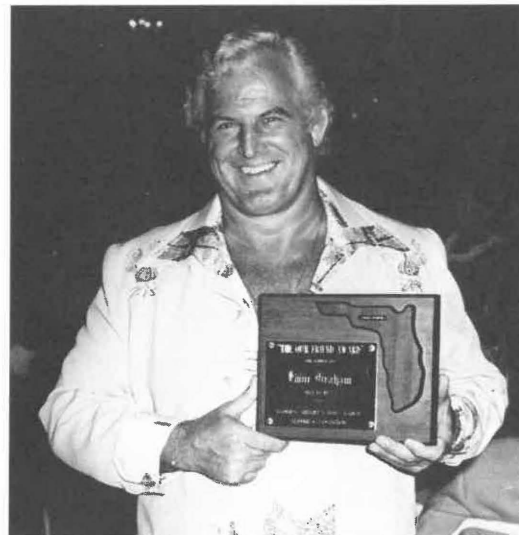

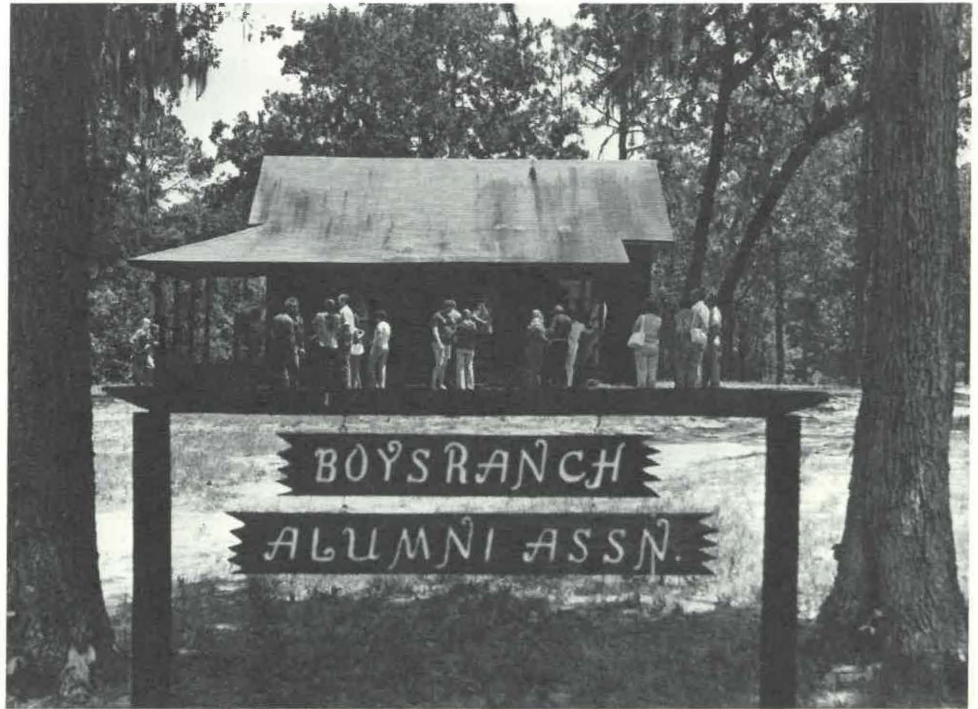

He cited also the many thousands of dollars raised through benefit wrestling matches staged by Eddie Graham and his associates for the benefit of the Ranch.

"When I was a boy selling newspapers on the streets of Chattanooga," Graham recalled, "someone gave me a helping hand." He said this motivated him to want to help other needy youngsters.

Graham is a trustee of the Boys Ranch, Girls Villa and Youth Fund. Blackburn is a trustee emeritus.

Other speakers at the banquet included Indian River County Sheriff Sam Joyce, of Vero Beach, who is Chairman of the Ranch, Villa and Youth Fund Trustees; and Leonard Russek, of Tampa, the newly-elected President of the Alumni Association.

During the weekend reunion returning alumni toured the growing Ranch facilities, and inspected the new Alumni Association headquarters building — a Florida backwoods style homestead which was donated to the Ranch many years ago by Elvis Presley and his manager, Col.
